§17-101-307 - LICENSE REQUIRED – EXEMPTIONS

(a) No person may practice veterinary medicine in this state who is not a licensed veterinarian or the holder of a valid temporary permit issued by the Arkansas Board of Animal Health.

(b) This chapter shall not be construed to prohibit:

(10) A chiropractor licensed in this state and certified by the American Veterinary Chiropractic Association or the equivalent thereof from performing chiropractic upon animals;
