New Laws Require Revision of Licensing Rules

Changes in state laws made during the 2023 legislative session will necessitate revisions to occupational licensing rules including the Arkansas Department of Health’s Rules Pertaining To Water Operator Licensing (Rules). This is the third legislative session in a row that has resulted in new laws requiring revisions to these Rules. The laws that affect these Rules also affect most if not all other occupational licenses administered by State government. Specific details are as follows below.

Act 137 of 2023, titled “An Act to Amend the Arkansas Occupational Licensing of Uniform Service Members, Veterans, and Spouses Act of 2021; ...”, updated Section 17-4-107 of Arkansas State Code to require acceptance of relevant national certifications of licensure applications.

Act 457 of 2023, titled “An Act to Create the Occupational Licensure for Out-of-State Licensure Act; ...”, added Sections 17-7-101 through 17-7-106 of Arkansas State Code to require licensure be granted to applicants that hold equivalent licensure in another State, Territory or District of the United States. The applicant must also meet other requirements such as being in good standing with the current license and not having a disqualifying criminal offense.

The Engineering Section is relying upon legal assistance from within the Arkansas Department of Health to ensure correct language is being used to modify the Rules so that the requirements of the two legislative Acts are correctly incorporated.

The process of revising the Rules to address the requirements of these Acts takes time and has several required steps. The first step in the process was completed by receiving approval from the Arkansas Board of Health to initiate the

Rules change process at their October 26, 2023 meeting.

Previously, the Engineering Section discussed the proposed Rule changes with the Arkansas Drinking Water Advisory and Operator Licensing Committee during their October 2023 meeting.

The next step is submitting the proposed Rule to the Governor’s office for review and approval before scheduling a public comment period and a public hearing to receive comments on the changes. After the comments are received and addressed, review by Legislative committees is required before eventually concluding with final approval by the Board of Health and filing of the new effective date for the revised Rule.

During the Rule change process, this newsletter will be used to communicate to the regulated community the language of the proposed revisions and update the regulated community concerning the progress of the Rules revision process. 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SERVICE LINE INVENTORY ASSISTANCE

The Arkansas Department of Health and Department of Agriculture have partnered to contract with Horner & Shifrin, Inc. (H&S) to provide no-cost assistance to small and medium water utilities to assist in developing their service line inventories as required under the federal Lead and Copper Rule Revisions.

To date, more than 200 water systems have requested this assistance, and any water system serving a population of less than 50,000 is eligible to apply. Any water system may apply through the Natural Resources Division of the Arkansas Department of Agriculture to direct funding assistance for water service line inventory or lead service line replacement projects.

H&S will start by gathering all available digital data and reviewing available paper records to compile as much information as possible regarding the system's service lines. Next, field technicians will go door-to-door to residences to physically inspect water service lines. Pipe material will be noted and uploaded to a GIS system that will be provided to water departments at the end of the survey, and a full inventory spreadsheet will be created to meet the State and EPA requirements. Assistance is also available to communities in developing a plan to address any lead service lines and seek their replacement.

TEN STATES STANDARDS FOR WATERWORKS UPDATED

The 2022 Edition of "Recommended Standards for Waterworks" by the Great Lakes – Upper Mississippi River Board (GLUMRB), commonly known as "Ten States Standards" has been officially published and adopted. Copies, both print and digital, are available for purchase from the Minnesota Department of Health's Bookstore at:

The ADH Engineering Section uses these Standards along with AWWA and ASTM standards as design guidelines for improvements to public water systems and has begun utilizing the 2022 Edition during plan review. Consulting Engineers, Utilities and others involved in the design/operation of public water systems are strongly encouraged to obtain a copy of the 2022 Edition of Ten States Standards and become familiar with the revisions as there are several changes/updates from the 2018 to the current 2022 edition. Some of the more notable changes are listed below:

1. A policy statement on Water Reuse has been added.
2. A policy statement on Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl substances has been added.
3. The previous Interim Standard on Ultraviolet Light Disinfection Treatment for Public Water Supplies has been incorporated into the 2022 standards.
4. A policy statement on Harmful Algal Blooms has been added.
5. A section on Arsenic Control has been added.
6. A section on Bulk Chemical Delivery has been added.
7. The section on Water System Interconnections has been greatly expanded.

