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PREFACE

This report is based on information obtained by licensing boards during the 2024 license renewal process. Copies of practitioner responses to questions on license renewal applications were provided to the Arkansas Department of Health (ADH) Vital Record & Statistics Branch by the licensing boards. Because the data were collected by several boards using questionnaires designed to meet the licensing requirements of the individual professions, a certain consistency of format and content, desirable for manpower measurement, is missing from the data. Various items of demographic data, such as ethnic origin and sex, are obtained by some, but not all, boards. Information relating to a practitioner's location-address, city, county, state, etc.- meets the licensing board's need to communicate with the practitioner by mail and may or may not identify the site(s) where health-related services are performed.

The report includes tables, maps and graphs representing health professions manpower distribution and demographics in Arkansas counties. The 2020 Census from the U.S. Census Bureau, Population Division, was used in the computation of population ratios throughout this report.

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Acknowledgement: We wish to express our gratitude to the licensing boards of these professions for their cooperation in providing requested access to their license-renewal files.

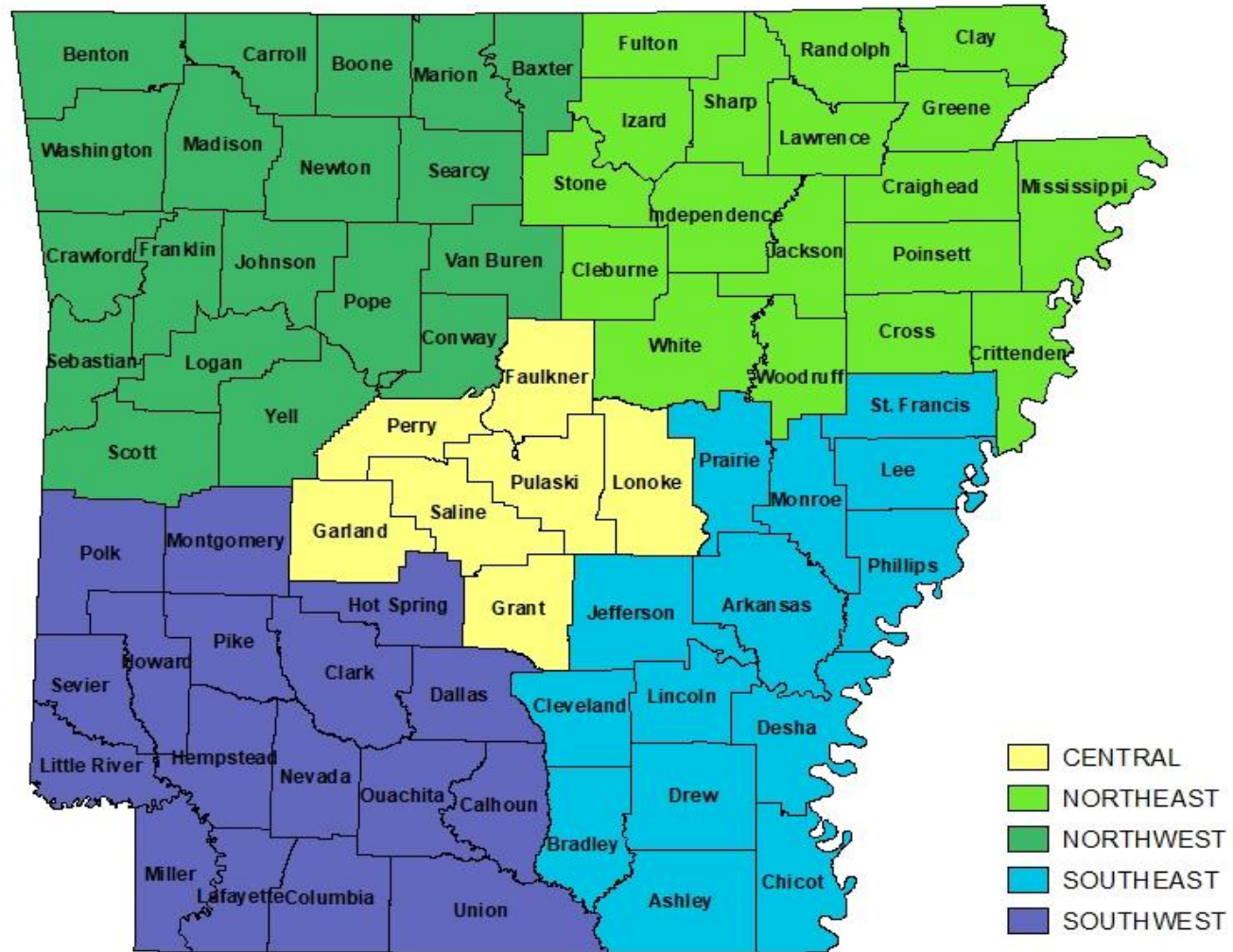
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Arkansas Public Health Regions

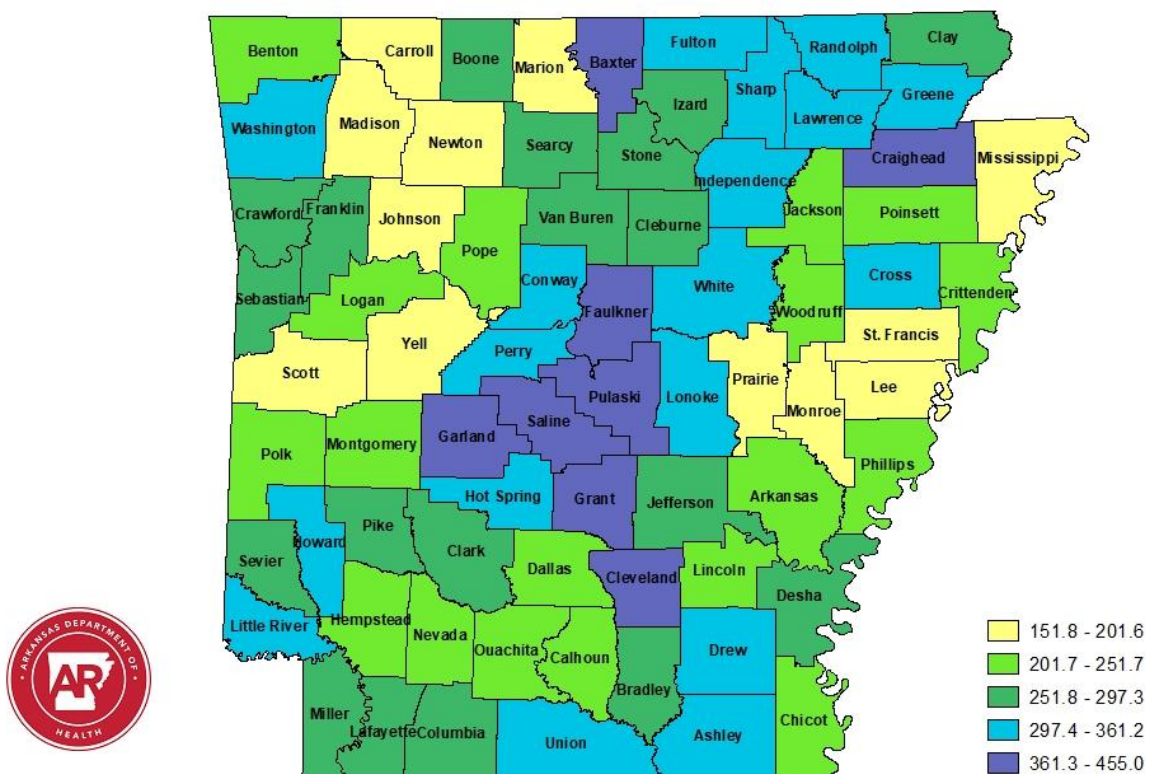

Health Professionals in Arkansas

In 2024, there were 99,735 licensed health professionals with Arkansas mailing addresses serving 3 million Arkansans, a population ratio of 322.9 professionals for every 10,000-population living in the State. The largest registration was by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing with 59,971 licensees, followed by the Arkansas State Medical Board with 14,086 licensees. The smallest registration was by the Arkansas Licensed Lay Midwife Program with 26 licensees. As a group, health professionals were distributed evenly across the counties with a heavier concentration in counties with larger populations.

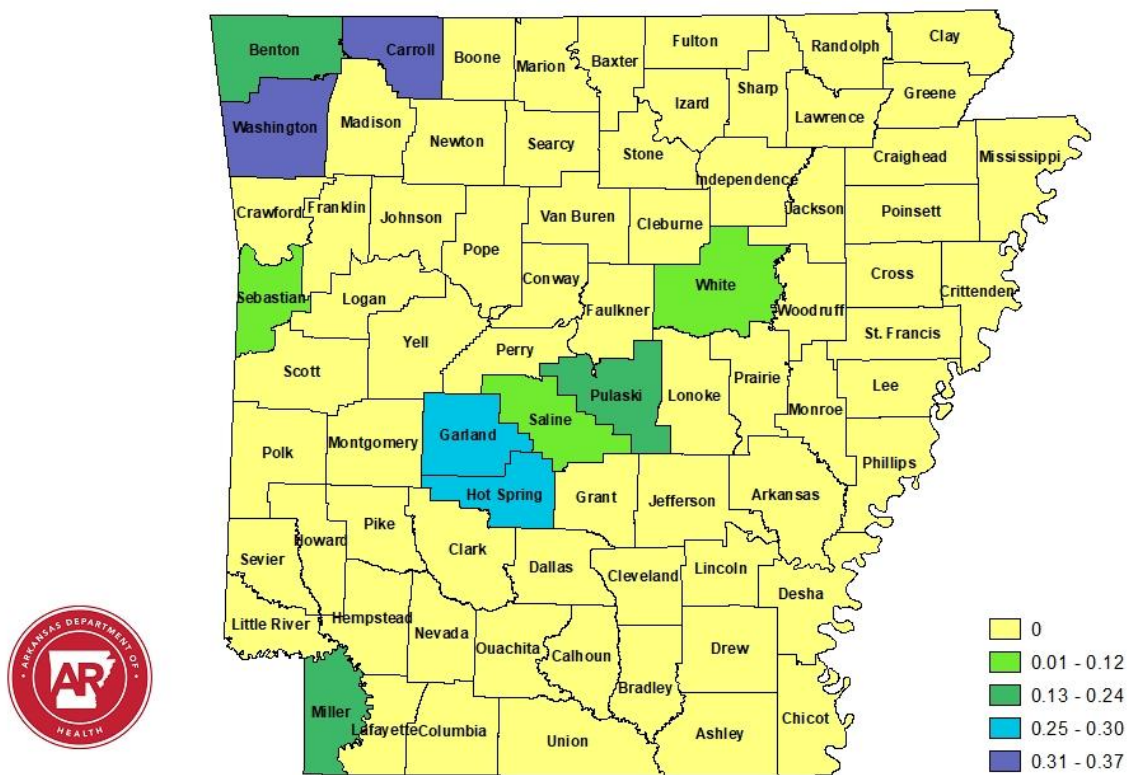

Acupuncturists & Related Techniques in Arkansas

In 2024, the Board of Acupuncture and Related Techniques licensed 36 acupuncturists with mailing addresses in Arkansas: about 0.1 per 10,000 population. Of the 75 counties in Arkansas, 65 counties (87%) had no registered acupuncturists, and 6 other counties (8%) had only one.

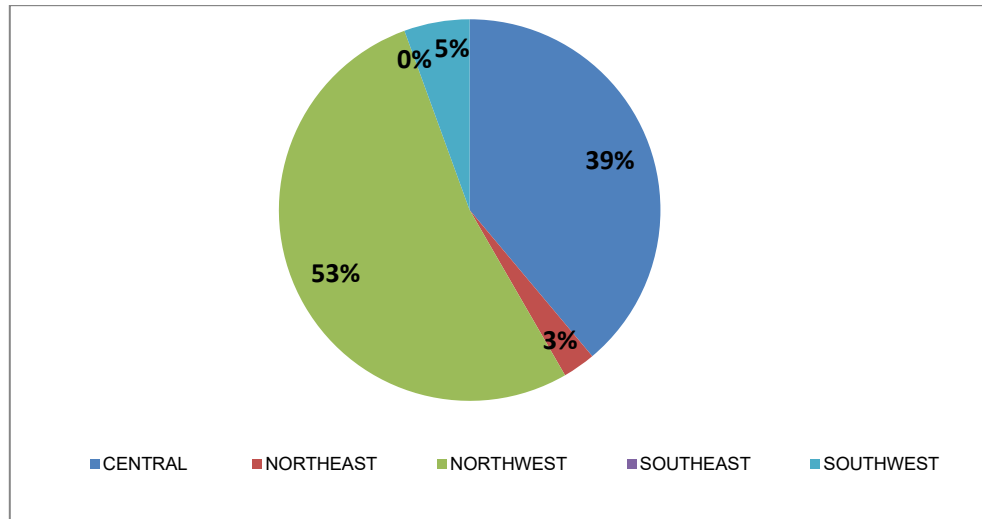
Acupuncturists by County Per 10,000 Population

Distribution of Acupuncturists by Region



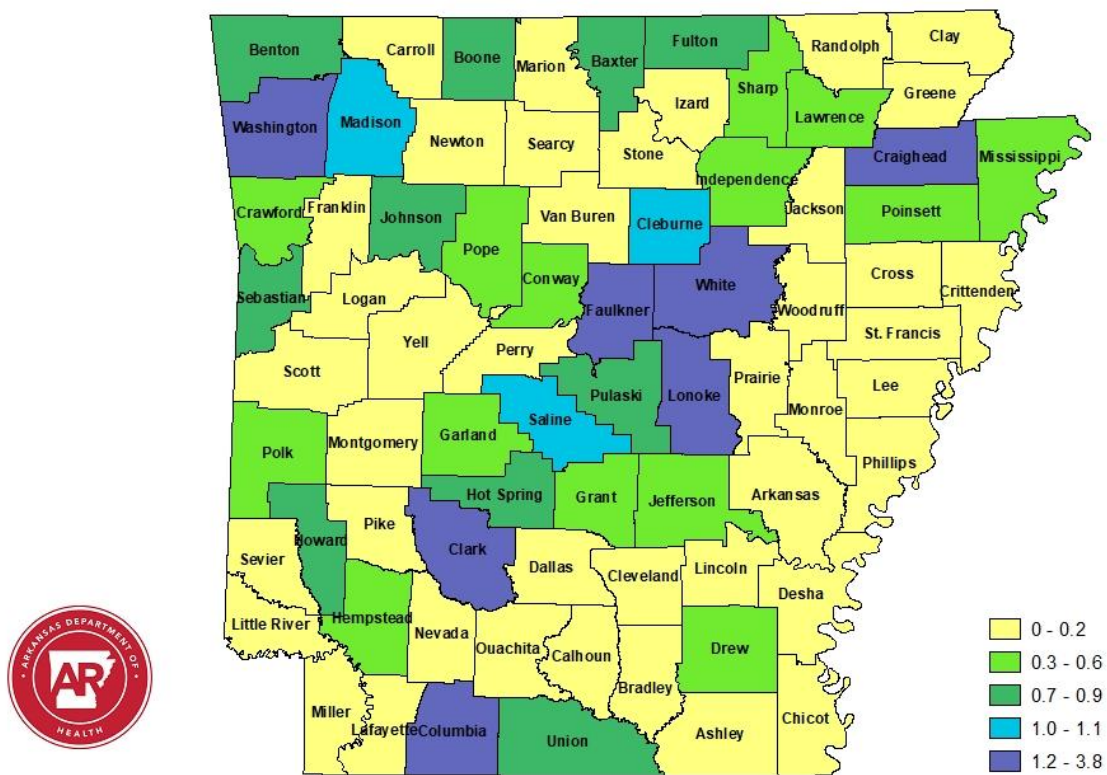

Athletic Trainers in Arkansas

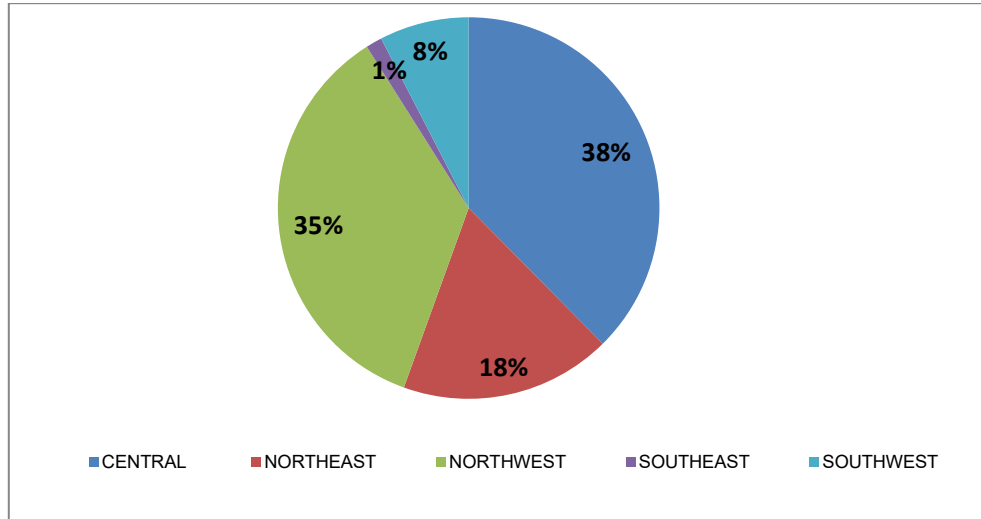
In 2024, the Board of Athletic Trainers licensed 290 athletic trainers with mailing addresses in Arkansas: about 0.9 per 10,000 population. Of the 75 counties in Arkansas, 38 counties (51%) had no registered athletic trainers, and 14 other counties (19%) had only one.

