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The Annual Report of the Arkansas State Board of Nursing is prepared and distributed in accordance with the *Nurse Practice Act* of the State of Arkansas, Arkansas Code Annotated § 17-87-203 (4). It contains information regarding the Board's activities, as well as information about nurses licensed by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, organized by licensure type and county of residence. Data on the supply and distribution of nurses licensed is included in Appendix A of this report. This data is obtained from responses during license renewal.

From the Director



It is with great pleasure that I present to you the Arkansas State Board of Nursing's 2024 Annual Report. This report reflects the Board of Nursing's activity from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

The mission of the Board of Nursing is to protect the public and act as their advocate by effectively regulating the practice of nursing. The Arkansas State Board of Nursing is composed of 13 board members. In accordance with state statutes, there are seven registered nurses (RNs) on the Board. Of these seven RNs, two are advanced practice registered nurses with at least one of them holding prescriptive authority; one has (as their highest educational preparation) a diploma, two have an associate degree and two have a baccalaureate or higher degree in nursing. There are three licensed practical or licensed psychiatric technician nurses and two consumers, one of which represents the elderly population. One additional at-large member is a licensed registered nurse or licensed practical nurse. One registered nurse must be an educator.

The agency consists of an administrative staff of 30 hard-working and dedicated individuals.

The Board is involved in nursing regulation on the local, state and national levels in order to address the ever-changing needs of the citizens of Arkansas. The annual report reflects the myriads of activities conducted by the Board and its staff in their commitment to fulfilling the mission of public protection. As you review this information, I hope you find the report informative and useful.

Legislative Mandate

The Arkansas State Board of Nursing has a legislative mandate to protect the public by assuring that any person practicing nursing is qualified to do so. The law governing the Board of Nursing is covered under the *Nurse Practice Act* (NPA) of the State of Arkansas (reprinted from Arkansas Code Annotated § 17-87-101 – § 17-87-711). In keeping with the power and responsibilities in the NPA, the Board:

- Maintains an office for the administration of its business and employs personnel necessary for carrying out its functions; examines, licenses, and renews licenses or certificates of duly qualified applicants for nursing licensure and medication assistant certification.
- Prescribes minimum standards, approves curricula, surveys, and approves educational programs preparing nurses for nursing licensure and medication assistant certification.
- Promulgates rules necessary for the implementation of the NPA and submits these to the Arkansas legislative bodies for review.
- Develops and recommends role levels of technical classes of nursing service and practice to state and federal health agencies and to public and private administrative bodies.
- Conducts disciplinary proceedings and causes prosecution of persons violating the NPA; and
- Grants certificates of prescriptive authority to qualified advanced practice registered nurses.

Committees

Administrative

The Administrative Committee serves in an advisory capacity and makes recommendations to the full Board which align with the Board's mission of public protection. The committee provides oversight on administrative matters and is responsible for providing direction of the agency. Some of the activities conducted by the committee include developing and revising agency policies, addressing legislative issues, evaluating the strategic plan, and providing guidance to staff on various administrative functions. The committee chairperson is Veronica Harmon, RN.

Education

The Nursing Education Committee reviews nursing education issues and standards for the purpose of making recommendations to the Board. The committee proposes guidelines for use in implementing the *Rules* regarding nursing education programs, reviews new and established nursing education programs and addresses current nursing education issues and trends. During FY2025, the Education Committee conducted reviews resulting in one Prerequisite Approval, one Initial Approval, one Full Approval, and nine Continued Full Approvals for nursing education programs. Additionally, the Committee reviewed and granted one Initial Approval for a medication assistant training program. The Committee is chaired by Tabitha Lancaster, RN.

Finance

The ASBN Finance Committee is a group of designated board members who provide recommendations to the full board. Board members are responsible for the oversight of ASBN, so the Finance Committee is charged with the review of ASBN's financial information. Phillip Petty, RN, is committee chairperson. The financial information reviewed by the Finance Committee includes, but is not limited to, the following:

Committees

Practice

The ASBN Practice Committee reviews and researches best practices for current issues in nursing practice and recommends official positions or other actions to the full Board. The committee monitors open investigations for trends in length of time cases are open and makes recommendations to the Board. The Practice Committee addresses other issues as assigned by the Board President. Cassie Gonzales, APRN, is the committee chair.

Prescriptive Authority

The Prescriptive Authority Committee functions in an advisory capacity to assist the Board with oversight and implementation of the provisions regarding prescriptive authority. The committee is composed of six members appointed by the Board and approved by the governor. Four members are APRNs with at least three members holding certificates of prescriptive authority and active DEA numbers. One member is a licensed physician who has been involved in a collaborative practice agreement with an APRN for at least five years. One member is a licensed pharmacist who has been licensed at least five years.

Full Independent Practice

In 2021 the legislature passed Act 412 which provides a pathway for certified nurse practitioners to apply for full independent practice removing the requirement of a collaborative practice agreement for prescriptive authority. Act 412 also created the Full Independent Practice Credentialing Committee (FIPCC), a separate committee comprised of four physicians and four advanced practiced registered nurses appointed by the governor to review and approve all applications for full independent practice. This committee is independent of ASBN and works in collaboration with the Arkansas State Medical Board (ASMB). ASBN Director and ASMB Director serve as ex-officio nonvoting members on the committee. Amendments were made in 2023 that added eligibility for clinical nurse specialists. Minimum eligibility requirements for applicants include 6,240 hours of practice under a board approved agreement.

ASBN began accepting applications August 1, 2022, through the Arkansas Nurse Portal. The FIPCC meets quarterly to review applications.

Budget

The ADH-Arkansas State Board of Nursing does not receive appropriations of general revenue from the state. Nurse licensure fees constitute the agency's primary financial support. The FY 2025 total revenue was \$4,412,654.12. Expenses for the fiscal year totaled \$3,836,179.04. Total revenue and expenses include Board of Nursing operating fund, nursing student loan fund, continuing education workshop fund and grant fund.

The Board is required to pay 1.5 percent of revenue fees to the Treasury of the State of Arkansas. These funds are credited to the State's General Fund for appropriation to various other agencies and services of state government. The Board paid \$61,627.88 to the General Fund for FY 2025. The financial statements and graphs on the following pages reflect the breakdown of revenue and expenses for the fiscal year 2025.

