

Education Requirement for Fluoride Varnish Application

In-Person Training:

1. Contact the Office of Oral Health at adh.ooh@arkansas.gov or call 501-280-4051
2. Training includes:
 - a. Presentation from a qualified Registered Dental Hygienist
 - b. Lunch for attendees
 - c. Toolkit of resources for implementation and reimbursement
 - d. Starter pack of fluoride varnish

Online Training:

1. Go to www.train.org
2. Click on Create an Account
 - a. Create Login Name
 - b. Create Password
 - c. Confirm Password: Passwords must match
 - d. Email Address: Please enter a valid email address
 - e. First Name: Please enter your legal first name
 - f. Last Name: Please enter your legal last name
 - g. Time Zone
 - h. Zip/Postal Code
 - i. Agree to all TRAIN policies
 - j. Click on "Create Account"
3. Update your profile
 - a. Under Notifications, click on "Your profile is incomplete"
 - b. Manage Groups: Click, "Join Another Group" and select an affiliate you want to join
 - c. Contact: Add a phone number
 - d. Address: Add your work address
 - e. Organization: Enter your organization name, department and work title
 - f. Professional Role: Select up to three professional roles that best match your profession
 - g. Work Settings: Select up to three work settings that best fit your work environment
 - h. Click the "Save" button and "Close"

4. Launch Course

- a. On the HOME page and click on “Course Catalog” at the top of the page
- b. Where it says, “Search TRAIN” type in course code “1040373”
- c. Click on, “Caries Risk Assessment, Fluoride Varnish and Counseling”
- d. Click the green “Launch” button
- e. In the pop-up box, please enter your current Arkansas Practice Licensing and Certification information. Include the license number and expiration date.
- f. If you do not have licensing and certification information, please enter “N/A”
- g. Take course and score at least 80% on assessment

5. Save Certificate

- a. After completion, under “Options” on the thank you page, click on “Download your certificate of completion”
- b. Save your “Smiles for Life” certificate to your computer
