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The Annual Report of the Arkansas State Board of Nursing is prepared and distributed in accordance with the *Nurse Practice Act* of the State of Arkansas, Arkansas Code Annotated § 17-87-203 (4). It contains information regarding the Board's activities, as well as information about nurses licensed by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, organized by licensure type and county of residence. Data on the supply and distribution of nurses licensed is included in Appendix A of this report. This data is obtained from responses during license renewal.

From the Director



It is with great pleasure that I present to you the Arkansas State Board of Nursing's 2023 Annual Report. This report reflects the Board of Nursing's activity from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

The mission of the Board of Nursing is to protect the public and act as their advocate by effectively regulating the practice of nursing. The Arkansas State Board of Nursing is composed of 13 board members. In accordance with state statutes, there are seven registered nurses (RNs) on the board. Of these seven RNs, two are advanced practice registered nurses with at least one of them holding prescriptive authority; one has (as their highest educational preparation) a diploma, two have an associate degree and two have a baccalaureate or higher degree in nursing. There are three licensed practical or licensed psychiatric technician nurses and two consumers, one of which represents the elderly

population. One additional at-large member is a licensed registered nurse or licensed practical nurse. One registered nurse must be an educator.

The agency consists of an administrative staff of 30 hard-working and dedicated individuals.

The Board is involved in nursing regulation on the local, state and national levels in order to address the ever-changing needs of the citizens of Arkansas. The annual report reflects the myriad of activities conducted by the Board and its staff in their commitment to fulfilling the mission of public protection. As you review this information, I hope you find the report informative and useful.

Legislative Mandate

The Arkansas State Board of Nursing has a legislative mandate to protect the public by assuring that any person practicing nursing is qualified to do so. The law governing the Board of Nursing is covered under the *Nurse Practice Act* (NPA) of the State of Arkansas (reprinted from Arkansas Code Annotated § 17-87-101 – § 17-87-711). In keeping with the power and responsibilities in the NPA, the Board:

- Maintains an office for the administration of its business and employs personnel necessary for carrying out its functions; examines, licenses, and renews licenses or certificates of duly qualified applicants for nursing licensure and medication assistant certification.
- Prescribes minimum standards, approves curricula, surveys, and approves educational programs
 preparing nurses for nursing licensure and medication assistant certification.
- Promulgates rules necessary for the implementation of the NPA and submits these to the Arkansas
 legislative bodies for review.
- Develops and recommends role levels of technical classes of nursing service and practice to state and federal health agencies and to public and private administrative bodies.
- Conducts disciplinary proceedings and causes prosecution of persons violating the NPA; and
- Grants certificates of prescriptive authority to qualified advanced practice registered nurses.

Committees

Administrative

The Administrative Committee serves in an advisory capacity and makes recommendations to the full Board which align with the Board's mission of public protection. The committee provides oversight on administrative matters and is responsible for providing direction of the agency. Some of the activities conducted by the committee include developing and revising agency policies, addressing legislative issues, evaluating the strategic plan, and providing guidance to staff on various administrative functions. The committee chairperson is Stacie Hipp, APRN.

Education

The Nursing Education Committee reviews nursing education issues and standards for the purpose of making recommendations to the Board. The committee proposes guidelines for use in implementing the *Rules* regarding nursing education programs, reviews new and established nursing education programs and addresses current nursing education issues and trends. During FY2023, the Education Committee reviewed fifteen Continued Full Approvals, four Prerequisite Approvals, one Initial Approval, and one Full Approval to nursing programs. The Committee also gave approval to three new medication assistant-certified programs. The chairperson is Ramonda Housh, APRN.

Finance

The ASBN Finance Committee is a group of designated board members who provide recommendations to the full board. Board members are responsible for the oversight of ASBN, so the Finance Committee is charged with the review of ASBN's financial information. Stacie Hipp, APRN, is chairperson. The financial information reviewed by the Finance Committee includes, but is not limited to, the following:

Committees

Practice

The ASBN Practice Committee reviews and research best practices for current issues in nursing practice and recommends official positions or other actions to the full Board. The committee monitors open investigations for trends in length of time cases are open and makes recommendations to the Board. The Practice Committee addresses other issues as assigned by the Board President. Neldia Dycus, RN is the committee chair.

