

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Arkansas Department of Health, Section of Medical Marijuana is accepting public comments on the proposed revision to the Rules and Regulations Governing Medical Marijuana Registration, Testing, and Labeling in Arkansas, promulgated pursuant to Amendment No. 98 of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas of 1874. The rules are changing pursuant to Act 1112 of 2021.

The public comment period begins March 18, 2022 and concludes Wednesday, April 20, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. The comment period is provided to allow interested parties and the public to provide any comments regarding the proposed revisions. Comments must be received by Wednesday, April 20, 2022, at 9:00 a.m.