Distribution of Athletic Trainers by Region



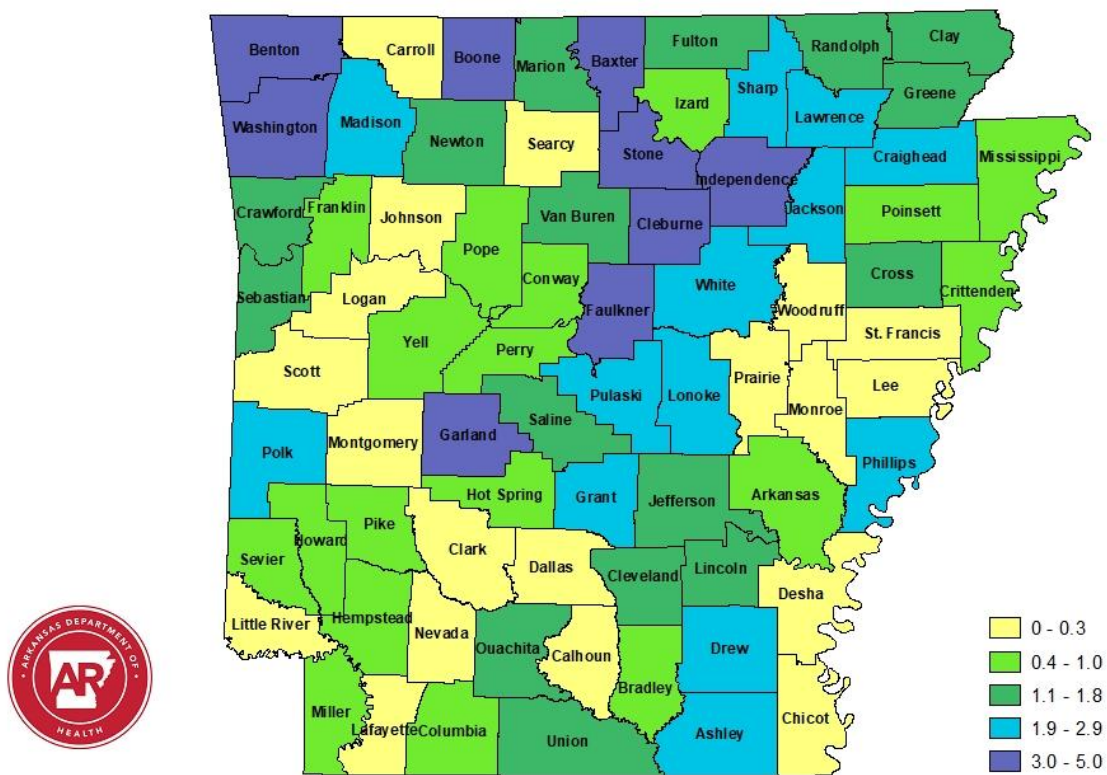

Chiropractors in Arkansas

In 2024, the Board of Chiropractic Examiners licensed 674 chiropractors with mailing addresses in Arkansas: about 2.2 per 10,000 population. Of the 75 counties in Arkansas, 17 counties (23%) had no registered chiropractors, and 15 other counties (20%) had only one.

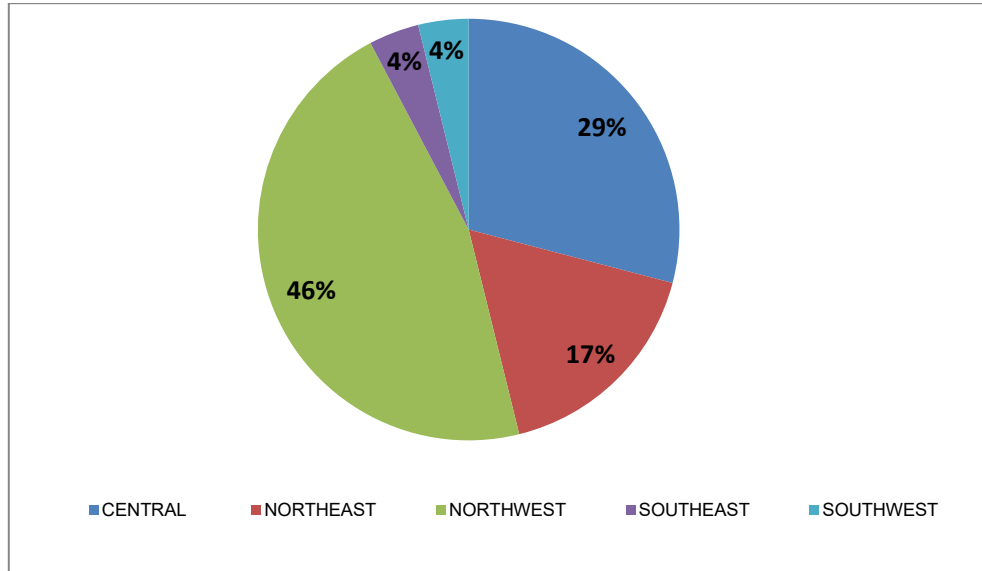
Chiropractors by County Per 10,000 Population



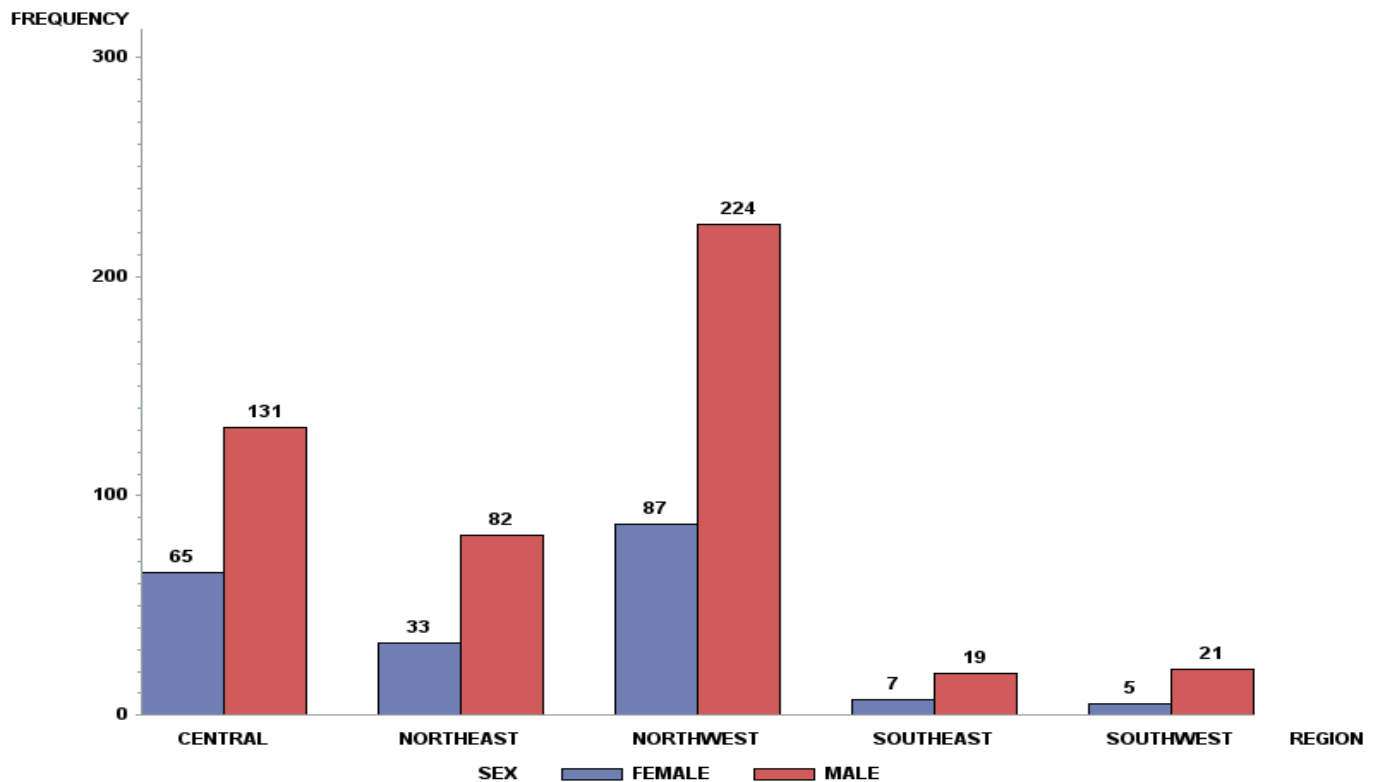

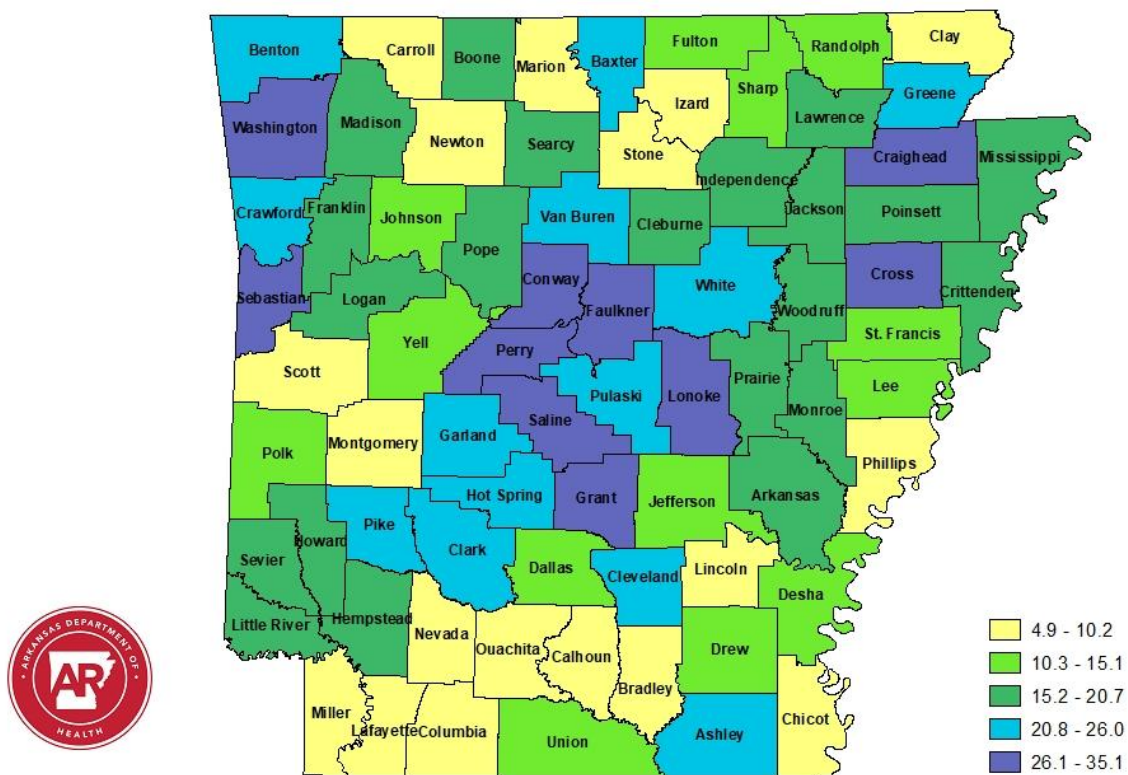

In 2024, the Board of Dental Examiners licensed 7,163 professionals of dental health services with mailing addresses in Arkansas: about 23.2 per 10,000 population. This total includes 1,421 dentists (DD), 3,837 dental assistants (DA), and 1,905 dental hygienists (DH). Overall, the number of dental health professionals decreased by 5.5% for the state. There was an increase in DDs of 3.3%, an increase in DHs of 7.2%, and a decrease in DAs of 13.2%. Each of the 75 counties in Arkansas had at least three registered dental health professionals, though it should be noted that dental assistants are included but have a limited scope of practice. Later in this section we will provide information on those considered primary care oral health providers only.

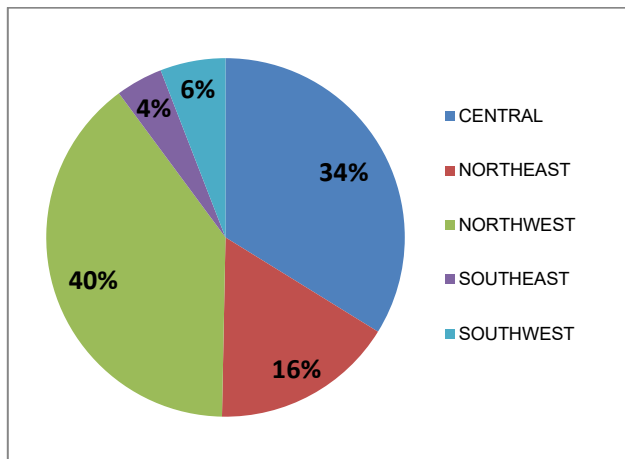
Dental Health Professionals by County Per 10,000 Population



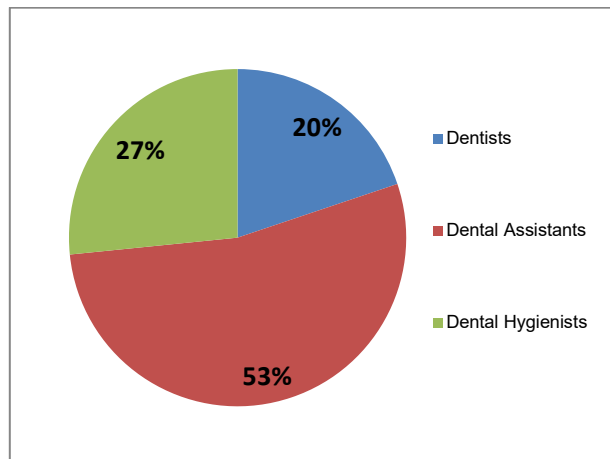

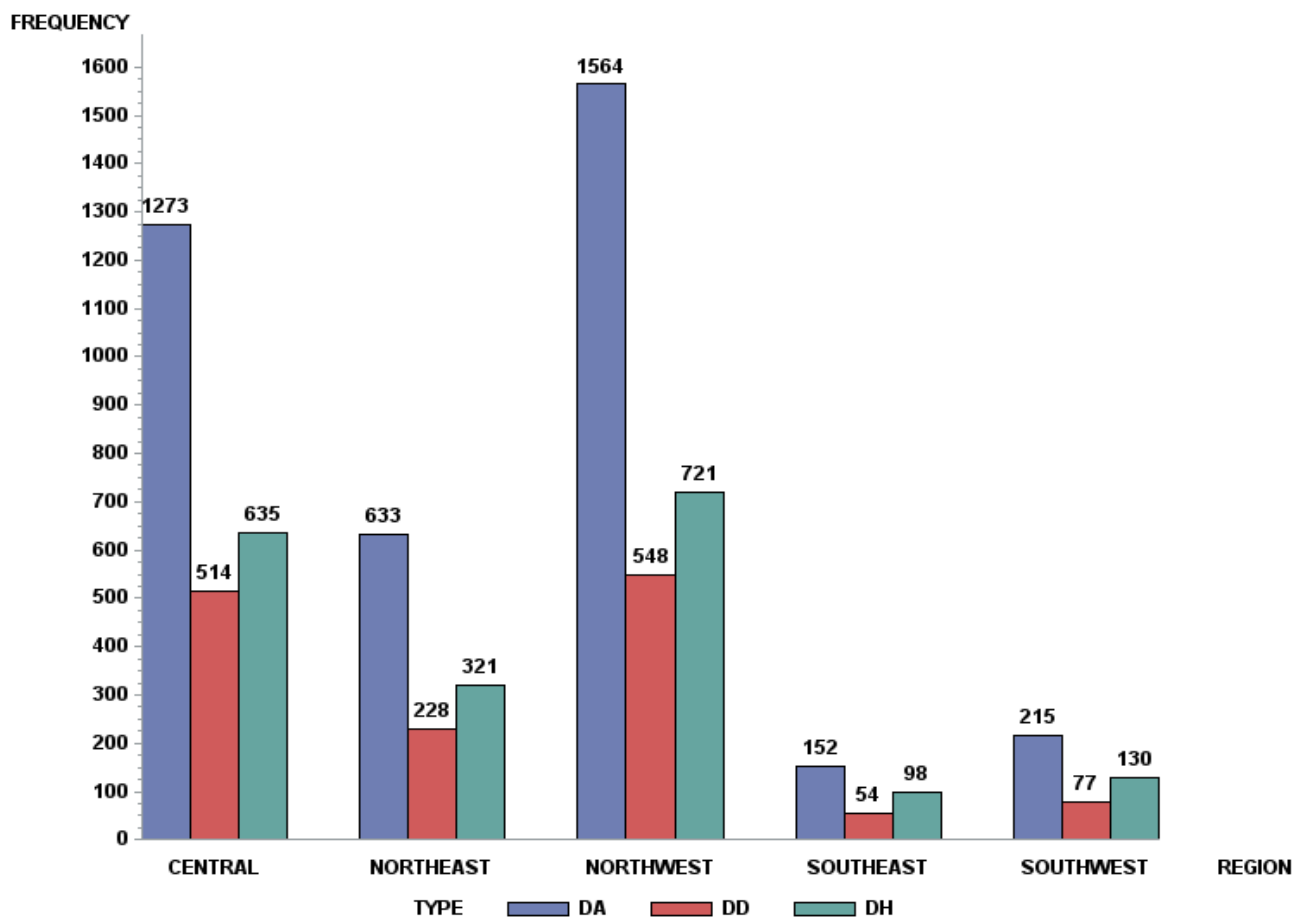
Distribution of Dental Professionals by Region