Prescriptive Authority

The Prescriptive Authority Committee functions in an advisory capacity to assist the Board with oversight and implementation of the provisions regarding prescriptive authority. The committee is composed of six members appointed by the Board and approved by the governor. Four members are APRNs with at least three members holding certificates of prescriptive authority and active DEA numbers. One member is a licensed physician who has been involved in a collaborative practice agreement with an APRN for at least five years. One member is a licensed pharmacist who has been licensed at least five years.

The ADH-Arkansas State Board of Nursing does not receive appropriations of general revenue from the state. Nurse licensure fees constitute the agency's primary financial support. The FY 2023 total revenue was \$4,203,717.89. Expenses for the fiscal year totaled \$3,613,411.41. Total revenue and expenses include Board of Nursing operating fund, nursing student loan fund, continuing education workshop fund and grant fund.

The Board is required to pay 1.5 percent of revenue fees to the Treasury of the State of Arkansas. These funds are credited to the State's General Fund for appropriation to various other agencies and services of state government. The Board paid \$60,477.94 to the General Fund for FY 2023. The financial statements and graphs on the following pages reflect the breakdown of revenue and expenses for the fiscal year 2023.

The Nursing Student Loan fund titled the Faith A. Fields Nursing Scholarship Loan is a separate fund used only for the purpose of providing loan/scholarships to nursing students and nurse educator students. The program is funded by donations that are deposited into the designated fund. Up to \$100,000.00 may be transferred from the Operating Fund each year to fund the program. From these funds, nursing students are awarded loans that can become scholarships if they work in the state of Arkansas after graduation and licensure. In addition to the current recipient selections, beginning in the Fall of 2017, each year two recipients are selected to receive the Faith A. Fields Scholarship Loan in honor of the memory of Jill Hasley, the ASBN Program Coordinator in the Advance Practice Department from June 25, 2011, until her death on July 30, 2016.

The Continuing Education fund is also a separate fund that allows the Board of Nursing to collect registration fees for the educational workshops provided by the Board of Nursing. The designated funds from the registration fees are used to offset the costs associated with providing this service.

The Grant fund is a special revenue fund established in FY2018 to comply with Act 521 of 2017. Up to \$173,000.00 may be transferred from the Operating Fund each year to fund the program. This allows ASBN to provide a grant to the Arkansas Center for Nursing.







Faith A. Fields Nursing Scholarship/Loan


The ASBN nursing student loan program was established in 2003 and legislatively revised by Act 9 in 2009. The purpose of the program is to provide funding for individuals attending a nursing program that will lead to licensure as a nurse or provide a higher degree in nursing. The goal is to increase the number of nurses in practice settings and faculty in nursing education programs. Rep. Tracy Pennartz, the sponsor of the 2009 legislation, supports nursing education and requested emphasis be placed on nurses desiring to teach in an Arkansas nursing education program.

Applicants apply for one of two types of scholarship/loan. Applicants entering a nursing program that leads to initial licensure as a nurse or who desire to remain in the practice setting apply for the Practice Loan. Applicants who are already a nurse and currently teach or plan to teach in a nursing program apply for the Educator Loan. Recipients of either loan type may have their loans converted to scholarships according to the terms of the loan. Recipients of the Practice Loan must practice full-time as a nurse in an Arkansas facility one year for each year of the loan and the Educator Loan recipients must teach full-time in an Arkansas nursing program one year for each year of the loan.

Loans are made to students around the state with most loans made to students living in Pulaski County. The diagram below displays the counties in which recipients from FY2023 reside.

Loan Recipient Status

Each recipient has a nine-month grace period following graduation to allow time to secure a nursing position that meets the contract requirements. During this time and while completing their work requirements they are placed in monitoring status.


Since 2010, one hundred eighty-four (184) individuals have received a scholarship/loan from the Faith A. Fields

Scholarship. At the end of fiscal year 2023, one hundred eighteen (118) have completed the terms of their scholarship by practicing/teaching in Arkansas or repaying their scholarship funding. Three (3) recipients will continue receiving scholarship money for the upcoming fiscal year. Thirty-nine (39) recipients are being monitored for compliance with the terms of the loan and twenty-four (24) are in collections for repayment of the loan due to failure to fulfill the terms of the contract. Loan recipients who fail to complete the nursing program or graduate and do not comply with the terms of the loan (fail to practice or teach in an Arkansas institution) are placed into repayment status.