The Nursing Student Loan Program is named after Faith A. Fields who devoted her time as a board member from 1988 until 1991 when she joined the Board as Director of Education. In 1996 she became the Executive Director where she served until her retirement in 2010. The Faith A. Fields Nursing Scholarship Loan is a separate fund used only for the purpose of providing loan/scholarships to nursing students and nurse educator students. The program is funded by donations that are deposited into the designated fund. Up to \$100,000.00 may be transferred from the Operating Fund each year to fund the program. From these funds, nursing students are awarded loans that can become scholarships if they work in the state of Arkansas after graduation and licensure. In addition to the current recipient selections, beginning in the Fall of 2017, each year two recipients are selected to receive the Faith A. Fields Scholarship Loan in honor of the memory of Jill Hasley, the ASBN Program Coordinator in the Advance Practice Department from 2011 until her death in 2016.

The Continuing Education fund is also a separate fund that allows the Board of Nursing to collect registration fees for the educational workshops provided by the Board of Nursing. The designated funds from the registration fees are used to offset the costs associated with providing this service.

The Grant fund is a special revenue fund established in FY2018 to comply with Act 521 of 2017. Up to \$173,000.00 may be transferred from the Operating Fund each year to fund the program. This allows ASBN to provide a grant to the Arkansas Center for Nursing, Inc.

Fee Chart for FY2025 (as of 6/30/2025)

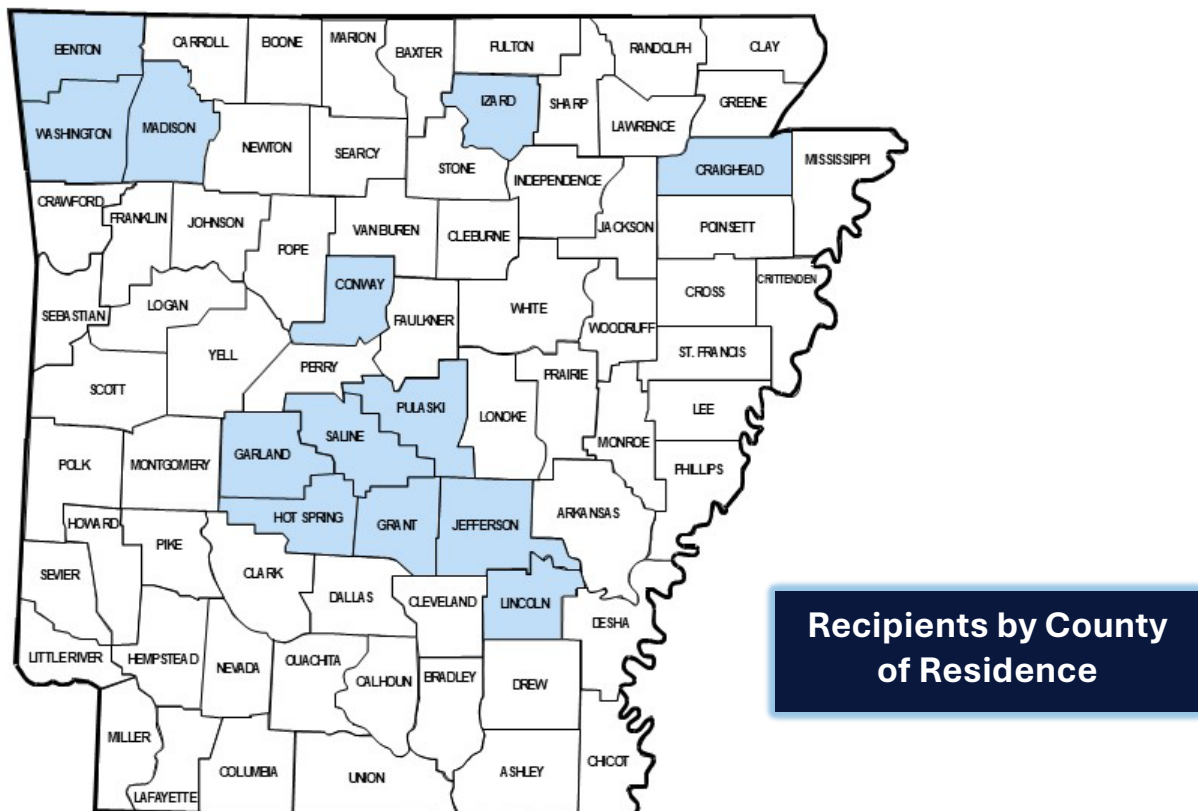

Faith A. Fields Nursing Scholarship/Loan

The ASBN nursing student loan program was established in 2003 and legislatively revised by Act 9 in 2009. The purpose of the program is to provide funding for individuals attending a nursing program that will lead to licensure as a nurse or provide a higher degree in nursing. The goal is to increase the number of nurses in practice settings and faculty in nursing education programs. Representative Tracy Pennartz, the sponsor of the 2009 legislation, supported nursing education and requested that emphasis be placed on nurses desiring to teach in an Arkansas nursing education program.

Applicants apply for one of two types of scholarship/loan. Applicants entering a nursing program that leads to initial licensure as a nurse or those who desire to remain in a practice setting are eligible to apply for the Practice Loan. Applicants who are already nurses and currently teach or plan to teach in a nursing program apply for the Educator Loan. Recipients of either loan type may have their loans converted to scholarships according to the terms of the loan. Recipients of the Practice Loan must practice full-time as a nurse in an Arkansas facility for one year for each year of the loan, and the Educator Loan recipients must teach full-time in an Arkansas nursing program for one year for each year of the loan.

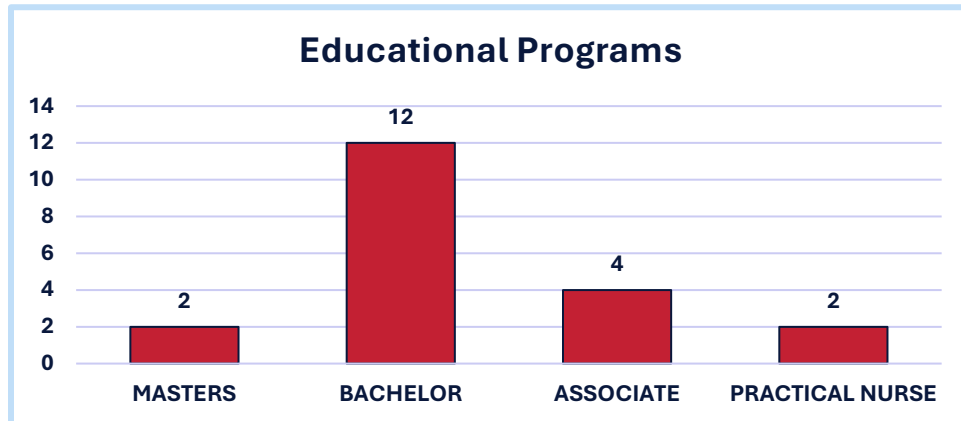
Loans are made to students throughout the state, with the majority of loans being awarded to students residing in central Arkansas. The diagram below displays the counties in which recipients from FY2025 reside.