Distribution of Dental Professionals by Specialty

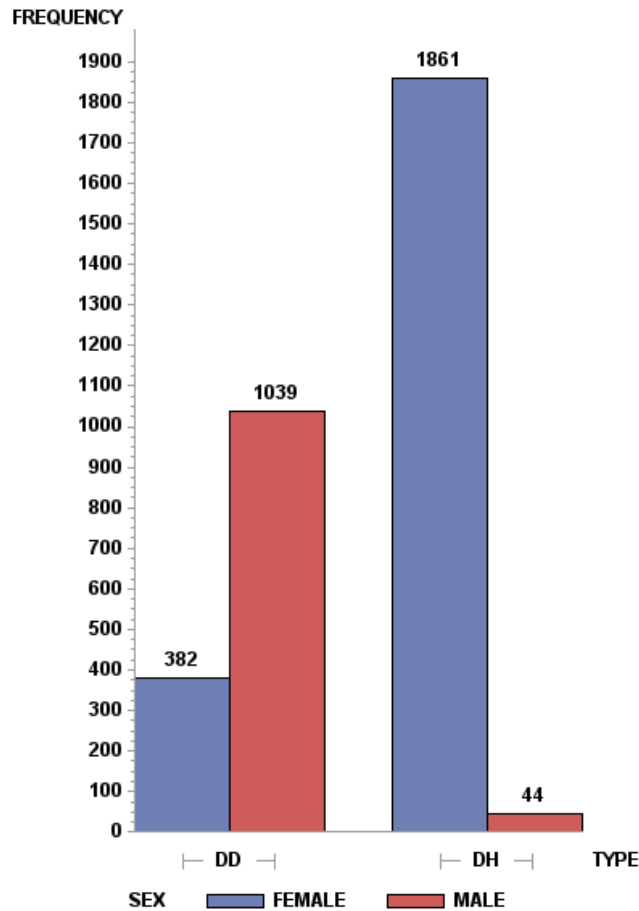


Dental Health Professionals by Region

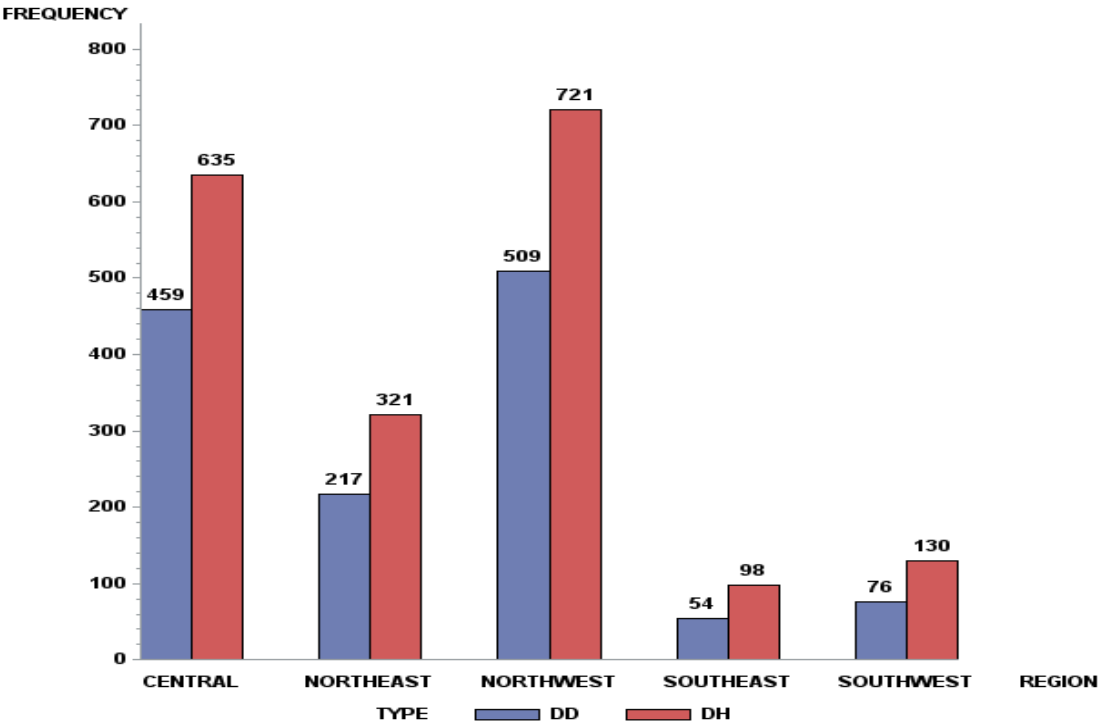

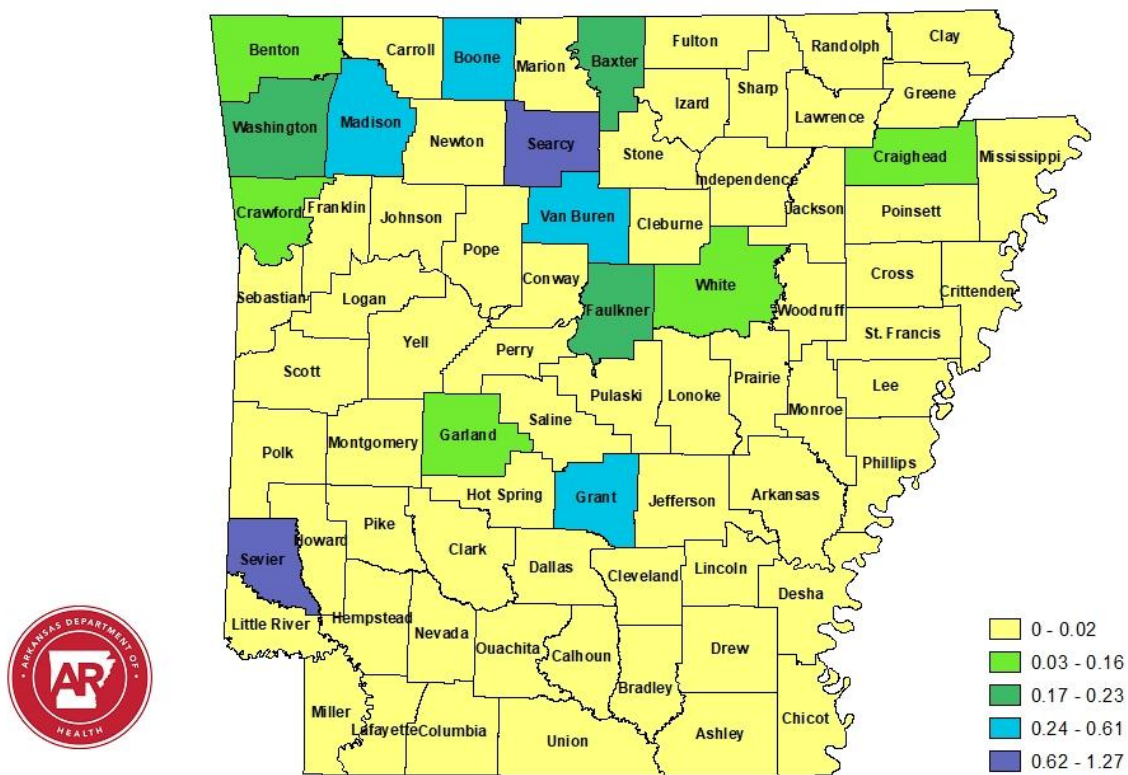

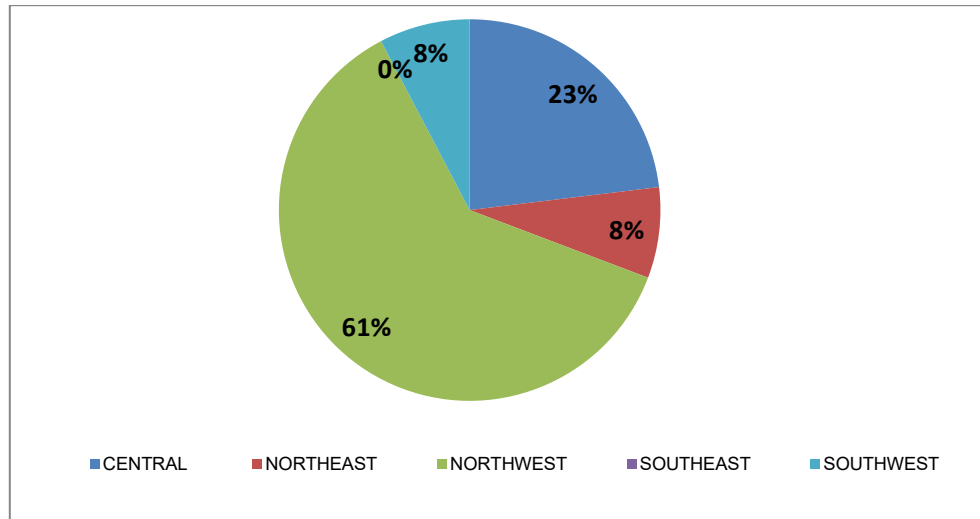
Licensed Lay Midwives by County Per 10,000 Population

Distribution of Lay Midwives by Region



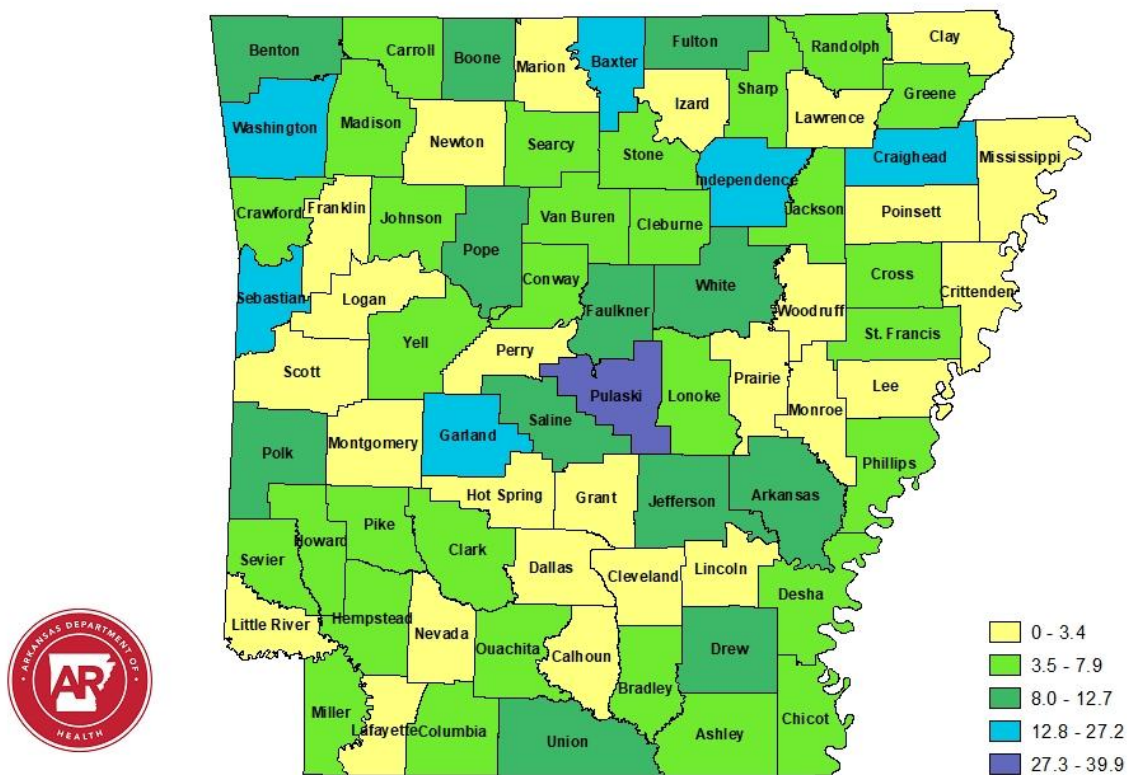

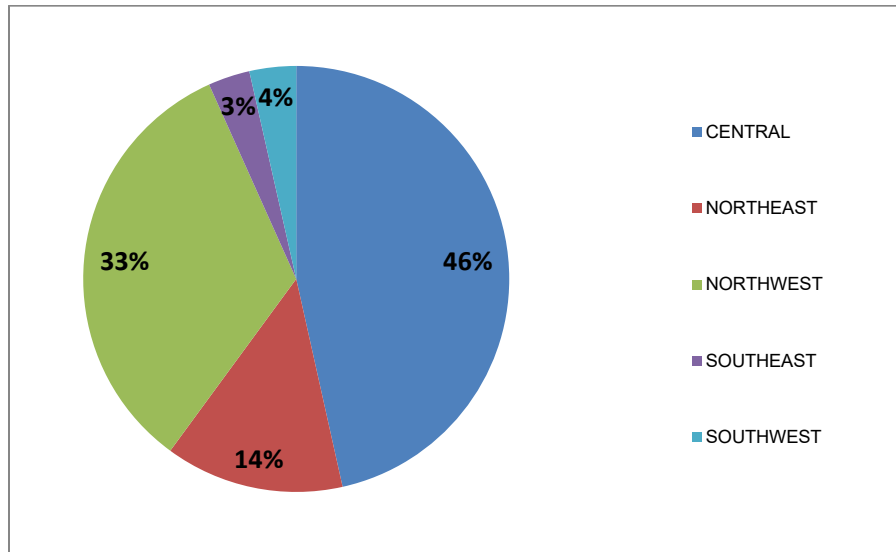
In 2024, the Medical Board licensed 14,086 health professionals with mailing addresses in Arkansas. The 2024 registry includes 4,578 physicians (33%) registered in five primary care specialties with mailing addresses in Arkansas; about 14.8 per 10,000 population. This list includes: 1,709 family practice, 71 general practice, 1,654 internal medicine, 344 obstetrics-gynecologists (OB/GYN), and 800 pediatrics. At least one fully licensed primary care physician was registered in each Arkansas county except for Lafayette County, which had none. The board licensed 3,152 physicians as secondary specialists and 33 physicians who reported no specialty. Also, the board licensed 6,323 health professionals as Health-Related Professionals. This total is made up of 1,933 Respiratory Therapists (LRCP), 2,107 Occupational Therapists (OT), 1,198 Occupational Therapy Assistants (OT-A), 746 Physician Assistants (PA), 6 Radiologist Assistants (RA), 4 Radiology Practitioner Assistants (RPA), 298 Surgical Technologists (ST), and 31 Licensed Genetic Counselors (LGC).

Primary Care Physicians by County Per 10,000 Population

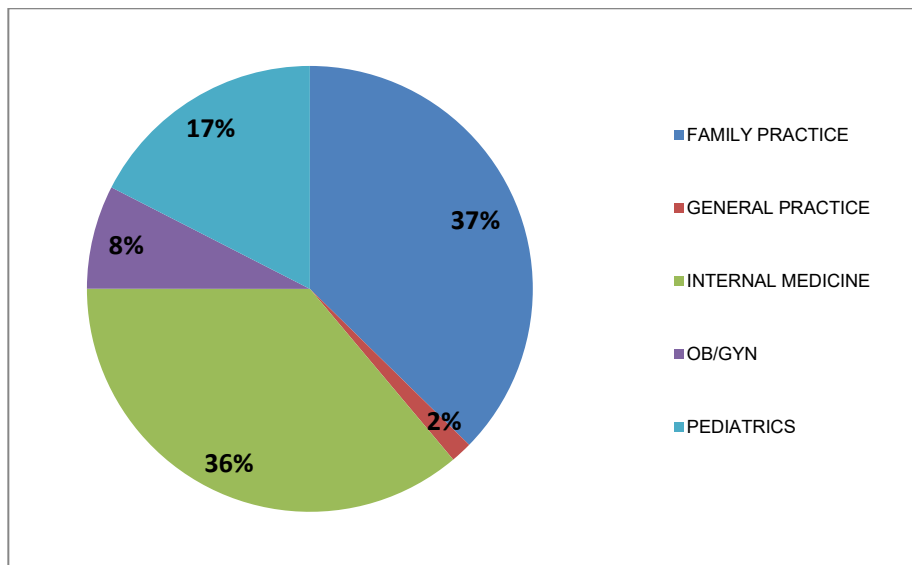

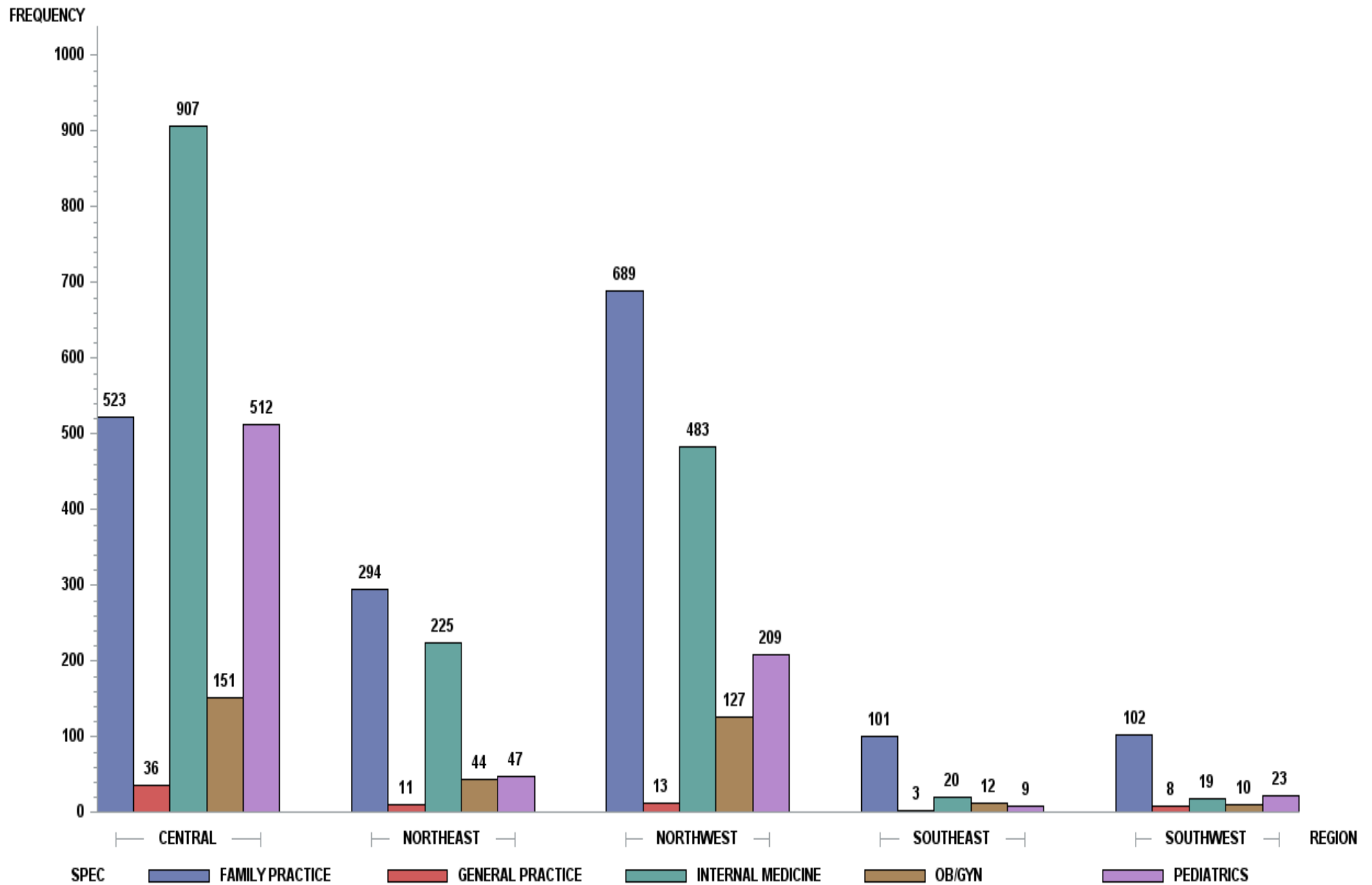
Distribution of Primary Care Physicians by Region



