### Act 258- Added Emergency Medical Responder (page 6)

Amended definition of *Air Medical Service Medical Director* to include the Osteopathic Board of Emergency Medicine for DOs (page 5).

Amended definition of *Flight Physician* to include an unrestricted license to PGY3s or above and to have the option of being board certified/eligible. The way it was written was contradictory. PGY3s are ineligible for board certification (page 8).

Amended definition of *Medical Director Community Paramedic* to remove "or eligible in a specialty that is involved in direct patient contact" (page 8). There is a preference for medical directors for community paramedic programs to be familiar with emergency medicine and prehospital care.

Added EMR licensure level to staffing requirements. Allows for EMRs to participate in the 911 primary system on a paramedic ambulance.

# Removed from Section IV. C. 1. (page 29)

Permitted ambulances that are providing general patient transfers and not primary 911 emergency responses may staff their ambulances in the following manner. Redundant

# Act 258 Section IV. C. 2. a. (page 30)

Added EMR licensure level to staffing requirements. Allows for EMRs to participate in the 911 primary system on an AEMT ambulance.

# Act 258 Section IV. C. 3. a. (page 30)

Added EMR licensure level to staffing requirements. Allows for EMRs and certified EVOs to participate in the 911 primary system on an EMT ambulance.

Added Must always be staffed by the highest licensed level of care during transport. Clarification