Educational Programs

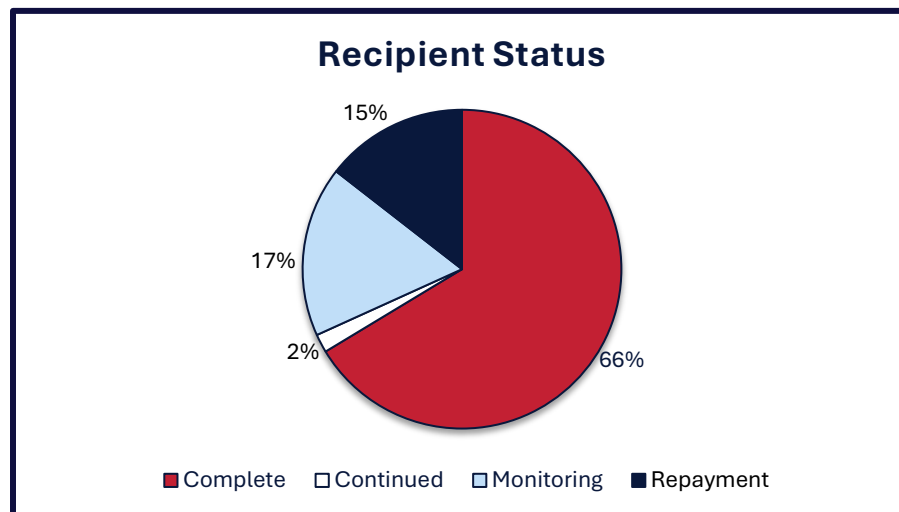
Nursing education programs attended by the twenty (20) individual recipients of fiscal year 2025 were from a variety of educational levels. The table below indicates the breakdown of nursing educational programs attended by recipients.



Loan Recipient Status

Each recipient has a nine-month grace period following graduation to allow time to secure a nursing position that meets the contract requirements. During this time, and while completing their work requirements, they are placed in monitoring status.

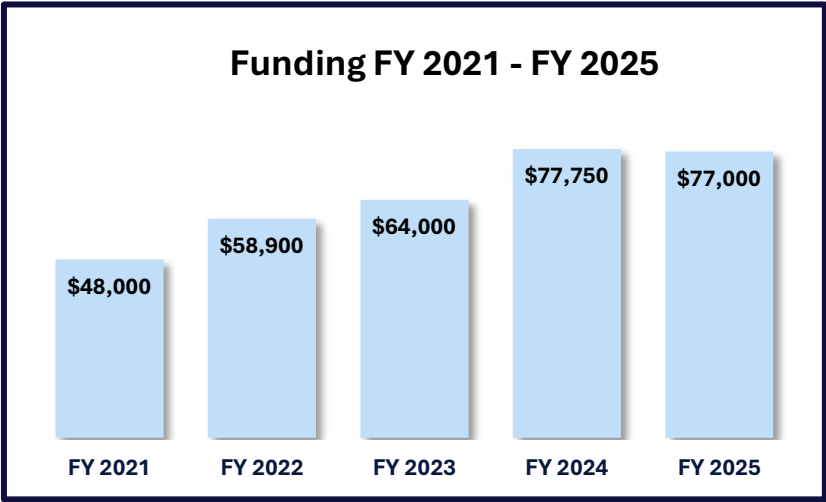
Since 2010, two hundred one (201) individuals have received a scholarship/loan from the Faith A. Fields Scholarship/Jill Hasley Scholarship. At the end of fiscal year 2025, one hundred forty-two (142) completed the terms of their scholarship by practicing/teaching in Arkansas or repaying their scholarship funding. Four (4) recipients will continue receiving scholarship money for the upcoming fiscal year. Thirty-seven (37) recipients are being monitored for compliance with the terms of the loan, and thirty-one (31) are in collections for repayment of the loan due to failure to fulfill the terms of the contract. Loan recipients who fail to complete the nursing program or graduate and do not comply with the terms of the loan (fail to practice or teach in an Arkansas institution) are placed into repayment status.



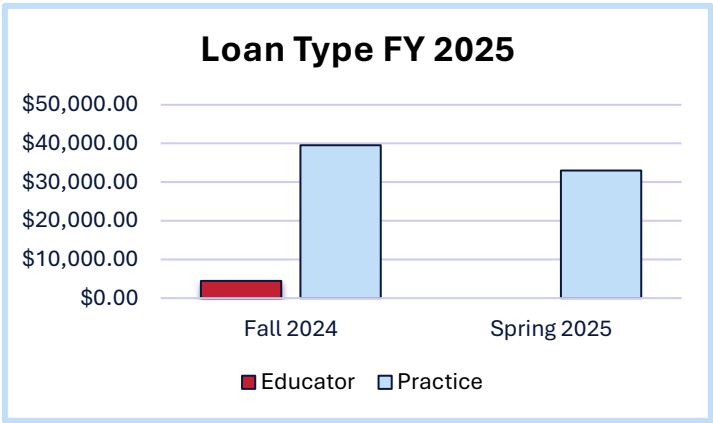
Faith A. Fields Nursing Scholarship/Loan

Number and Types of Loans

In 2021, the amount appropriated for each fiscal year was increased from \$50,000 to \$100,000. The table below demonstrates the amount disbursed for scholarship awards during the last five years by fiscal year.



A total of thirty-six (36) loans were granted during the reporting period totaling \$77,000. For the fall 2024 semester, one (1) educator loan and nineteen (19) practice loans were disbursed. The loans awarded for the 2025 spring semester consisted for sixteen (16) practice loans. The table to the right depicts the amount of funding allocated for the two loan types during the fiscal years.



The Faith A. Fields Scholarship/Loan program continues to meet its goal of providing money for individuals attending a nursing education program.