Distribution of Primary Care Physicians by Specialty

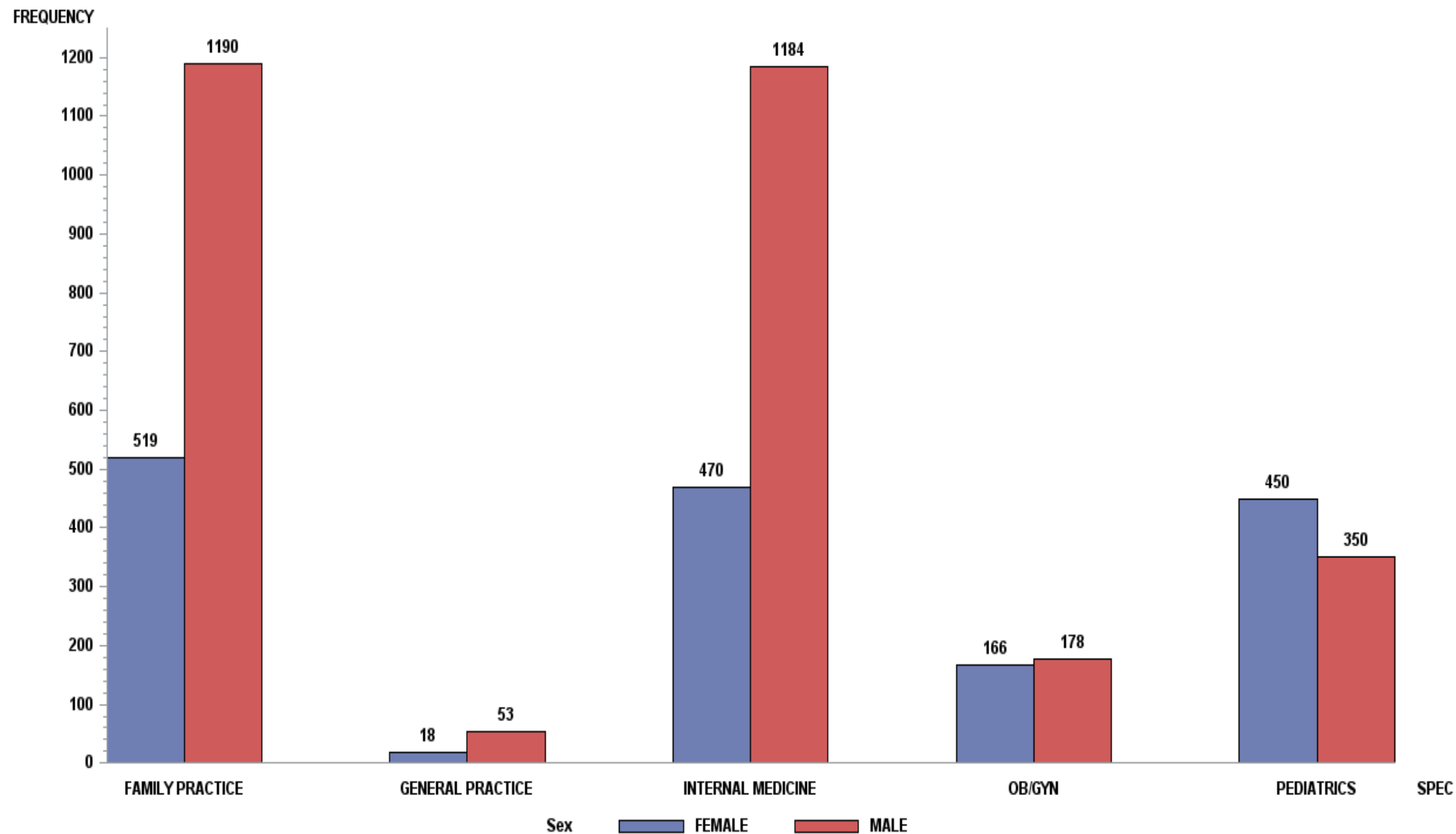


Primary Care Physicians by Region and Specialty

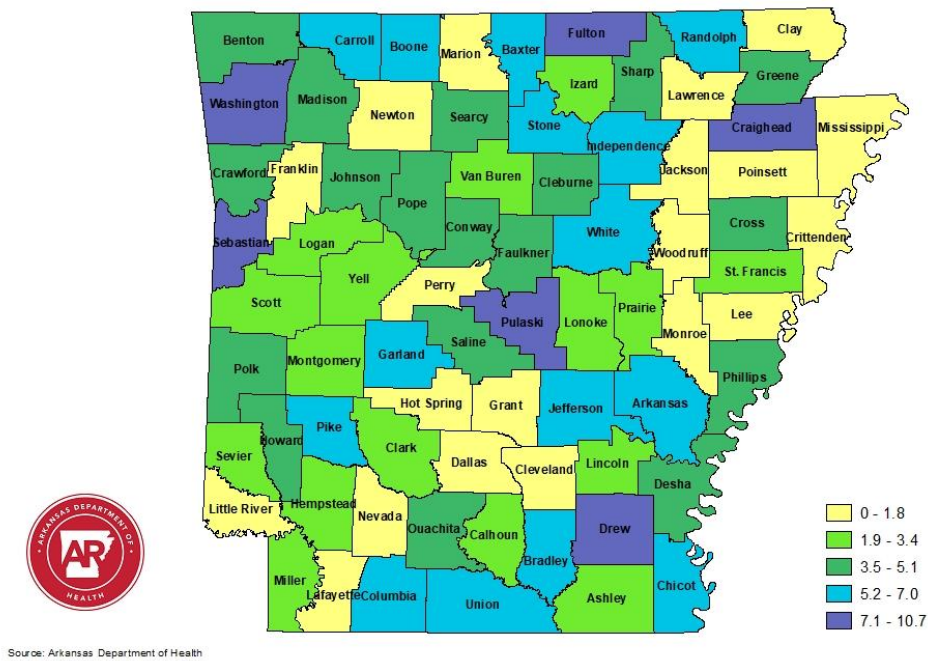
Primary Care Physicians by Sex and Specialty



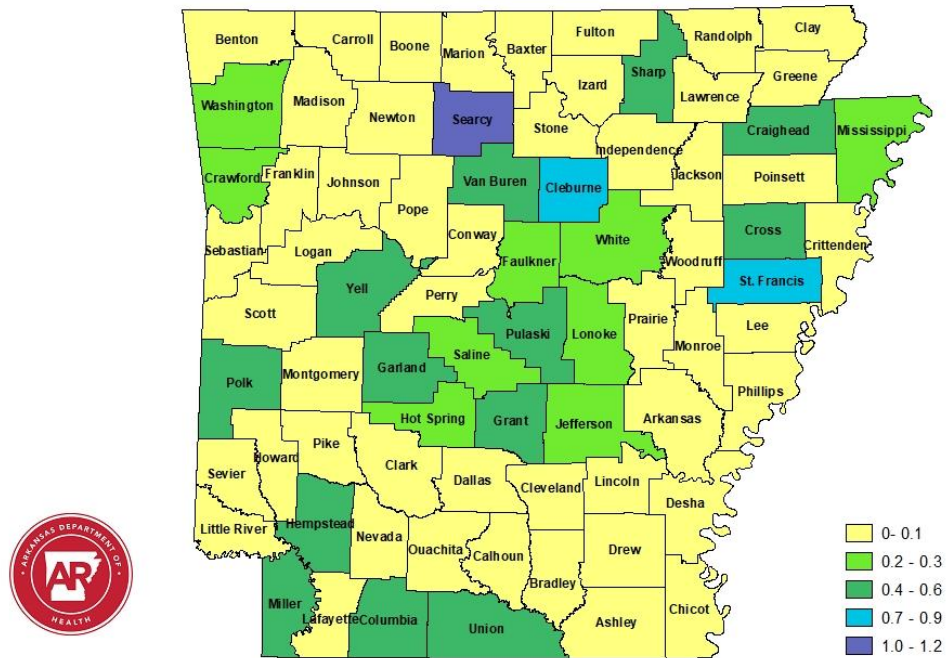

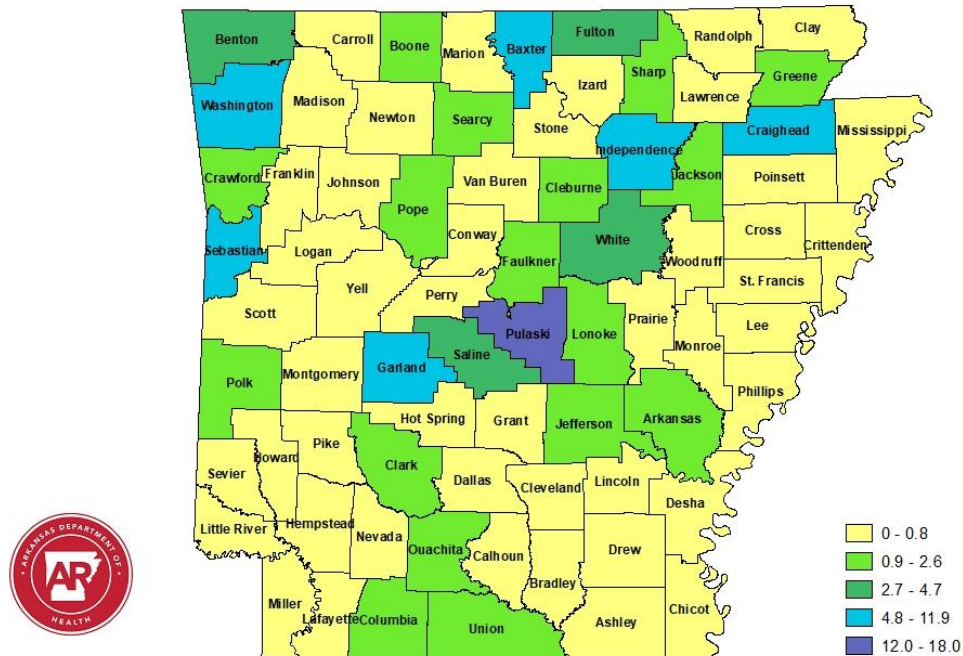
Family Practice Physicians by County Per 10,000 Population



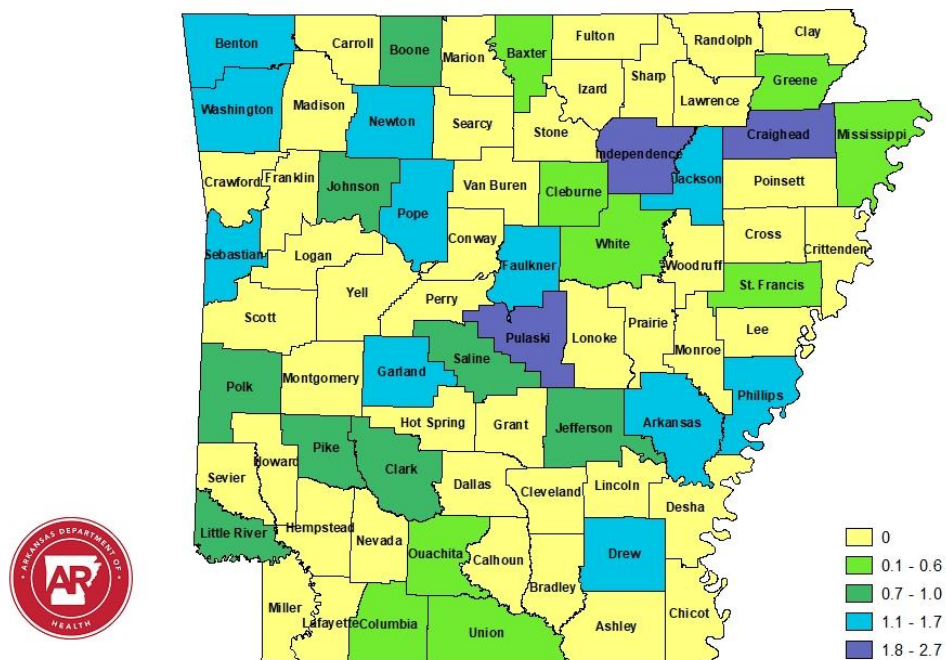
General Practice Physicians by County Per 10,000 Population



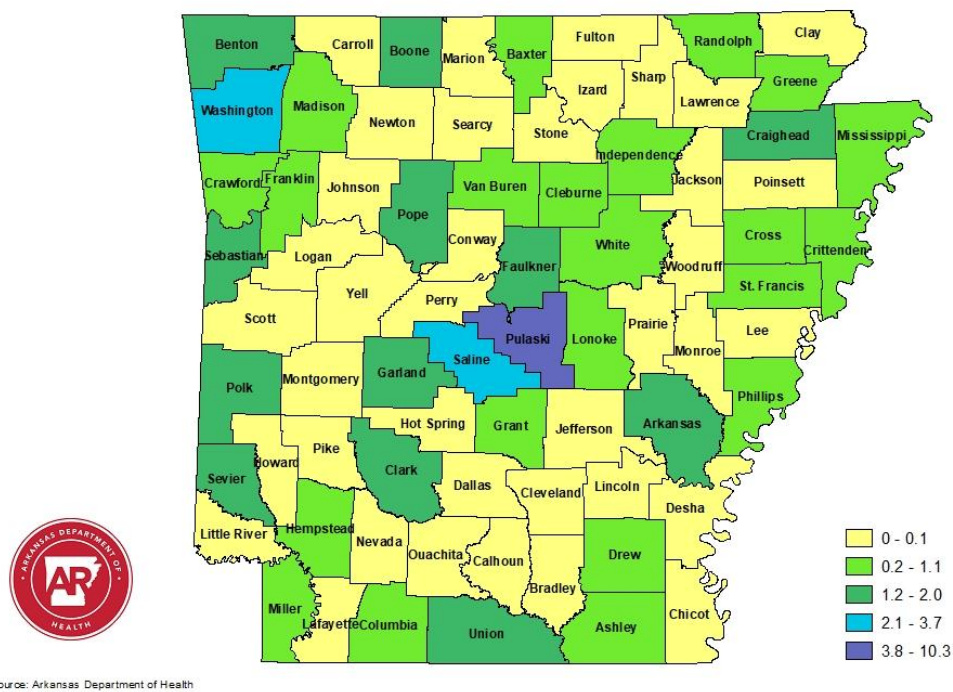
Internal Medicine Physicians by County Per 10,000 Population

