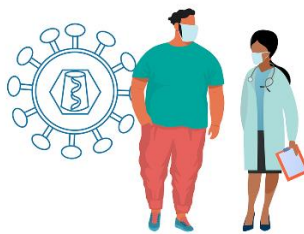




## Ending the HIV Epidemic (EHE) HIV Testing and Education

#### Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)

is a virus that attacks the body's immune system.

Taking HIV medicine **does not prevent transmission** of other sexually transmitted diseases (STDs). Condoms can help protect against other STDs.