Discipline

The Arkansas *Nurse Practice Act (NPA)* and its *Rules* provide that the Board may deny, suspend, revoke, limit or otherwise discipline any license or privilege to practice nursing or certificate of prescriptive authority issued by the Board or applied for in accordance with the provisions to discipline a licensee upon proof that the person:

- (1) Is guilty of fraud or deceit in procuring or attempting to procure a license to practice nursing or is engaged in the practice of nursing without a valid license;
- (2) Is guilty of a crime or gross immorality;
- (3) Is unfit or incompetent by reason of negligence, habits, or other causes;
- (4) Is habitually intemperate or is addicted to the use of habit-forming drugs;
- (5) Is mentally incompetent;
- (6) Is guilty of unprofessional conduct;
- (7) Has had a license, privilege to practice, certificate, or registration revoked, suspended, or placed on probation or under disciplinary order in any jurisdiction;
- (8) Has voluntarily surrendered a license, privilege to practice, certification, or registration and has not been reinstated in any jurisdiction; or
- (9) Has willfully or repeatedly violated any of the provisions of any chapter of the Arkansas *NPA*.

An individual is not eligible to receive or hold a license if that individual has pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to or been found guilty of any offense listed in § 17-3-102(a) unless the person requests and the Board grants a waiver pursuant to in § 17-3-102(b). Investigations of inquiries and reports are completed by Board staff, legal counsel, contract investigators or other governmental agencies. During its investigations, the staff has continued to emphasize the Board's commitment to the due process afforded each licensee under the provisions of the *NPA* and the Administrative Procedures Act, as well as the Board's charge to protect the public. During the reporting period, 1,995 complaints were received, 1,372 cases were assigned to an investigator and 1,181 were resolved.

If disciplinary action is pursued, this can be accomplished in one of three ways:

Letter of Reprimand	The Board issues a reprimand on the license of the nurse. Licensee may be required to complete stipulations, such as educational courses, to satisfy the terms of the Letter of Reprimand within a certain time frame. Failure to comply may result in suspension until the terms are met.
Consent Agreement	The Board staff determines the violations and proposed stipulations. Board attorney draws up a legally binding agreement. The licensee receives a copy of the agreement, agrees to the terms, including waiving their right to a hearing before the Board, signs the agreement and returns to Board office. (If the licensee declines to sign the agreement, the Disciplinary Hearing process begins.) Board President signs the agreement following a majority approval by the Board.
Disciplinary Hearing	The General Counsel files formal charges. This may be done initially or after the licensee declines a Consent Agreement. Disciplinary Hearing is held – If the Board finds that the conduct which was charged did not occur or that the conduct which did occur is not a violation of the <i>Nurse Practice Act</i>, the case is dismissed, and no further action is taken. OR If the Board finds the nurse violated the <i>Nurse Practice Act</i>: Disciplinary Order – The Board issues an Order setting forth the discipline. This Order becomes effective the day it is signed. Appeal – The licensee may appeal this decision to the circuit court of the county in which he/she resides or the Circuit Court of Pulaski County, AR.

Alternative to Discipline

Arkansas Alternative Program (ArNAP) is a non-public, abstinence-based, non-disciplinary monitoring program that was legislatively created in 2017 to help licensed nurses and applicants who have a drug or alcohol abuse problem, or addiction.

The mission of ArNAP is to protect the public by providing education, consultation, referral, monitoring, and support for participants licensed or certified by the Board of Nursing with conduct related to substance abuse and use. The program is administered by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing and is available to individuals who meet the program criteria.

To participate in ArNAP, a nurse must meet the following criteria:

- Hold an Arkansas nursing license, certificate or be eligible for licensure or certification.
- Otherwise, be eligible for continued licensure or certification under the Arkansas *Nurse Practice Act*.
- Acknowledge a drug or alcohol abuse problem or addiction; and
- Voluntarily request participation in ArNAP.

An individual will be denied participation in ArNAP if they do not meet the eligibility requirements, or if any of the following is applicable:

- Diverted controlled substances for reasons other than self-administration.
- Engaged in behaviors resulting in patient harm.
- Have prior discipline by any board of nursing for substance abuse or diversion; or
- Demonstrated unsuccessful participation resulting in termination from ArNAP or another similar program offered in another jurisdiction.

Process for Entering ArNAP

1. A complaint or referral is sent to the Board.
2. The complaint or referral is reviewed to determine if the individual is eligible for ArNAP.
3. If the individual is eligible for ArNAP and requests to participate in ArNAP, the individual is required to sign an Agreement.
4. The Agreement addresses several initial items, such as acknowledging the drug or alcohol abuse problem or addiction, placing current nursing licensure on inactive status, obtaining an evaluation from a Board-approved evaluator for an addiction evaluation, and agreeing to comply with all treatment recommendations.
5. Once an ArNAP staff member has reviewed the individual's evaluation report, a detailed contract is presented to the individual. The ArNAP Contract contains the terms and conditions that the individual must comply with while enrolled in ArNAP, which may include, but is not limited to the following: daily check-in with a drug screening monitoring company for random drug screens; therapy/counseling; support group meetings (such as 12-step); abstinence from drugs, alcohol, and abuse potential medications; employment restrictions; and submission of required reports (i.e. self, aftercare, treatment provider, and employment).
6. The term of ArNAP varies from one (1) to five (5) years depending upon the complaint or referral, and the diagnosis. A disciplinary flag will not be placed on the individual's license if the individual successfully completes ArNAP.