Number and Types of Loans

In 2021, the amount appropriated for each fiscal year was increased from \$50,000 to \$100,000. The table below demonstrates the amount disbursed for scholarship awards during the last five years by fiscal year.

A total of thirty-three (33) loans were granted during the reporting period totaling \$64,000. For the fall 2022 semester, five (5) educator loans and sixteen (16) practice loans were disbursed. The loans awarded for the following spring semester (2023) consisted of a continued



funding of two (2) educator loans and ten (10) practice loans. The table above depicts the amount of funding allocated for the two loan types during the fiscal year.



The Faith A. Fields Scholarship/Loan program continues to meet its goal of providing money to individuals attending a nursing education program.

Discipline

The Arkansas *Nurse Practice Act (NPA)* and its *Rules* provide that the Board may deny, suspend, revoke, limit or otherwise discipline any license or privilege to practice nursing or certificate of prescriptive authority issued by the Board or applied for in accordance with the provisions to discipline a licensee upon proof that the person:

- (1) Is guilty of fraud or deceit in procuring or attempting to procure a license to practice nursing or is engaged in the practice of nursing without a valid license;
- (2) Is guilty of a crime or gross immorality;
- (3) Is unfit or incompetent by reason of negligence, habits, or other causes;
- (4) Is habitually intemperate or is addicted to the use of habit-forming drugs;
- (5) Is mentally incompetent;
- (6) Is guilty of unprofessional conduct;
- (7) Has had a license, privilege to practice, certificate, or registration revoked, suspended, or placed on probation or under disciplinary order in any jurisdiction;
- (8) Has voluntarily surrendered a license, privilege to practice, certification, or registration and has not been reinstated in any jurisdiction; or
- (9) Has willfully or repeatedly violated any of the provisions of any chapter of the Arkansas NPA.

An individual is not eligible to receive or hold a license if that individual has pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to or been found guilty of any offense listed in § 17-3-102(a) unless the persons requests and the Board grants a waiver pursuant to in § 17-3-102(b). Investigations of inquiries and reports are completed by Board staff, legal counsel, contract investigators or other governmental agencies. During its investigations, the staff has continued to emphasize the Board's commitment to the due process afforded each licensee under the provisions of the *NPA* and the Administrative Procedures Act, as well as the Board's charge to protect the public.

Letter of Reprimand	The Board issues a reprimand on the license of the nurse. Licensee may be required to complete stipulations, such as educational courses, to satisfy the terms of the Letter of Reprimand within a certain time frame. Failure to comply may result in suspension until the terms are met.
Consent Agreement	The Board staff determines the violations and proposed stipulations. Board attorney draws up a legally binding agreement. The licensee receives a copy of the agreement, agrees to the terms, including waiving their right to a hearing before the Board, signs the agreement and returns to Board office. (If the licensee declines to sign the agreement, the Disciplinary Hearing process begins.) Board President signs the agreement following a majority approval by the Board.
Disciplinary Hearing	The General Counsel files formal charges. This may be done initially or after the licensee declines a Consent Agreement. Disciplinary Hearing is held — If the Board finds that the conduct which was charged did not occur or that the conduct which did occur is not a violation of the Nurse Practice Act, the case is dismissed, and no further action is taken. OR If the Board finds the nurse violated the Nurse Practice Act: Disciplinary Order — The Board issues an Order setting forth the discipline. This Order becomes effective the day it is signed. Appeal — The licensee may appeal this decision to the circuit court of the county in which he/she resides or the Circuit Court of Pulaski County, AR.

Alternative to Discipline

ArNAP is a non-public, abstinence-based, non-disciplinary monitoring program that was legislatively created in 2017 to help licensed nurses and applicants for licensure, who have a drug or alcohol abuse problem, or addiction.

The mission of ArNAP is to protect the public by providing education, consultation, referral, monitoring, and support for participants licensed by the Board of Nursing with conduct related to substance abuse and use. The program is administered by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing and is available to individuals who meet the program criteria.

In order to participate in ArNAP, a nurse must meet the following criteria:

- Hold an Arkansas nursing license or be eligible for licensure;
- Otherwise be eligible for continued licensure under the Arkansas Nurse Practice Act;
- Acknowledge a drug or alcohol abuse problem or addiction; and
- Voluntarily request participation in ArNAP.