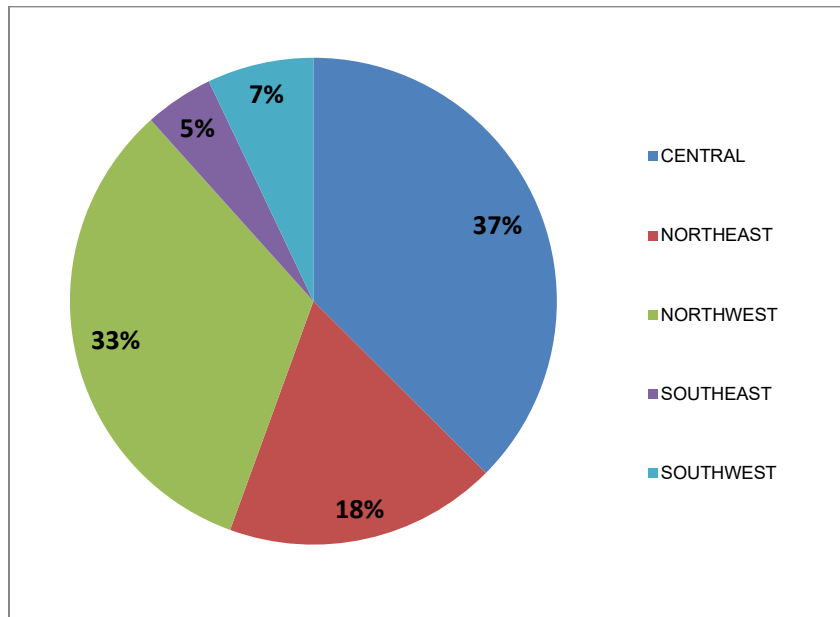

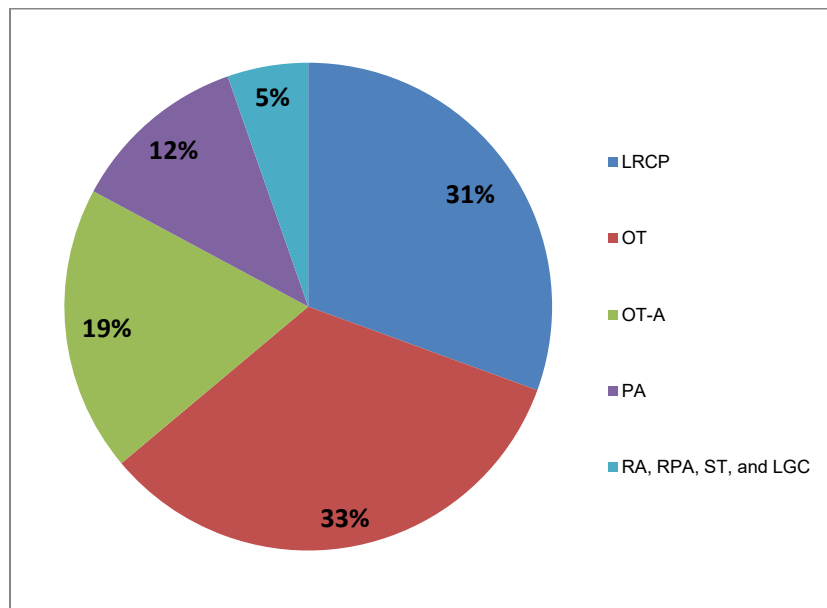

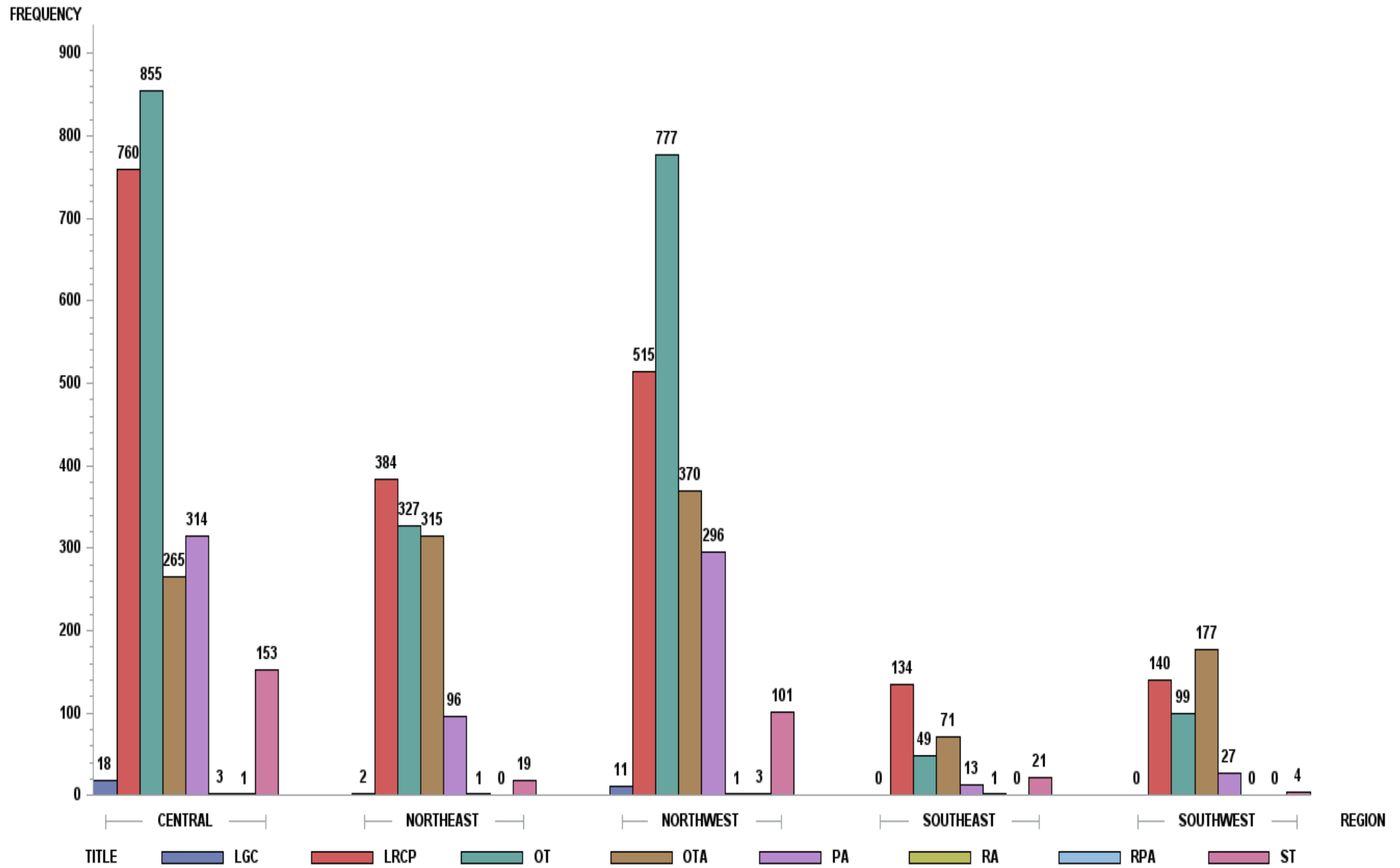
Health-Related Professionals by Region



Health-Related Professionals by Specialty

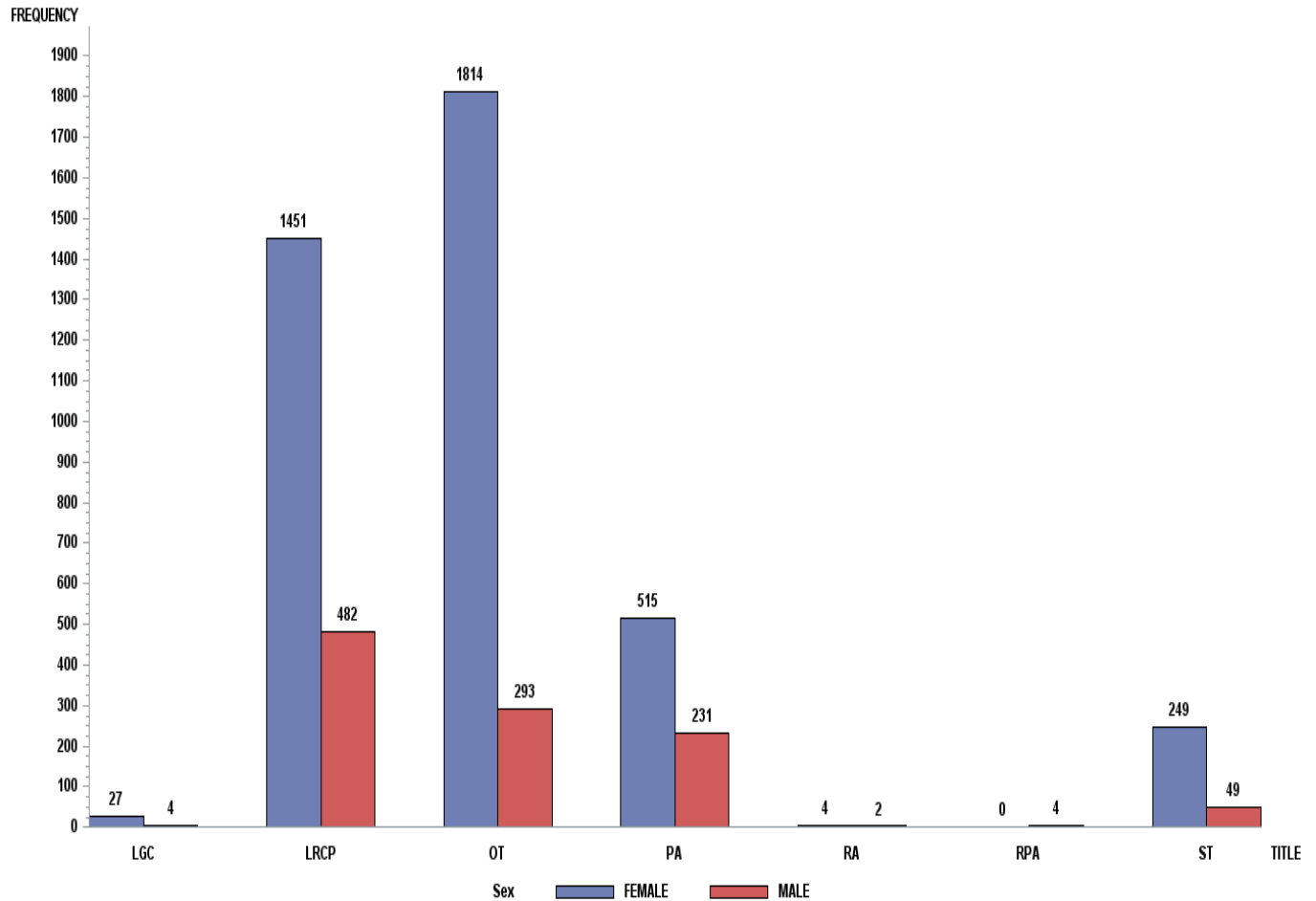


Health-Related Professionals by Region and Specialty

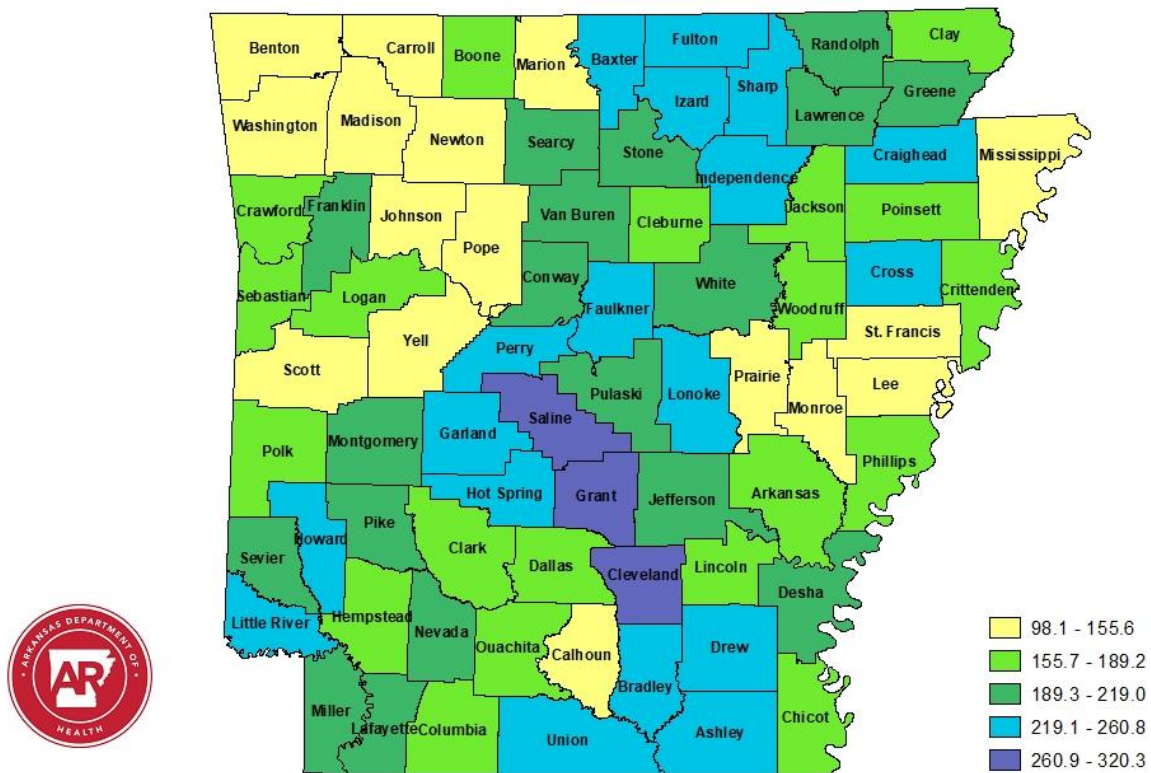

Nurses in Arkansas

In 2024, the Nursing Board licensed 59,971 nurses with mailing addresses in Arkansas, about 194.2 per 10,000 population. This total includes 41,364 Registered Nurses (RN), 12,713 Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN), 39 Licensed Psychiatric Technician Nurses (LPTN), and 210 Registered Nurse Practitioners (RNP). There were 5,645 nurses registered as Advanced Practice Nurses (APN). These 59,971 nurses had a total of 66,669 licenses, however for the purposes of this report, the following hierarchy was used to take the highest of the five license types: LPN < LPTN < RN < RNP < APN. The APNs consist of four different licenses but will be grouped together for most of this section. They will be broken down into individual licenses later in the section. The number of licensed nurses for the state increased 2.2% from 2023 to 2024.

After completing basic nursing programs, RN and LPN must pass nationally standardized examinations. LPTNs must have passed a state licensure exam. RNPs must complete a nurse practitioner program in addition to their RN program. To be licensed as an APN, an RN must complete an advanced practice nursing program and hold certification from a Board approved, nationally recognized, certifying body.