REPORT OF THE Arkansas Drinking Water Advisory and Operator Licensing Committee

A quarterly meeting of the Arkansas Drinking Water Advisory and Operator Licensing Committee (Committee) was held on July 19, 2023, at the ADH Offices and utilizing virtual technology.

The meeting was called to Order by Jones, Executive Secretary. Jones asked everyone to introduce themselves starting with the Committee members, staff, and guests. (See above attendance notations) McAvoy then directed attention to the meeting minutes provided prior to the meeting. Rogers requested any corrections to the July 19, 2023, meeting minutes. The Committee had no corrections and Jones received a motion from Ford to approve minutes as presented, Lloyd provided the second and the motion was passed by the Committee. Jones referenced the need for the election of a new Chair and Chair-Elect based on the nominations presented at the previous meeting. A motion was received by Hammond with Ford providing a second for Lance McAvoy to serve as Chair, and the motion passed. Jones passed the gavel to the new Chair, McAvoy.

McAvoy received a motion from Lloyd and second from Hammond for Jeff Ford to serve as Chair-Elect, and the motion passed. McAvoy noted three (3) high school waivers were listed in the agenda, with Parker-Foster confirming the school waiver applications were ready to be reviewed by the Committee.

Dennis Watkins and Mayor Shawn Lane answered questions about Yellville Waterworks pertaining to the process, expectations, and high

school diploma waiver request for Watkins. Sweeney made a motion to approve the waiver, Hammond provided the second and the motion was passed by the Committee to grant the waiver.

Hunter Campbell from Elkins answered questions pertaining to the process, expectations, and high school waiver request he submitted. Mr. Campbell indicated that he was not currently working or seeking employment in the waterworks industry. McAvoy received a motion from Lloyd to deny the waiver, Hammond provided the second, and the motion was passed by the Committee to not grant the waiver.

Brad Monday answered questions about Central Arkansas Water pertaining to the process, expectations, and his high school diploma waiver request. McAvoy received a motion from Ford to approve the waiver, Lloyd provided the second, and the motion was passed by the Committee to grant the waiver.

McAvoy noted that two (2) criminal history waivers were listed on the agenda, with Parker-Foster confirming the criminal history waiver applications were ready to be reviewed by the Committee. Discussion about the criminal history waivers and further submitted information

commenced and a determination was made to not hear the criminal waiver requests as they were not required since five (5) years had passed from the completion of the court actions. Both applicants were allowed by the current Rule to pursue licensure.

The Committee further discussed the criminal history process with Rogers and Thompson pertaining to the 5-year criteria. ADH's legal team will assist with determining if future criminal history information meets the criteria to come before the Committee and provides due diligence for out of state charges with other jurisdictions and legal details.

Old Business

Bryan Smith, General Manager, Grand Prairie Regional Water was introduced to the Committee as a new official member. Rogers then reviewed the duties required of members of the Committee.

New Business

Parker-Foster updated the Committee on the Licensing Program and work to complete the annual report for SFY23 and the Report will be submitted to the EPA by August 1, 2023 deadline.

Committee Reports

Jones updated the Committee of the varied new PWS funding available from the federal government through the State Revolving Loan Fund (SRF). These include allocations for a supplement to the base funding, Emerging Containments and Lead Service Lines. The Section is currently working with the Natural Resources Division of the Department of Agriculture to get a contract for a service provider to help medium and small water systems get their service lines inventories completed October 24, 2024 deadline.

The Section has been busy with the review and implementation challenges from for several new and proposed EPA Rules such as the Lead and Copper Rule (LCRR) and Lead and Copper Rule Improvements (LCRI), MDBP suite of Rules, CCR revisions, PFAS, and cybersecurity.