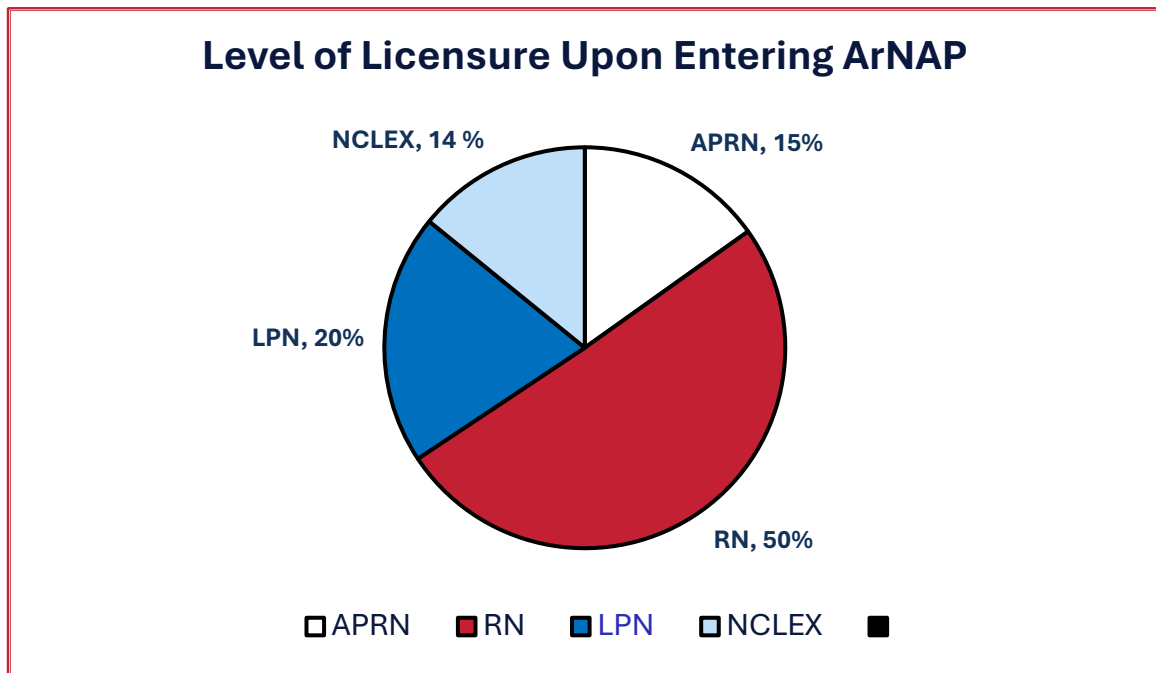
ArNAP Statistics for July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025

One hundred six (106) individuals were screened for eligibility for ArNAP during the reporting period and fifty (50) individuals entered ArNAP in lieu of disciplinary action. At the end of the reporting period, eighty-eight (88) individuals were currently monitored in the ArNAP program.

Thirty-six (36) individuals have completed ArNAP successfully during this reporting period, meeting all their monitoring requirements. The program success rate at the end of fiscal year 2025 is 75 percent.

Individuals who fail to meet their monitoring requirements are discharged from ArNAP and referred to the Board for disciplinary action. During the reporting period, sixteen (16) individuals were discharged for failing to meet the requirements of ArNAP. Seven (7) of the individuals chose to voluntarily surrender their license, seven (7) individuals chose to enter Consent Agreements (probation), and two (2) individuals were referred to hearing.

Licensure

The *Nurse Practice Act* requires that any person practicing as a(n)

- Registered Nurse
- Advanced Practice Registered Nurse
- Registered Nurse Practitioner
- Practical Nurse, or
- Psychiatric Technician Nurse

in this state shall be licensed by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing. Legislation enacted in 1979 authorized the licensing of registered nurse practitioners. Act 409 of 1995 created advanced practice registered nurse licensure. This licensure includes the previous categories of certified registered nurse anesthetist and certified nurse midwives and adds licensure of certified nurse practitioners (previously known as advanced nurse practitioners) and clinical nurse specialists. Appendix A gives totals of nurses licensed in Arkansas by licensure category and county of residence. The information is derived from questions that are completed on the licensure renewal forms. Incomplete data indicates that the licensee did not provide that information.

Advanced Practice Prescriptive Authority

Licensure

Licensure by Examination

Licensure examinations for registered nurse and practical nurse candidates are administered via computerized adaptive testing. State boards of nursing contract with the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) for these examinations. In Arkansas, tests are administered by technology centers located in Little Rock, Fort Smith, Rogers and Texarkana. A candidate may test at any center nationwide or internationally for licensure by the Board that provided the authorization to test.

The licensure examinations have one purpose: to test knowledge, skills and abilities essential to the safe and effective practice of nursing at the entry level. The use of national RN and PN examinations facilitates licensure by endorsement from one jurisdiction to another. The passing standard is set by a panel of practicing nurses who are knowledgeable of entry-level nursing practice. Membership on the panel is open to all NCSBN jurisdictions. Examination results are reported to boards of nursing and to the candidates as either “pass “or “fail”. Unsuccessful candidates are provided with a performance report that gives information on areas for remedial study.

The Board participates in the test development system administered by the testing service of the NCSBN. The Arkansas Board approves practicing nurses to participate in RN and PN item writing, item review and standard-setting panel.

Temporary permits may be issued to Arkansas graduates of a nursing program. This permit allows a nurse to practice between graduation and receipt of results of the first examination for which the licensee is eligible.

Licensure by Endorsement

Pursuant to the Arkansas *Nurse Practice Act (NPA)*, the Board may issue a license to practice nursing by endorsement to an applicant who is duly licensed as a nurse under the laws of another state, territory, or foreign country if the applicant meets Board qualifications. Applicants for endorsement must have successfully completed a nursing education program, the appropriate licensure examination and must be verified by the jurisdiction of original licensure. An amendment to the *NPA* enacted by the 1980 Special Session of Legislature, provided for issuing temporary permits to qualified endorsement applicants holding current licensure in other states.

License Renewal

The *Nurse Practice Act* requires biennial license renewal for practicing nurses. Renewal reminders are mailed at least sixty days before the license expiration date. Nurses who allow their licenses to lapse and who have not practiced nursing during the preceding licensure period may be reinstated upon request, payment of the renewal fee and late penalty, and after meeting the continuing education requirements. Nurses who do not renew are in good standing as long as they do not practice nursing in Arkansas. Legislation to require continuing education prior to license renewal was passed in the 2001 Legislative session. Approved renewals based on application submission are reflected in the table.

Retired Licenses

Any licensee who desires to retire from the practice of nursing for any length of time in this state and submits an electronic application will have their current license placed on Inactive Retired status. While retired, the licensee shall not practice nursing. However, the nurse may use respective credentials. When the licensee desires to resume practice, he or she shall submit a renewal application, which shall be completed and submitted with a reinstatement fee and the current renewal fee. The number of current retired licenses issued during the reporting period is 162.

Licensure

Military Automatic Licenses

The Arkansas State Board of Nursing (ASBN) is committed to honoring the service of active and reserve uniformed service members, uniformed service veterans and their families.

As mandated by Act 137 of the 2023 Arkansas legislative session, the ASBN has adopted rules to assist active and reserve uniformed service members, uniformed service veterans, and their spouses in obtaining initial nursing licensure. ASBN provides an opportunity for automatic temporary permit licensure and preferential processing during the issuance of a permanent license. The total number of automatic licenses issued to active-duty military members, veterans, and their spouses for Fiscal Year 2025 is listed below.

Criminal Background Checks

Federal and Arkansas criminal background checks are required of all individuals applying for an initial license in Arkansas. During the 2024-2025 fiscal year, 5,656 Arkansas and federal criminal background checks were conducted. There were 481 investigations initiated, and 443 investigations resolved on applicants with a positive criminal background check.