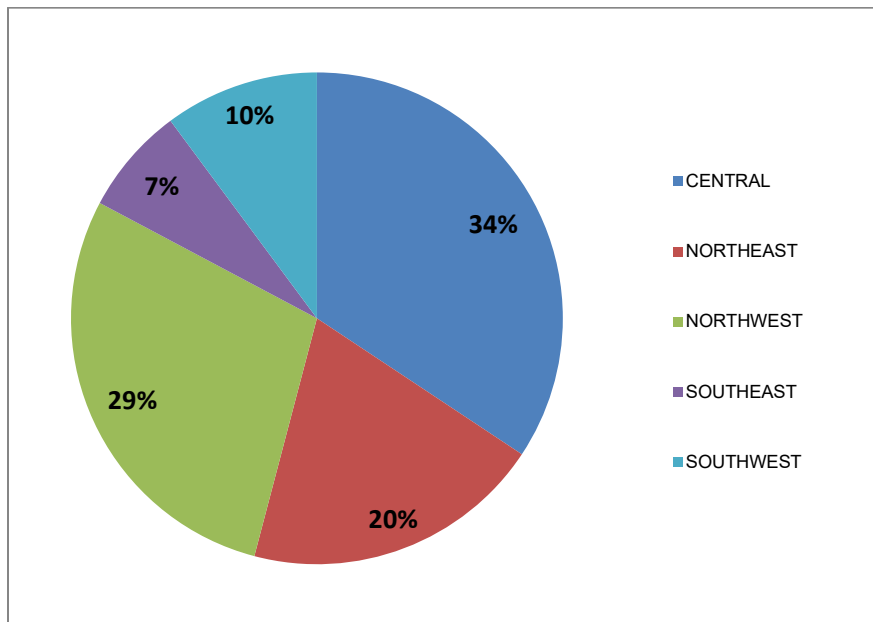
Nurses by County Per 10,000 Population



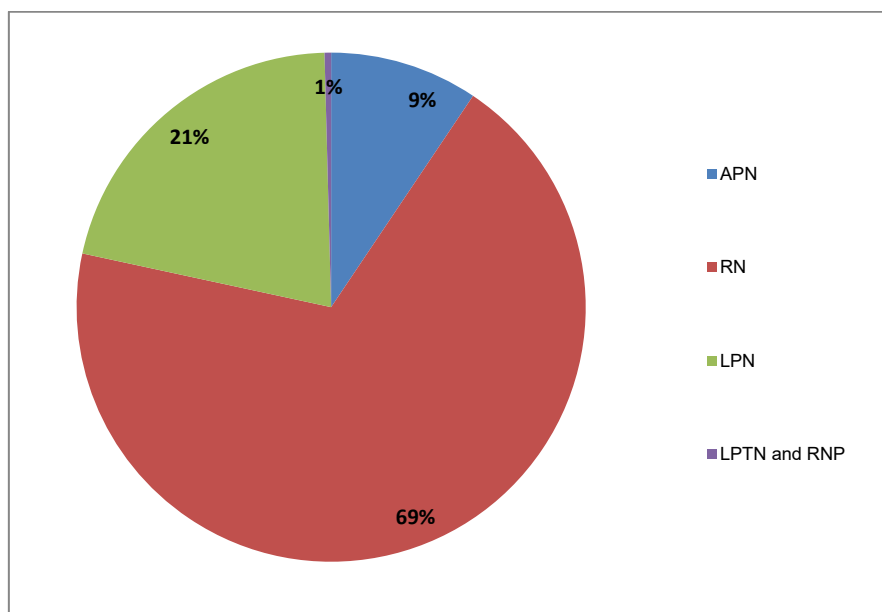

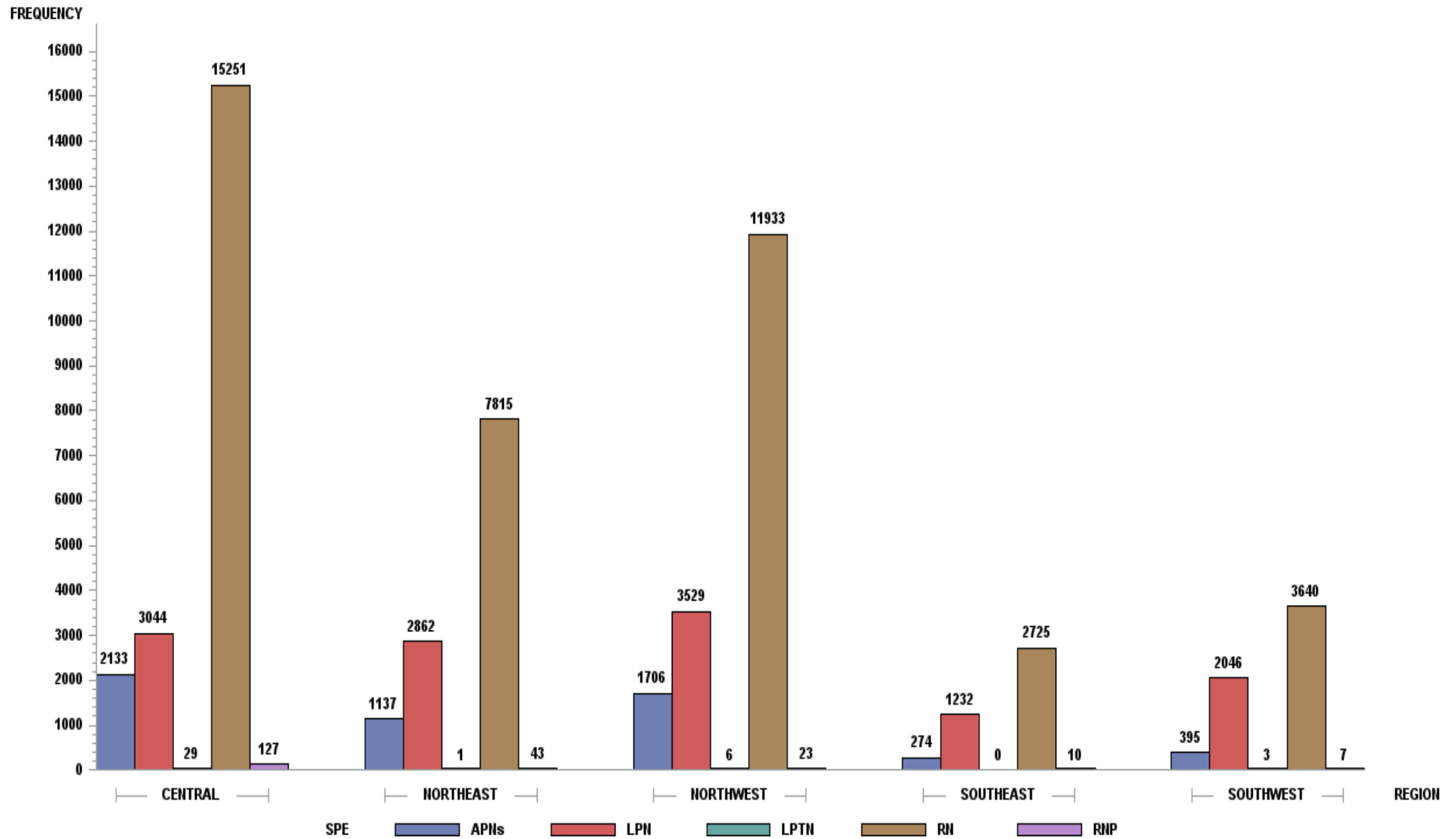
Distribution of Nurses by Region



Distribution of Nurses by Title

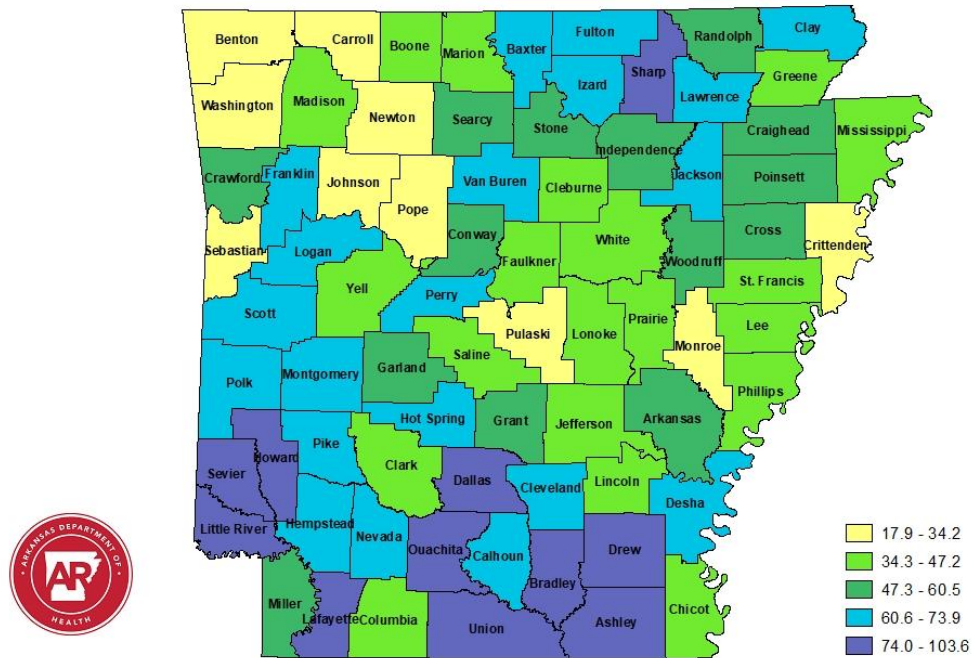


Nurses by Region and License Type

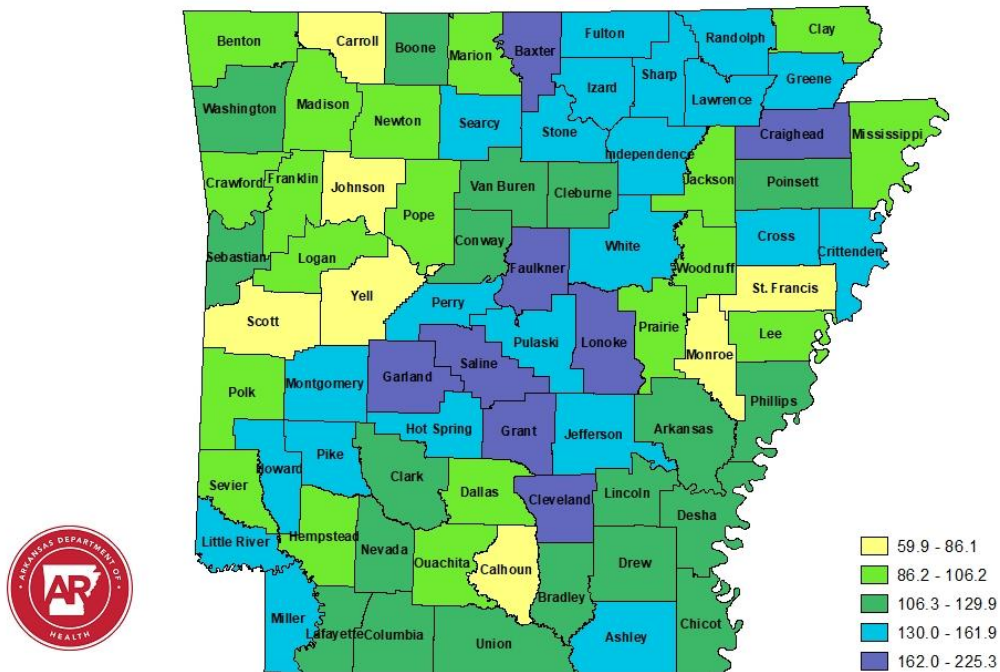

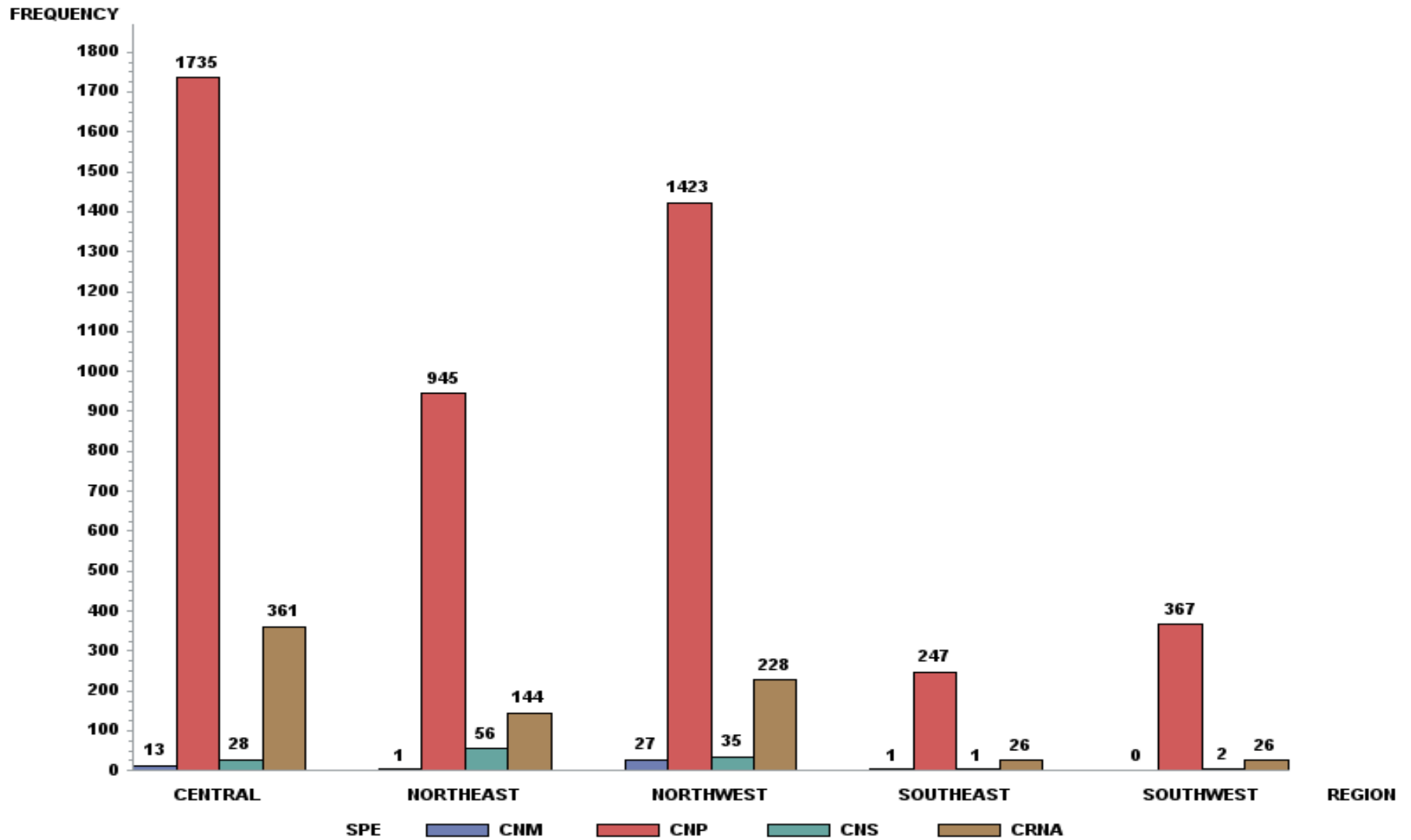
Map of Arkansas showing the number of U.S. Representatives by county. The map is color-coded according to the number of representatives, with a legend in the bottom right corner.

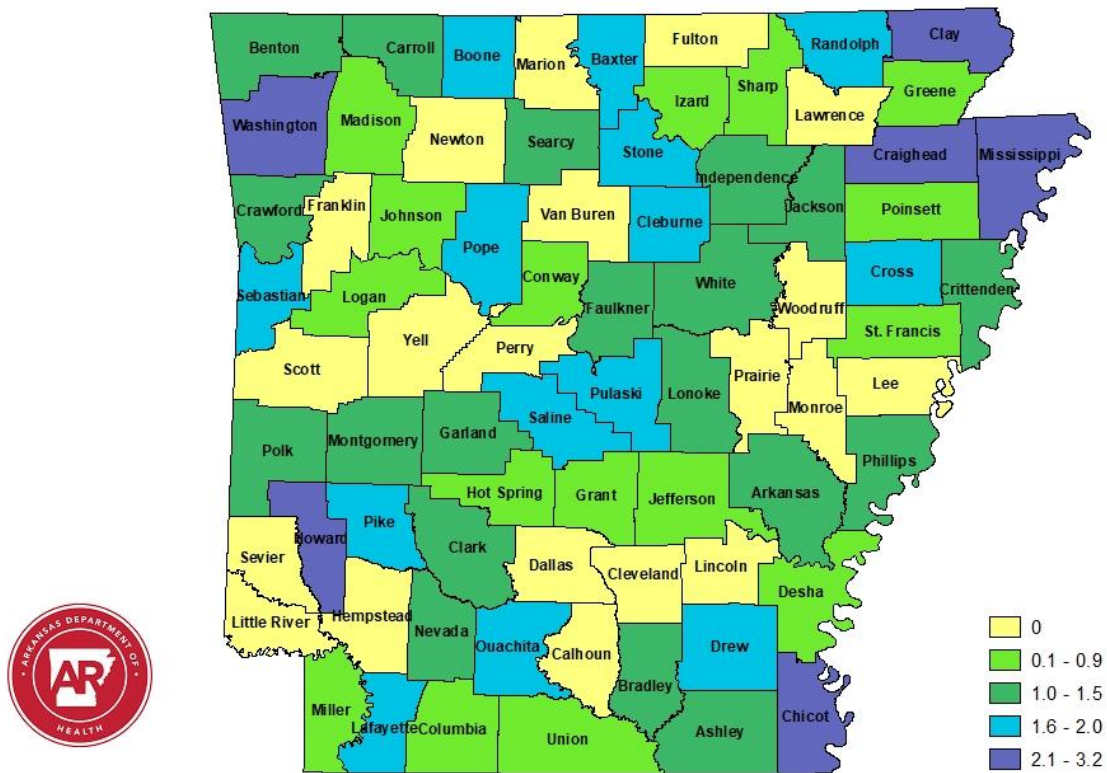

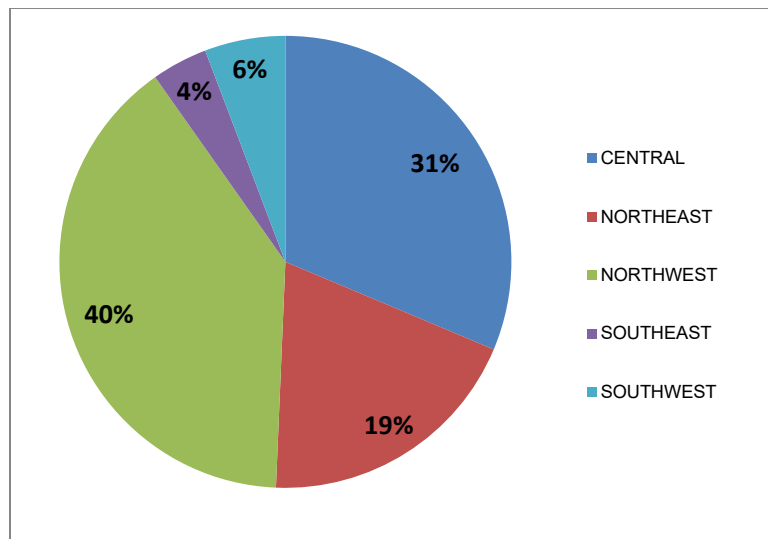
Optometrists by County Per 10,000 Population