Licensees or applicants for licensure will be denied participation in ArNAP if they do not meet the eligibility requirements, or if any of the following is applicable:

- Diverted controlled substances for reasons other than self-administration;
- Engaged in behaviors resulting in patient harm;
- Have prior discipline by any board of nursing for substance abuse or diversion; or
- Demonstrated unsuccessful participation resulting in termination from ArNAP or another similar program offered in another jurisdiction.

Process for Entering ArNAP

- 1. A complaint or referral is sent to the Board.
- 2. The complaint or referral is reviewed to determine if the nurse is eligible for ArNAP.
- 3. If the nurse is eligible for ArNAP and requests to participate in ArNAP, the nurse is required to sign an Agreement.
- 4. The Agreement addresses several initial items, such as acknowledging the drug or alcohol abuse problem or addiction, placing current nursing licensure on inactive status, obtaining an evaluation from a Board-approved evaluator for an addiction evaluation, and agreeing to comply with all treatment recommendations.
- 5. Once an ArNAP staff member has reviewed the nurse's evaluation report, a detailed contract is presented to the nurse. The ArNAP Contract contains all of the terms and conditions that the nurse must comply with while enrolled in ArNAP, which may include, but is not limited to the following: daily check-in with a drug screening monitoring company for random drug screens; therapy/counseling; support group meetings (such as 12-step); abstinence from drugs, alcohol, and abuse potential medications; employment restrictions; and submission of required reports (i.e. self, aftercare, treatment provider, and employment).
- 6. The term of ArNAP varies from one (1) to five (5) years depending upon the complaint or referral, and the diagnosis. A disciplinary flag will not be placed on the nurse's license if the nurse successfully completes ArNAP.


ArNAP Statistics for July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023

One hundred twenty-four (124) individuals were screened for eligibility for ArNAP during the reporting period and fifty-four (54) nurses entered ArNAP in lieu of disciplinary action. One applicant for licensure was ordered into ArNAP through a Board hearing. At the end of the reporting period, eighty-six (86) nurses were currently being monitored in the ArNAP program.

Twenty-five (25) nurses have completed ArNAP successfully during this reporting period, meeting all their monitoring requirements. The program success rate at the end of fiscal year 2023 is 78 percent.

Nurses who fail to meet their monitoring requirements are discharged from ArNAP and referred to the Board for disciplinary action. During the reporting period, seventeen (17) nurses were discharged for failing to meet the requirements of ArNAP. Eight (8) of the nurses chose to voluntary surrender their license, seven (7) nurses chose to enter Consent Agreements (probation), and two (2) nurses were referred to hearing.

Licensure

The *Nurse Practice Act* requires that any person practicing as a(n)

- Registered Nurse
- Advanced Practice Registered Nurse
- Registered Nurse Practitioner
- Practical Nurse, or
- Psychiatric Technician Nurse

in this state shall be licensed by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing. Legislation enacted in 1979 authorized the licensing of registered nurse practitioners. Act 409 of 1995 created advanced practice registered nurse licensure. This licensure includes the previous categories of certified registered nurse anesthetist and certified nurse midwives and adds licensure of certified nurse practitioners (previously known as advanced nurse practitioners) and clinical nurse specialists. Appendix A gives totals of nurses licensed in Arkansas by licensure category and county of residence. The information is derived from questions that are completed on the licensure renewal forms. Incomplete data indicates that the licensee did not provide that information.

Advanced Practice Prescriptive Authority

Licensure by Examination

Licensure examinations for registered nurse and practical nurse candidates are administered via computerized adaptive testing. State boards of nursing contract with the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) for these examinations. In Arkansas, tests are administered by technology centers located in Little Rock, Fort Smith, Rogers and Texarkana. A candidate may test at any center nationwide or internationally for licensure by the Board that provided the authorization to test.

The licensure examinations have one purpose: to test knowledge, skills and abilities essential to the safe and effective practice of nursing at the entry level. The use of national RN and PN examinations facilitates licensure by endorsement from one jurisdiction to another. The passing standard is set by a panel of practicing nurses who are knowledgeable of entry-level nursing practice. Membership on the panel is open to all NCSBN jurisdictions. Examination results are reported to boards of nursing and to the candidates as either "pass "or "fail". Unsuccessful candidates are provided with a performance report that gives information on areas for remedial study.

