MEMORANDUM

TO: Applicant for Registration to Conduct Procedures with Controlled Substances

FROM: Nick Shull, Pharm.D., Section Chief Pharmacy Services

RE: Application for Registration Procedure

DATE: March 5, 2026

Attached is an application for controlled substances registration to be completed and returned to the address noted on application. In addition to the completed application, we need items:

1. A complete description of the procedure utilizing the controlled substances listed in your application.
2. A statement regarding the security and accountability provisions in order to prevent diversion.
3. A statement of sources of obtaining the controlled substances to be used in the procedure.

Applications to conduct Animal Training Procedures shall include in addition to items 1, 2, & 3, the following item:

4. A statement that certifies that the applicant is an officer or employee of a federal, state, or local agency who in the course of such employment is authorized to obtain and be accountable for controlled substances used for procedures authorized by this registration. The statement is to be signed by the certifying official of the agency.

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Application to conduct Animal Euthanasia Procedures using controlled substance shall include in addition to above items 1, 2, 3, & 4, the following items:

5. A signed and dated certificate of training by a licensed veterinarian.
6. Statements from local veterinarians stating no opposition to your proposal.
7. A statement that you will only purchase and utilize Schedule II and Schedule III non-narcotic medications that have a labeled indication for euthanasia. Additionally, you may stock one (1) controlled substance medication for use in chemical capture. Please provide us the name of the specific medication you will utilize for this purpose.

You must make application to the Federal Drug Enforcement Administration in addition to the Arkansas Department of Health. D. E. A. application may be obtained by going online to: https://www.dea diversion.usdoj.gov/online_forms_apps.html located on their website.
