Chairperson, Carol Moore confirmed that there is nothing that we can do for the counselors that don't have the adequate amount of in-person or interactive CEU credits, they will have the option of paying the late fee, getting the in-person hours, or reapply as a new applicant.

Board's administrator, Jacob Smith, stated that there is another new applicant seeking licensure who didn't have her applied behavioral analyst certification, we are seeking answers if the applicant gets the certification, would that meet the national exam requirements of this licensure.



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Attorney, Tawnie Hughes confirmed that once the applicant gets the applied behavioral analyst certification that this certification will take the place of the national exam.