The Board participates in the test development system administered by the testing service of the NCSBN. The Arkansas Board approves practicing nurses to participate in RN and PN item writing, item review and standard-setting panel.

Temporary permits may be issued to Arkansas graduates of a nursing program. This permit allows a nurse to practice between graduation and receipt of results of the first examination for which the licensee is eligible.

Licensure by Endorsement

Pursuant to the Arkansas *Nurse Practice Act (NPA)*, the Board may issue a license to practice nursing by endorsement to an applicant who is duly licensed as a nurse under the laws of another state, territory, or foreign country if the applicant meets Board qualifications. Applicants for endorsement must have successfully completed a nursing education program, the appropriate licensure examination and must be verified by the jurisdiction of original licensure. An amendment to the *NPA* enacted by the 1980 Special Session of the Legislature, provided for issuing temporary permits to qualified endorsement applicants holding current licensure in other states.

License Renewal

The *Nurse Practice Act* requires biennial license renewal for practicing nurses. Renewal reminders are mailed at least sixty days before the license expiration date. Nurses who allow their licenses to lapse and who have not practiced nursing during the preceding licensure period may be reinstated upon request, payment of the renewal fee and late penalty, and after meeting the continuing education requirements. Nurses who do not renew are in good standing if they do not practice nursing in Arkansas. Legislation to require continuing education prior to license renewal was passed in the 2001 Legislative session. Approved renewals based on application submission is reflected in table.

Retired Licenses

Any licensee who desires to retire from the practice of nursing for any length of time in this state and submits an electronic application will have their current license placed on Inactive Retired status. While retired, the licensee shall not practice nursing. However, the nurse may use respective credentials. When the licensee desires to resume practice, he or she shall submit a renewal application, which shall be completed and submitted with a reinstatement fee and the current renewal fee. The number of current retired licenses issued during the reporting period is 166.

Military Expedited Licenses

The Arkansas State Board of Nursing is committed to honoring the service of active and reserve uniformed service members, uniformed service veterans and their families.

As mandated by Act 820 of the 2019 Arkansas legislative session, the ASBN has adopted rules to assist active and reserve uniformed service members, uniformed service veterans, and their spouses in obtaining nursing licensure. ASBN provides an opportunity for expedited temporary permit licensure and preferential processing during the issuance of a permanent license once receipt of all required documents. The total number of expedited licenses issued to active-duty military members, veterans, and their spouses for Fiscal Year 2023 is listed below.

Criminal Background Checks

Federal and Arkansas criminal background checks are required of all individuals applying for an initial license in Arkansas. During the 2022-2023 fiscal year, 5,756 Arkansas criminal background checks and 5,756 federal criminal background checks were conducted. There were 394 investigations completed and 496 investigations resolved on applicants with a positive criminal background check.

Education

The Arkansas State Board of Nursing staff conducts presentations, continuing education workshops, and online courses on a regular basis throughout the state as included in the Continuing Education Presentations table below. Additionally, continuing education courses were developed and are offered on a continuous basis thus expanding our online presence. Education Programs

The Arkansas State Board of Nursing has statutory authority to oversee nursing educational program compliance with mandated regulations and educational standards as established by the Arkansas legislature. A nursing program that is approved initially progresses through a three-tiered process of approval that includes Prerequisite Approval, Initial Approval and Full Approval.

A nursing program that is approved continues to be reviewed for continued compliance with the educational

standards as delineated in the *Rules*. The staff periodically conducts a program review to verify compliance. A new program has an onsite survey three years after initial full approval. Established programs have an onsite survey every five years, or if they have continued accreditation status from a national accreditation organization and maintain a National Council



Education Program Enrollment

Enrollment in nursing education programs is reported to the Board by program directors annually in January. The enrollment data submitted and reported is for the previous 2022 academic year. Enrollment figures are inclusive of only students enrolled in nursing courses that lead to a certificate or degree in nursing. The total numbers do not reflect the actual number of students that could potentially be enrolled in Arkansas nursing programs, due to a maximum enrollment not being set in several programs.

