

Ending the HIV Epidemic (EHE) Community Based Organizations Request for Application (RFA) DH-21-0009

1. Who should applicants contact regarding questions about the RFA?

2. The work plan only has a limited number of lines for outlining activities. What should applicants do if additional space is needed?

It is allowable by the program for applicants to use a Word Document to continue narration of their activities for a specific component.

3. Is there a Center for Disease Control and Prevention administrative cap to adhere to when developing budgets?

There is not an administrative cap however proper Generally Accepted Accounting Principles should be followed in the preparation of budgets. However, it is the ADH Ending the HIV Epidemic (EHE) Program's expectation that a substantial amount of funding is budgeted towards EHE service efforts.