Education

The Arkansas State Board of Nursing staff conducts presentations, continuing education workshops, and online courses on a regular basis throughout the state as included in the Continuing Education Presentations table below. Additionally, continuing education courses were developed and are offered on a continuous basis thus expanding our online presence. Online course offerings have the advantage of reaching a larger audience. The Online Course Offering table reflects courses that are available and the number of times each course was taken in the respective fiscal year.

Education Programs

For the fiscal year 2025 (FY25) reporting period (July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025), the State of Arkansas maintained 79 approved educational programs under the jurisdiction of the Arkansas State Board of Nursing (ASBN). These included 68 nursing education programs—28 practical nursing programs and 40 registered nursing programs (25 associate degree, 14 baccalaureate degree, and one master’s entry program), in addition to 11 medication assistant training programs.

The ASBN Education Committee is charged with the responsibility of reviewing all nursing education and medication assistant training programs to ensure compliance with established Educational Standards. The Committee provides recommendations to the Board regarding program approval, proposes guidelines for the implementation of Rules governing educational programs, evaluates new and continuing programs, and addresses issues and trends impacting nursing and medication assistant education within the state.

As reflected in Table 1, during FY25 the Committee conducted reviews resulting in one Prerequisite Approval, one Initial Approval, one Full Approval, and nine Continued Full Approvals for nursing education programs. Additionally, the Committee reviewed and granted one Initial Approval for a medication assistant training program. The Committee is chaired by Tabitha Lancaster, RN.

Education Program Approval Process

ASBN has statutory authority to oversee nursing education and medication assistant training programs to ensure compliance with mandated regulations and established Educational Standards as defined by the Arkansas legislature.

Nursing Education Programs

Newly approved nursing education programs progress through a three-tiered approval process consisting of Prerequisite Approval, Initial Approval, and Full Approval. Once granted approval, nursing education programs are subject to ongoing review to ensure continued compliance with ASBN Educational Standards as outlined in the *Rules*. ASBN staff conduct periodic program reviews to verify compliance.

- A new nursing education program undergoes an onsite survey three years following the granting of Full Approval.
- Established nursing education programs undergo an onsite survey every five years.
- Programs maintaining national nursing accreditation and a National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX®) passage rate of 75 percent or higher may submit a paper survey in lieu of an onsite review.

Education Programs

Nursing Education Programs

Currently, 25 nursing education programs hold national accreditation (one practical nursing program and 24 registered nursing programs, consisting of 11 associate degree, 12 baccalaureate degree, and one master’s entry program). Established nursing education programs preparing graduates for nursing licensure are designated as either Continued Full Approval, or Conditional Approval. Of the 68 nursing education programs, two currently hold Conditional Approval. One associate degree program voluntarily closed to new admissions effective December 2024. The remaining 65 programs hold Initial Approval or Full Approval (Table 2).

Medication Assistant Training Programs

New medication assistant training programs undergo an initial onsite survey, followed by onsite reviews every five years. Established medication assistant training programs are designated as either Full Approval, or Conditional Approval. As of FY25, all 11 medication assistant training programs hold Full Approval. Two programs did voluntarily choose to close due to low enrollment numbers.

Conditional Approval

For both nursing education and medication assistant training programs, Conditional Approval indicates noncompliance with ASBN Educational Standards that have not been corrected within the timeframe established by the Board. Conditional Approval remains in effect for two years for nursing education programs and one year for medication assistant training programs, unless otherwise determined by the Board.

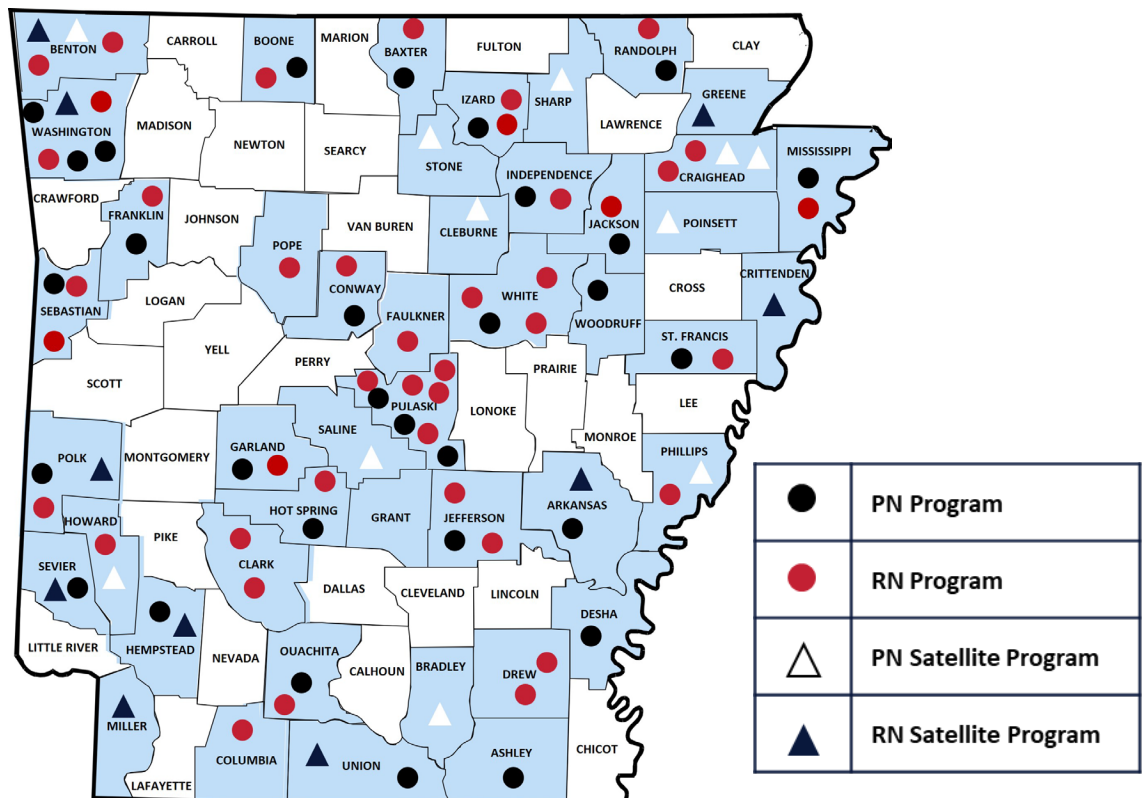

Education Programs

Enrollment in nursing education programs is reported to the ASBN each January and reflects data from the previous academic year. These enrollment figures include only pre-licensure students enrolled in nursing courses leading to a practical nursing (PN) certificate or an associate, baccalaureate, or master's degree in nursing.