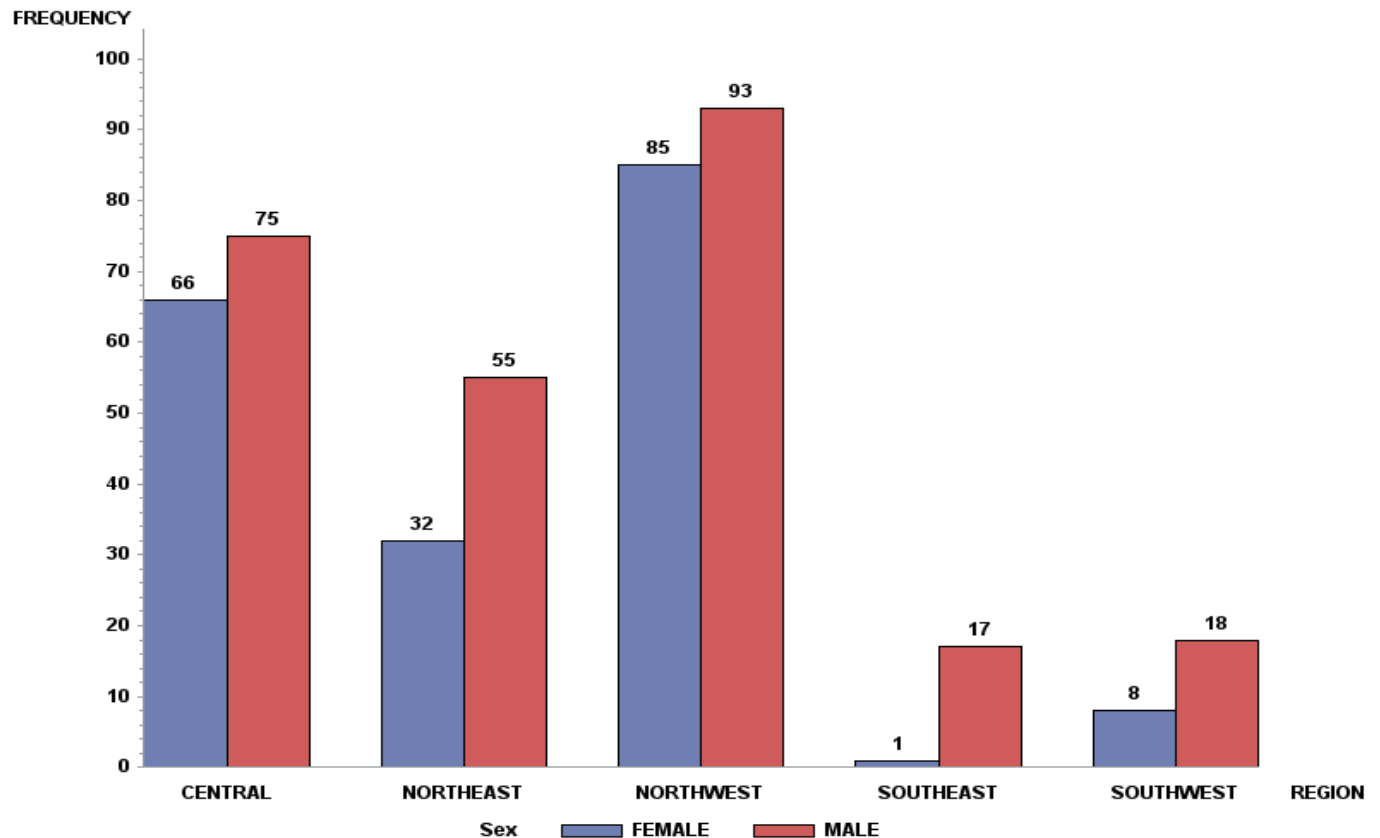

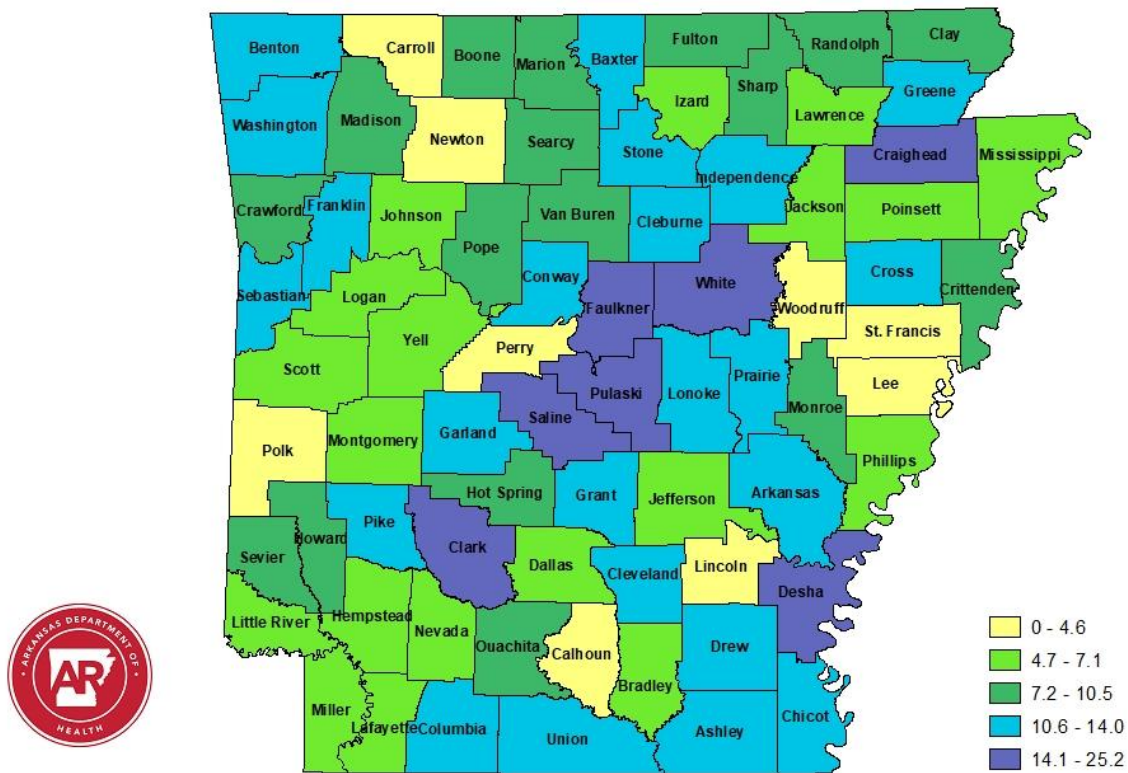

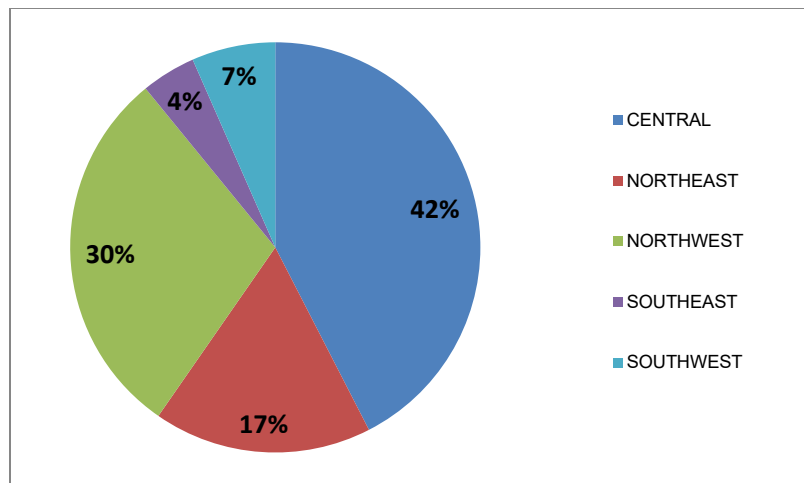
Pharmacists by County Per 10,000 Population



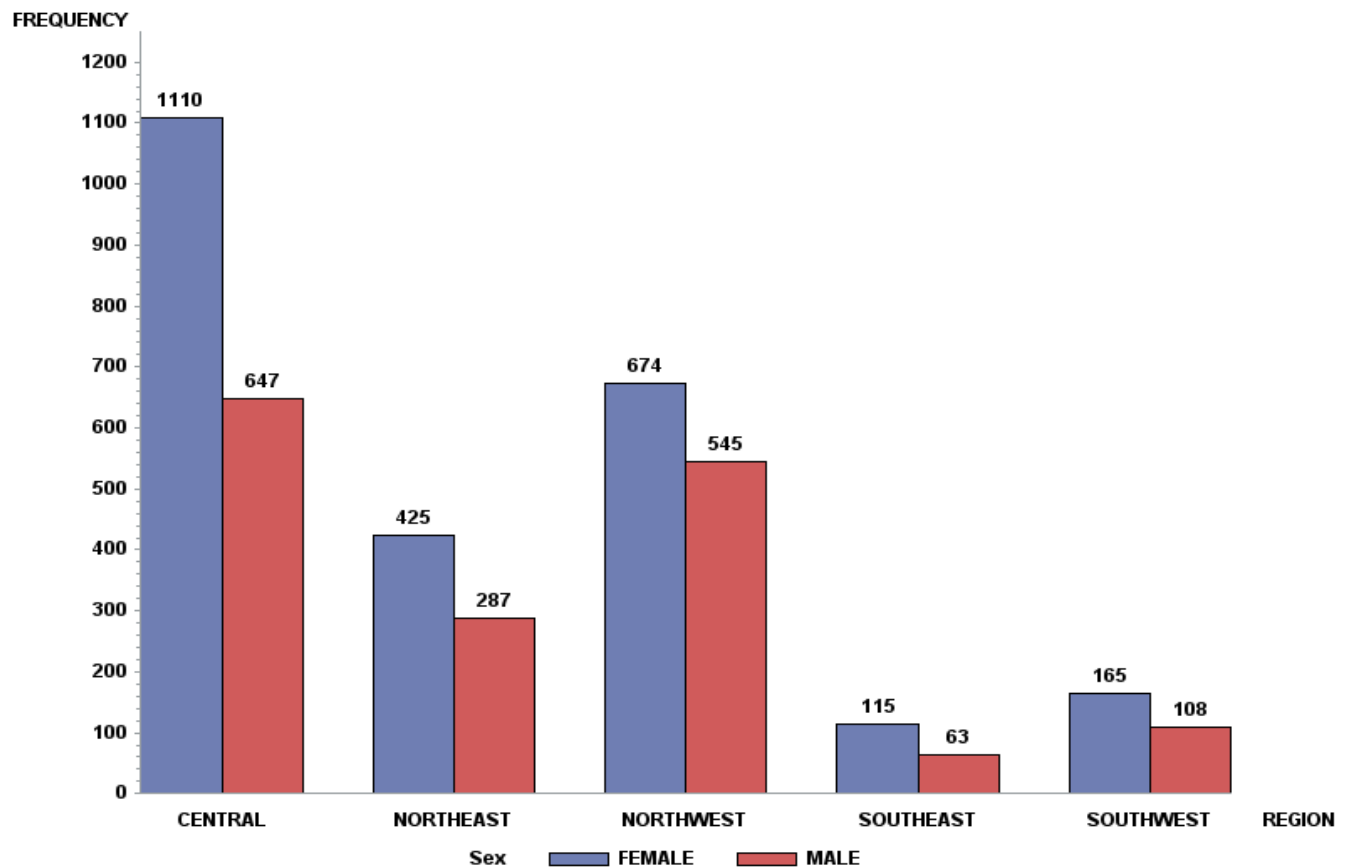

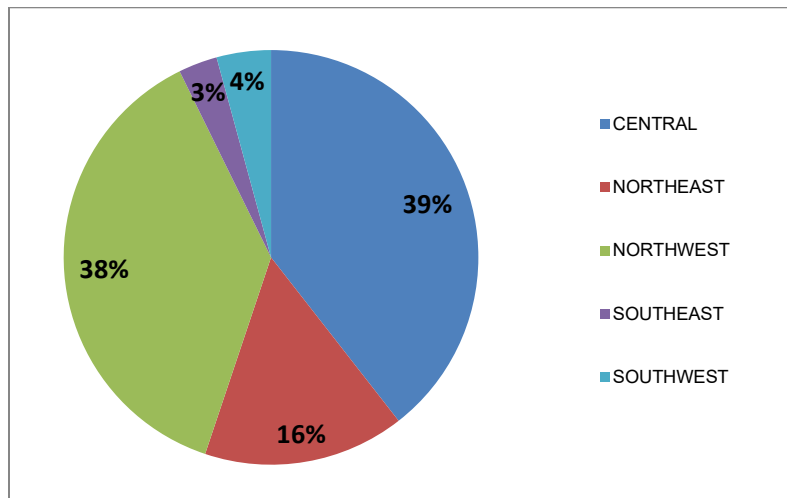

Physical Therapists by County Per 10,000 Population

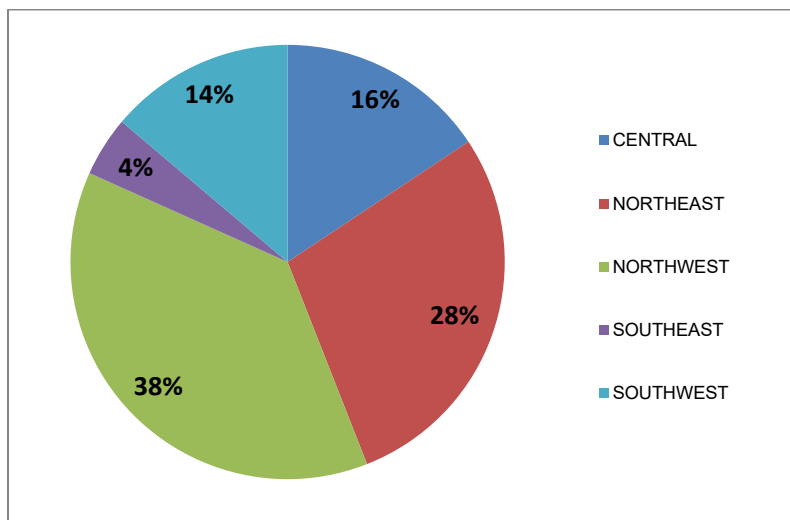


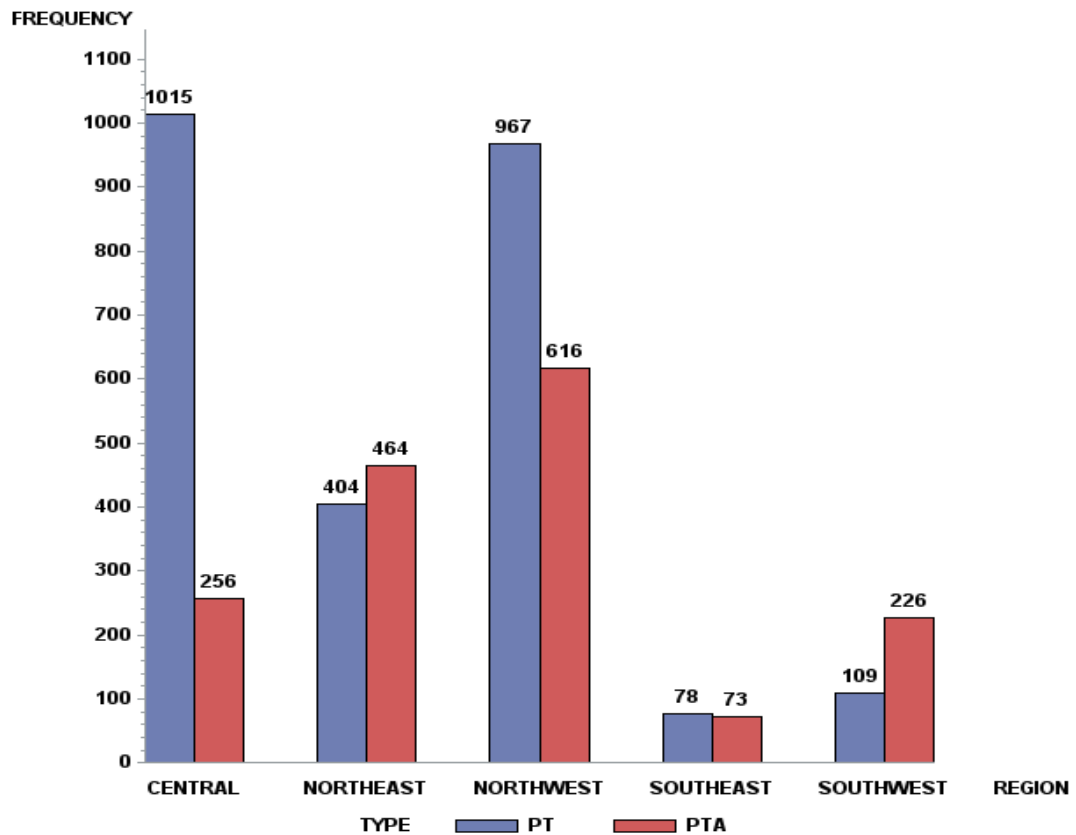

Physical Therapists by Region

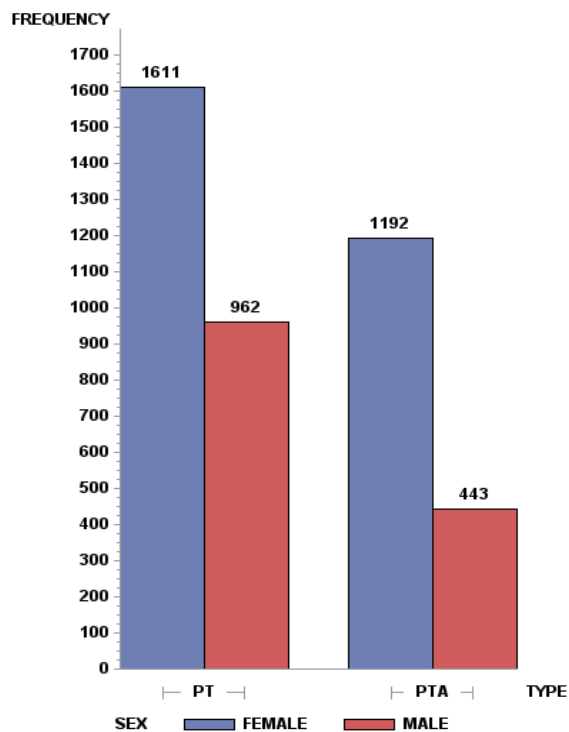


Physical Therapist Assistants by Region

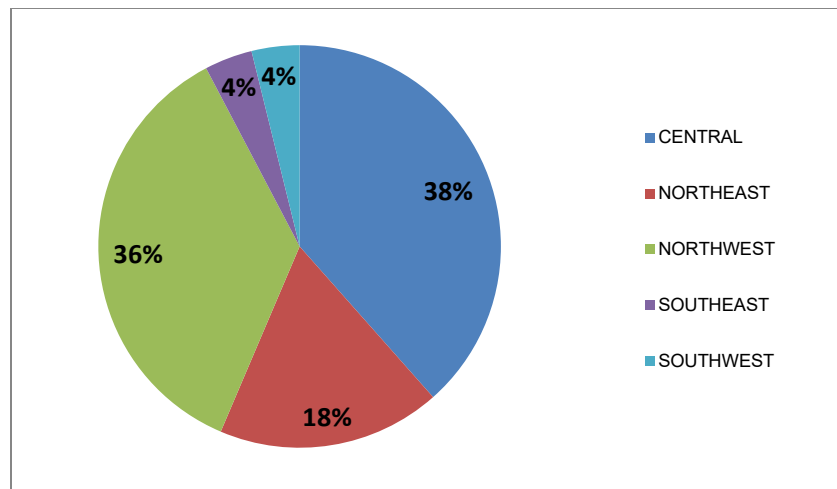
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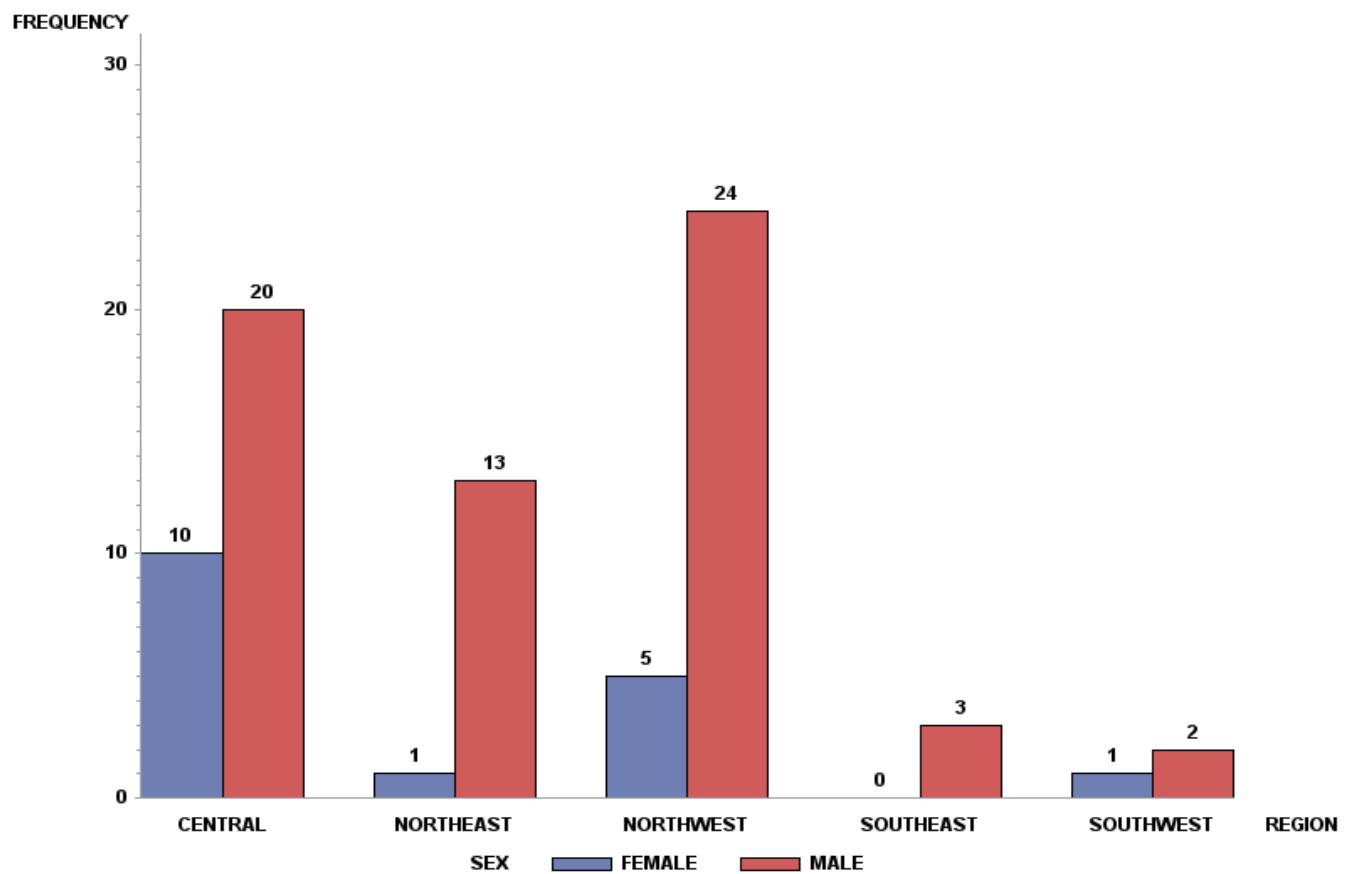