Compared to the previous ASBN Annual Report, enrollment has increased in Arkansas nursing programs during 2022. The practical nursing programs have increased from 1,180 students enrolled during 2021, to 1,235 students enrolled during 2022. This is an increased enrollment of 55 students, or 4.6 percent. The associate degree nursing programs have increased from 2,387 students enrolled during 2021, to 2,433 students enrolled during 2022. This is an increased enrollment of 46 students, or 1.9 percent. The Bachelor of Science in Nursing programs have increased from 2,429 students enrolled during 2021, to 2,584 students enrolled during 2022. This is an increased enrollment of 155 students, or 6.3 percent. The Master's Entry into Professional Nursing program has also increased enrollment from 26 students in 2021, to 31 students in 2022. This is an increased enrollment of 5 students, or 19.2 percent.

Overall, Arkansas nursing programs have increased enrollment of students from 6,022 students in 2021, to 6,283 students in 2022. This is an overall increase of 261 students enrolled, or 4.3 percent.

Licensing Examination Data

The licensure examinations for registered and practical nurses are administered via computer adaptive testing (CAT). The performance, by program, for first-time candidates taking the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN®), regardless of where the examination was taken during the FY23 reporting period (July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023) is shown in the table below. FY23 NCLEX Performance by Program charts below are inclusive of outcomes from the NCSBN Next Generation NCLEX (NGN) examination, that was launched on April 1, 2023. The NGN is an enhancement to the current licensure exam and is based on the NCSBN Clinical Judgement Measurement Model (NCJMM). The NCJMM is a framework for valid measurement of clinical judgment and decision making within the context of a standardized, high-stakes examination (ncsbn.org).

Compared to FY22, the overall NCLEX-RN volume for Arkansas increased from 2,113 first-time testers to 2,163 first-time testers. This is an overall 2.3 percentage point increase in FY23. The pass rate performance for the RN programs in Arkansas also increased significantly from 79.2 percent in FY22 to 85.3 percent in FY23. This is a 6.1 percentage point increase in FY23.

The performance, by program, for graduates of Arkansas programs taking the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (NCLEX-PN*) for the first time, regardless of where the examination was taken during the FY23 reporting period (July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023) is shown in the table below.

Compared to FY22, the overall NCLEX-PN volume for Arkansas decreased by 72 first-time testers, or -8.4 percent in FY23. - Overall, 198,287 first-time U.S. graduates took the NCLEX-RN examination during FY23, as compared to 188,193 who tested in FY22. This represents an increase of approximately 5.3 percent.
- The overall passing rate for the first-time U.S. graduates taking the NCLEX-RN during FY23 was 83.2 percent, as compared to 80.8 percent in FY22. This represents an increase of 2.4 percentage points.

Medication Assistant – Certified

Act 1423 of 2005 gave the Board authority to grant certification to qualified unlicensed persons to administer certain medications in designated facilities determined by the Board. The Board allows medication assistants only in Arkansas nursing homes or a facility operated as a local correctional facility as defined by ACA § 12-41-107, which nursing supervision is available and nurse patient ratios are legislatively required. This authorization included persons wo have met certain qualifications in Arkansas or who have met substantially similar qualifications and held similar credentials under the law in another state. In addition, in 2007, persons who have completed a certain portion of a nursing education program may be eligible to take the certification exam and work as a certified medication assistant.

Certification exams for Medication Assistants are administered through a computerized competency test. The Board has approved D&S Diversified Technologies-Headmaster, LLP, to provide examinations and scoring services for the Medication Assistant Certification Examination. In Arkansas, exams are administered electronically using TMU[©] Internet connected personal electronic devices, that are securely proctored.

The pass rate performance for the MA-C programs in Arkansas has increased from 60.6 percent in FY22 to 68.2 percent in FY23. This is a 7.6 percentage point increase in FY23.

A person who holds a Medication Assistant-Certified (MA-C) in another state or territory is eligible for endorsement of their certification, if the program meets the qualifications of a MA-C in Arkansas.

There was 1 endorsement granted during FY23, as compared to 0 in FY22. This is an increase of 1 certification by endorsement, or 100 percent.

A Medication Assistant-Certified (MA-C) is required to renew certifications biennially. The MA-C must complete eight (8) hours of Arkansas State Board of Nursing approved continuing education courses during each renewal period.

There were 48 MA-C renewals issued during FY23, as compared to 18 renewals in FY22. This is an increase of 30 renewals, or 166.6 percent.