Compared to the 2024 ASBN Annual Report, nursing programs across Arkansas saw an overall increase of 515 students. Total enrollment rose from 5,551 in 2024 to 6,066 in 2025, representing a 9.2% increase.

- Practical Nursing (PN) programs (Table 3) reported an increase of 73 students (6.4%), growing from 1,128 in 2024 to 1,201 in 2025.
- Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) programs (Table 4) added 146 students (6.2%), increasing from 2,338 to 2,484, and continued to represent the largest cohort among all program types.
- Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) programs (Table 5) saw the largest growth in overall enrollment, increasing by 291 students (14%), from 2,064 in 2024 to 2,355 in 2025.
- The state's sole Master's Entry into Professional Nursing (MEPN) program (Table 6) also experienced growth, with enrollment rising from 21 to 26 students, a 23.8% increase.

In 2025, Arkansas nursing programs collectively expanded their enrollment capacity by 245 seats, a 3.4% increase from the previous year (Table 7). Available seats rose from 7,028 in 2024 to 7,273 in 2025. Across all program types, 5,351 qualified applicants applied for admission in 2025. Despite this, vacant seats remain in every program type. In 2025, there were 1,207 vacant seats compared to 1,477 in 2024, a reduction of 270 seats (18.2%). This decrease in vacancies reflects the overall growth in nursing program enrollment from 2024 to 2025. Enrollment capacity and vacancy details for 2025 were reported as follows:

- PN programs report 145 vacant seats (89% full capacity)
- ADN programs report 562 vacant seats (81.5% full capacity)
- BSN programs report 462 vacant seats (83.5% full capacity)
- MEPN program reported 38 vacant seats (40.6% full capacity)

Nursing Education Program Graduation

Program completion rates are calculated by dividing the number of students who graduate by the number originally enrolled in a given cohort. In 2025, a total of 2,033 students graduated from nursing education programs in Arkansas. This includes 530 graduates from practical nursing programs and 1,503 from registered nursing programs—comprising 911 associate degree, 584 bachelor's degree, and 8 master's degree graduates. This represents a slight decrease of 16 graduates (0.7%) compared to the 2,049 reported in 2024 (Table 8).

Licensing Examination Data

Licensure exams for both practical and registered nurses are administered using computer adaptive testing (CAT). First-time pass rates for the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (NCLEX-PN) and Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN®), regardless of testing location, are reported for the FY25, covering the period from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025. These results include performance on the Next Generation NCLEX (NGN), which was launched on April 1, 2023. The NGN incorporates the NCSBN Clinical Judgment Measurement Model (NCJMM), a framework designed to assess clinical judgment and decision-making in a standardized, high stakes setting ([ncsbn.org](https://www.ncsbn.org)).

NCLEX-PN Performance (Table 9):

In FY25, Arkansas had 767 first-time NCLEX-PN testers, a decrease of 28 students (3.5%) compared to 795 in 2024. The statewide pass rate declined from 94.2% in FY24 to 92% in FY25, a drop of 2.2 percentage points.

NCLEX-RN Performance – Associate Degree Programs (Table 10):

First-time testers from associate degree nursing (ADN) programs decreased slightly by 4 students (0.3%), from 1,292 in 2024 to 1,288 in 2025. The pass rate also declined, falling from 91.1% in FY24 to 85.5% in FY25—a 5.6 percentage point drop.

NCLEX-RN Performance – BSN and MEPN Programs (Table 11):

Because Arkansas has only one Master's Entry into Professional Nursing (MEPN) program, its NCLEX-RN data is combined with that of bachelor's degree (BSN) programs. The total number of first-time testers from BSN/MEPN programs increased by 141 students (14.4%), from 903 in 2024 to 1,044 in 2025. Despite this growth in volume, the pass rate declined by 3.8 percentage points, from 94% in FY24 to 90.2% in FY25.

Medication Assistant

Medication Assistant Training

In 2005, Act 1423 granted the ASBN the authority to certify competent individuals who completed approved medication assistant training programs and successfully passed a certification exam. This certification allowed a Certified Medication Assistant (CMA) or Medication Assistant-Certified (MA-C) to begin working in nursing home settings. In 2007, the ASBN expanded eligibility by allowing nursing students who had completed specific portions of a nursing curriculum, and who demonstrated competency in medication administration, to take the certification exam. In 2021, regulatory rules were revised to expand work settings for CMA/MA-Cs to include designated facilities in Arkansas. The ASBN defines designated facilities as nursing homes or local correctional facilities, as outlined in Arkansas Code Annotated (ACA) §12-41-107.

Further legislative progress occurred in April 2021 when Act 715 officially classified CMA/MA-Cs as Direct Care Staff. This designation allows them to provide care in Certified Nursing Facilities, as defined by ACA §20-10-1401 and §20-10-1402. Most recently, during the 2025 Legislative Session, Act 265, expands the scope of work for CMA/MA-Cs. Under this act, these professionals are now permitted to administer inhalation therapy (oxygen) and subcutaneous insulin injections, a significant step forward for the role.

Certification by Examination

Data for Arkansas Medication Assistant Training Programs reflects activity from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025. Certification exams are administered electronically via a computerized competency test. The Arkansas State Board of Nursing (ASBN) has approved D&S Diversified Technologies–Headmaster, LLP to provide examination and scoring services for the Medication Assistant Certification Examination. Exams are conducted using TMU®-connected personal electronic devices under secure proctoring.

The reported exam volume includes the total number of exams administered, not the number of individuals tested. Each candidate may take the exam up to three times. If unsuccessful after three attempts, they must repeat the training program.

Table 12 shows the growth of CMA/MA-C certification exams administered. In 2025, 336 exams were administered, which is an increase of 14 exams (4.2%) from 2024 and an increase of 141 exams (53%) from 2023. Eighteen (18) of the 336 exams were taken by student nurse applicants, a five percent increase from 17 in 2024 and a 113 percent increase from five (5) in 2023.

Table 13 lists the 11 approved programs. Of those 11 programs, four did not offer courses in 205 and had no exam candidates. Two programs closed due to low enrollment. Out of the 336 total exams administered by Headmaster in FY25, 310 were first-time attempts, and 288 individuals passed on their first try, resulting in a 92.9% first-time pass rate, up from 84.9% in 2024 – an 8.9 percentage point increase. Of those 336 exams, 26 were taken by individuals repeating the exam after failing a prior attempt (note: those 26 exams include multiple attempts by the same person).