Parker-Foster provided an exam report showing the Operator Licensing program administered 199 license exams between April 1, 2023, and June 30, 2023, with an overall 36 percent passage rate and 75 licenses certificates being issued. Administrative tasks, such as processing licensing exam results, licensing fees and license applications are proceeding with above normal numbers. The previous license renewal ended on June 30, 2023 and many applications were still being processed.

The enforcement report was provided to the Committee for this meeting. Eleven (11) systems were listed in Enforcement from January 1, 2023 through June 30, 2023. There was a concern about one of the systems that had gone before the Board of Health for review and no further effort has been made by the public water system to reach compliance. It was suggested that this item be brought before the next Committee meeting if no progress was made before then.

Rowe provided a written report for the Committee, stating that the Arkansas Environmental Training Academy was fully staffed but looking for an OSHA instructor. Act 605 Retail Water Provider Board Member Training was being conducted through traditional in-person, Zoom Video Conferencing, and self-paced online training classes. Training numbers were provided to the Committee for the 1st quarter of 2023 with 95 students and 105 participants trained over 15 classroom sessions.

Philipp provided a written report for the Committee, stating that Arkansas Rural Water Association provided 240 hours of water classes, with 464 training hours with 1,961 student class days taught to water operators from January through June 2023,

McAvoy commenced discussion to set the date for the next Committee meeting which concluded with scheduling the next meeting date for October 12, 2023, at Freeway Medical Tower in Little Rock, AR. McAvoy thanked everyone for the opportunity to serve as Chair of the Committee. With no further business for the committee, McAvoy adjourned the meeting.

The Arkansas Water Operator License exams are available at PSI Services (also known as AMP) computer testing centers as one of two methods to take license exams. Traditional paper exams remain available per the schedule included in this publication. The testing centers offer exams throughout the workday/workweek, with some centers available on Saturday. Before requesting a computer-based exam, the license application must be on file, you must have an unspent exam fee paid, and the mandatory training courses must be documented as attended (copies of course completion certificates have been submitted). Use this website: https://health.arkansas.gov/wa_engTraining/ExamType.aspx to request your exam. The request will be confirmed by email from the licensing program, a second email will confirm your exam has been approved. A PSI Services email will direct you through their exam registration process to arrange your date, time, and location for the exam. An additional facility use fee of \$69.00 is currently assessed and will be collected by PSI. Exam results are provided immediately following exam completion.

Water Licensing Renewal Update

The 2022-2023 Water Operator License renewal period ended June 30, 2023. A list of operators that have not renewed or informed our office of an intent to not renew is listed on the following pages.

Expired Licenses

Expired licenses – Licenses for operators who have completed all renewal requirements are considered expired as of October 1, 2023. In addition, renewals not received before

October 1, 2023, are subject to a \$5.00 renewal penalty, which will be assessed and invoiced. The penalty invoice serves as your individual written notice of non-renewal and that your license has lapsed and is currently invalid.

If you have paid for your license renewal and DID NOT submit a renewal contact information form (record of attendance/PWS/contact update) with your payment, your license has not been renewed.

If you have paid for your license renewal and have inadequate training documentation, your license has not been renewed.

Please contact the Licensing Program if you have submitted payment and the record of attendance form and have not received your license(s). Please send any correspondence to adh.water.licensing@arkansas.gov.

Next Renewal Period (2024-2025)

Licensed or OIT Water Operators are expected to obtain at least 24 hours of ADH approved training within the renewal period of July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2025. At least 12 hours must be Direct training hours. The remaining 12 hours may be Direct or In-direct to meet the total renewal training requirement. A license or OIT issued after July 1, 2023 may have the required hours prorated (monthly) to meet the License renewal requirements. At least one-half of prorated training must be Direct training. Also, mandatory training courses attended within the renewal period prior to passing the exam may be used as Direct training to renew licenses.