Medication Assistant

Upon successful completion of the exam, individuals are awarded certification. Because individuals may retest up to three times, repeat pass rates are reported by program rather than at the statewide level. In addition, individuals who retest and successfully pass, are issued a certification the fiscal year upon passing the exam. The growth of CMA/MA-C certifications is listed in Table 14. In 2025, 294 certifications were issued. This is an increase of 30 (10.7%) certifications from 2024 and an increase of 165 (78%) more certifications from 2023 (Table 14).

Certifications Issued by Endorsement

Individuals certified as Medication Assistants (CMA/MA-C) in another state or territory may apply for certification in Arkansas by endorsement, provided their program meets Arkansas standards. Applicants must submit:

- An endorsement application
- Verification of their original certification sent directly to the ASBN
- Employer verification of nursing home employment
- Completion of the ASBN Scope of Work course with a minimum score of 80% on post-test

The growth of CMA/MA-C endorsements is shown in Table 15. In 2025, seven endorsements were granted, up from five in 2024 (a 33% increase) and up from one in 2023 (a 150% increase).

Certifications Issued by Renewal

Arkansas Medication Assistants must renew their certification biennially. Renewal applications must be submitted within 60 days prior to expiration. To be eligible, CMAs must:

- Be listed in good standing on the Arkansas Certified Nurse Aide Registry
- Be currently employed as a CMA/MA-C
- Have completed eight (8) hours of ASBN-approved continuing education during the renewal period

The growth of CMA/MA-C renewals is listed in Table 16. In 2025, 246 renewals were completed, which is a 56% increase from 138 in 2024, and a 138% increase from 45 in 2023.

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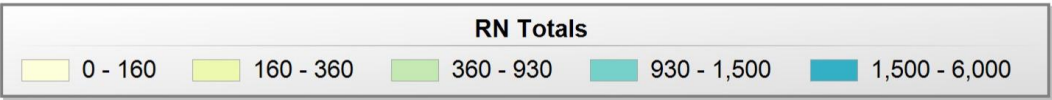
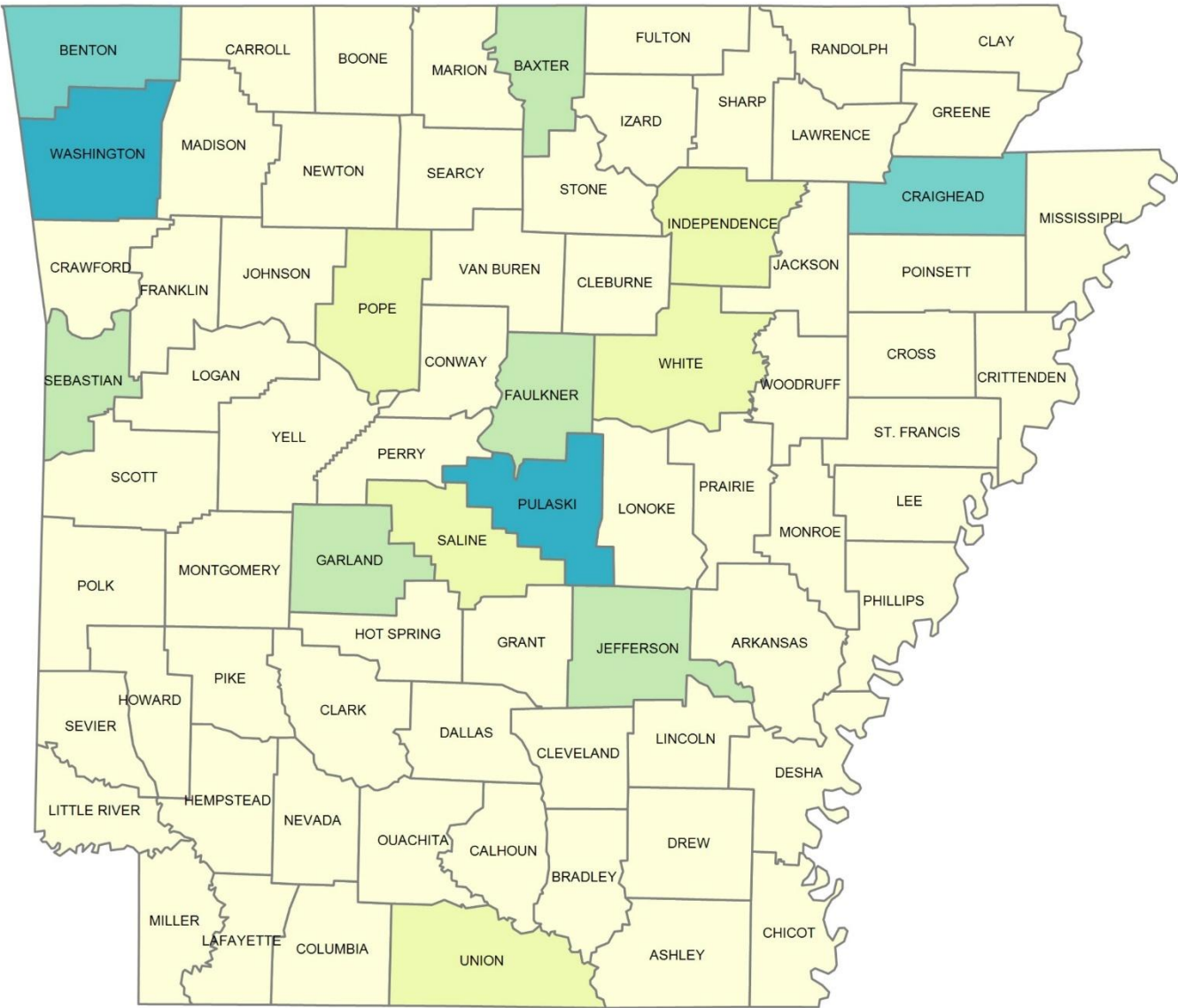

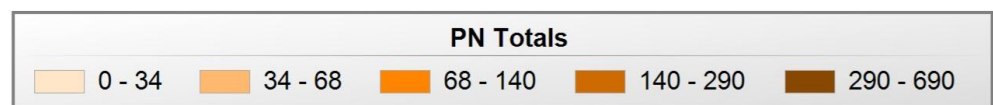