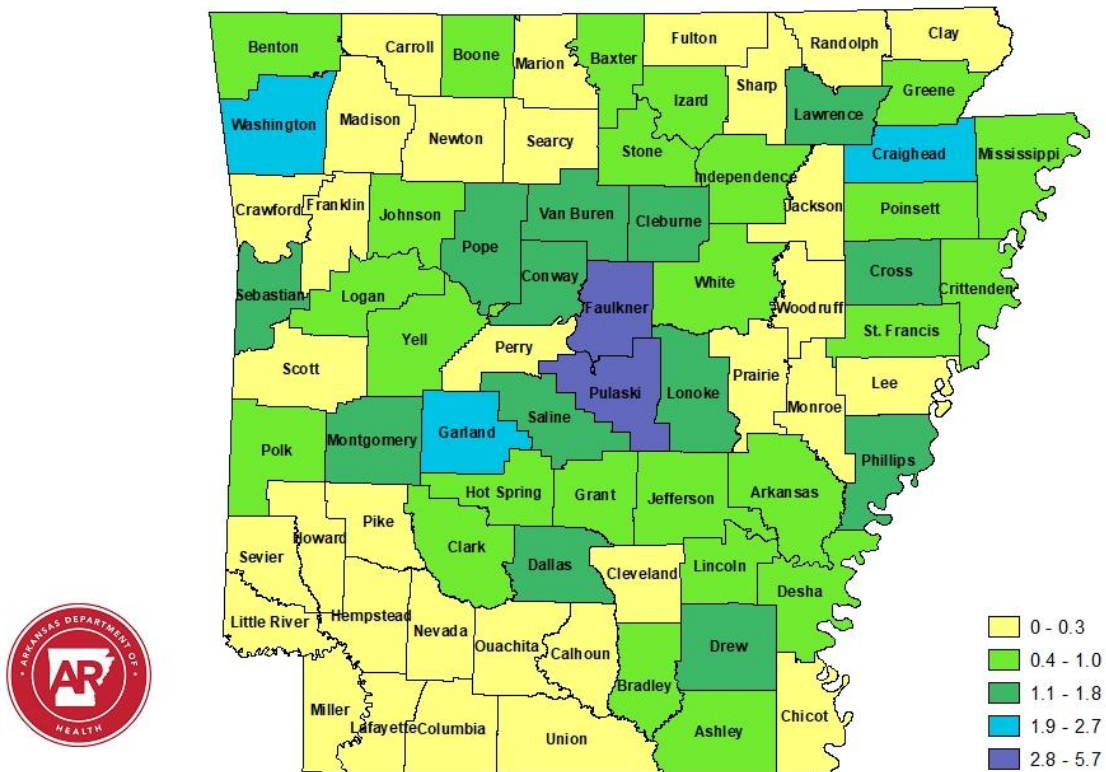

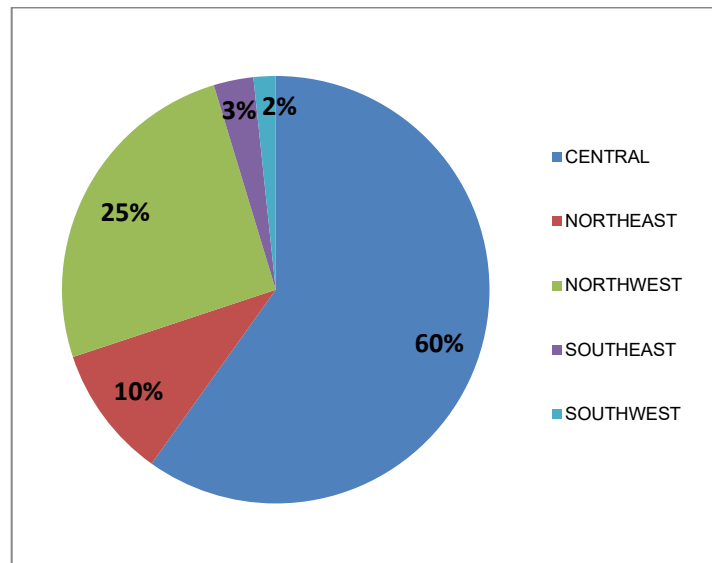
Psychologists by County Per 10,000 Population



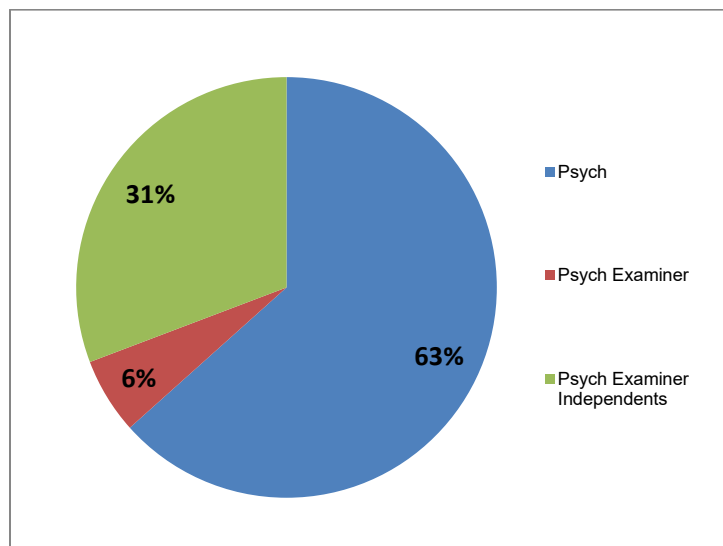

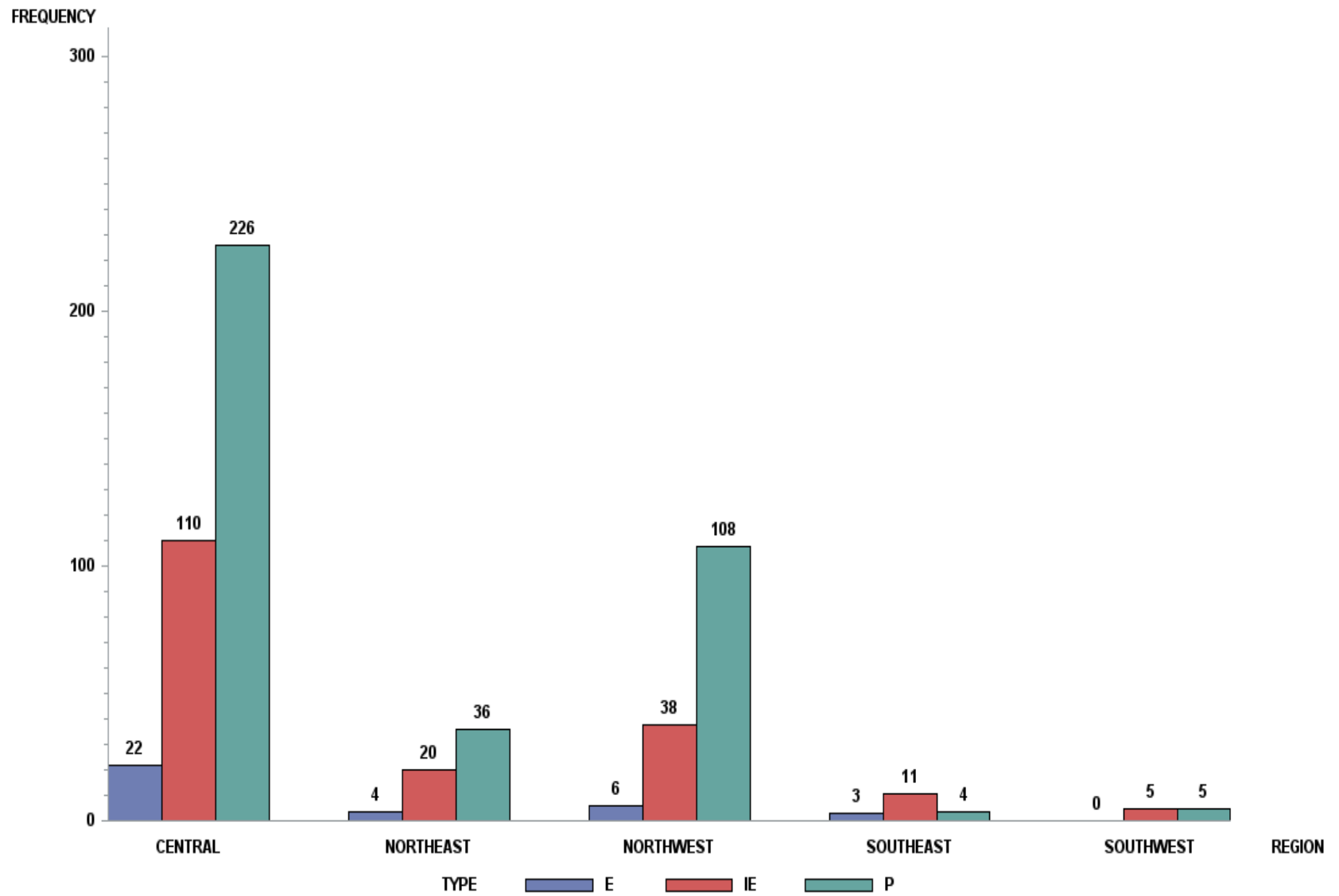
Distribution of Psychologists by Region



Distribution of Psychologists by Title

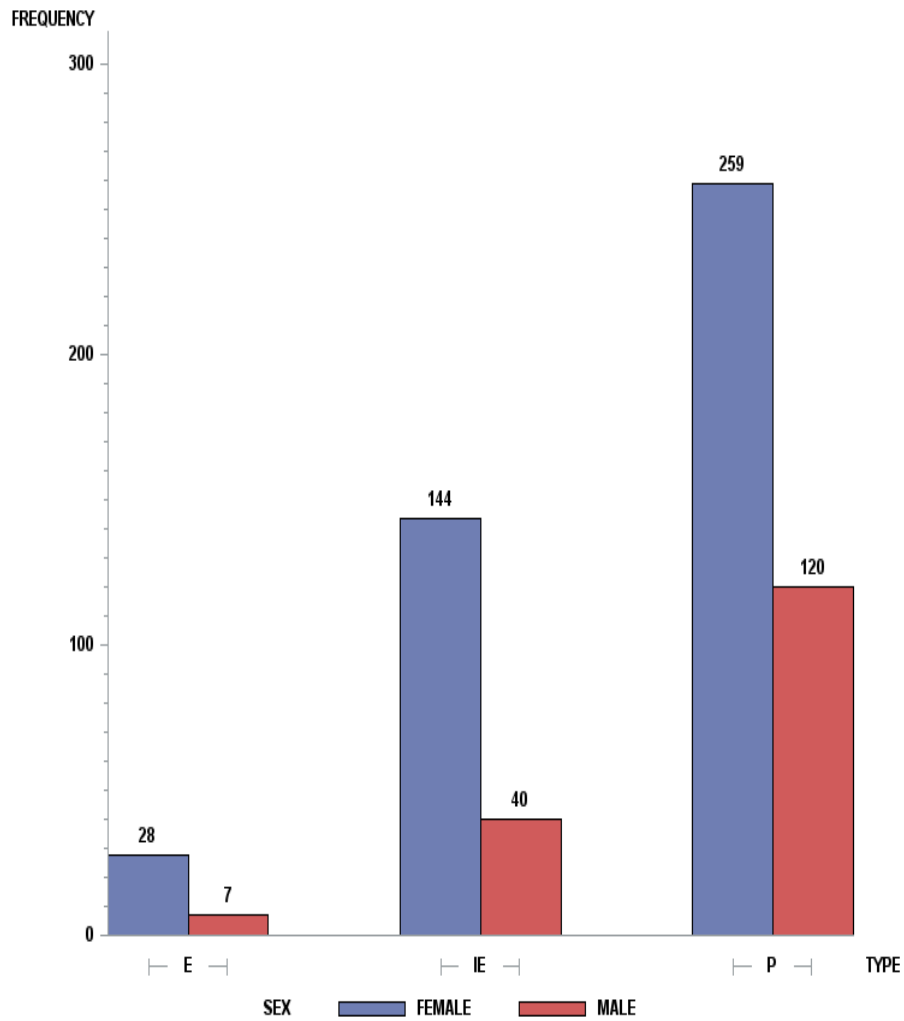


Psychologists by Region and License Type

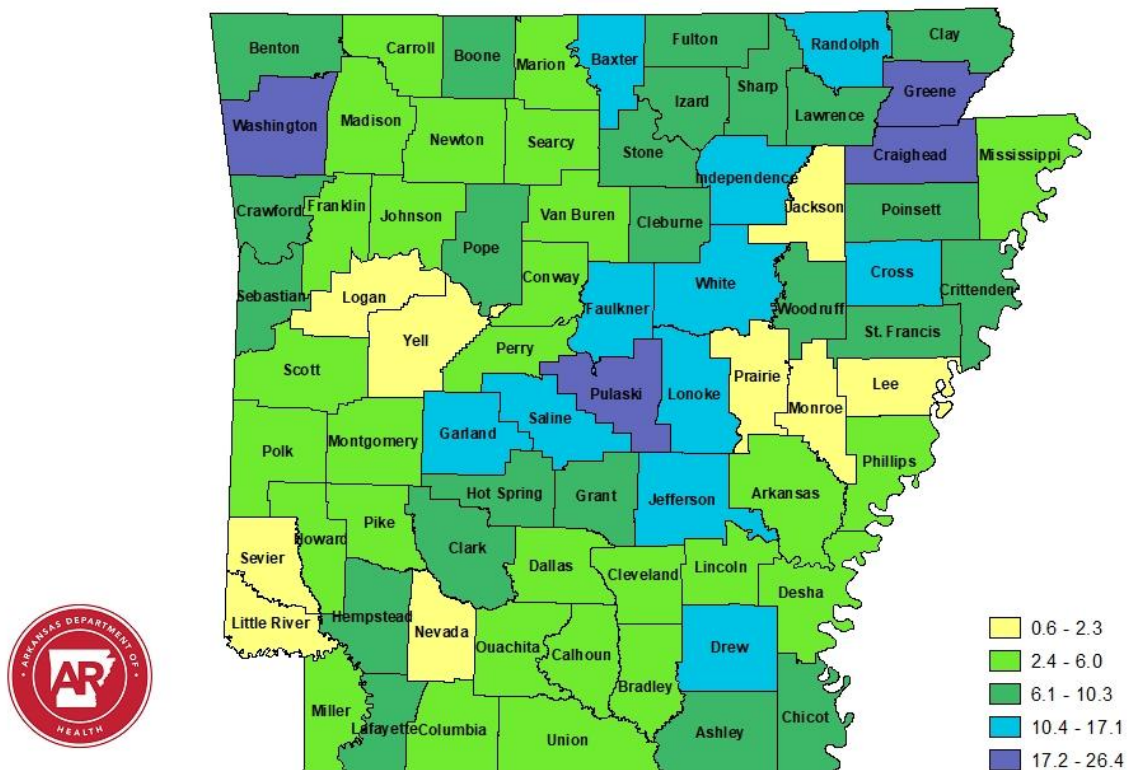

Social Workers in Arkansas

In 2024, the Social Work Licensing Board licensed 3,971 social workers with mailing addresses in Arkansas: about 12.9 per 10,000 population. This total includes 296 social workers (LSW), 2,267 certified social workers (LCSW), and 1,200 master social workers (LMSW). In addition, the Social Worker Licensing Board issued 208 provisional licenses for social workers with mailing addresses in Arkansas (*Provisional license for social workers means: First-time applicants for LSW or LMSW licensure will be issued a provisional license upon approval of his or her application. A provisional license will be issued one time per person and expires exactly one year from the date of issuance. Provisional licensing is prohibited at the LCSW level.*). This total includes 28 Provisional license social workers (PLSW), and 180 provisional license master social workers (PLMSW). At least one fully licensed social worker was licensed in each of the Arkansas counties.

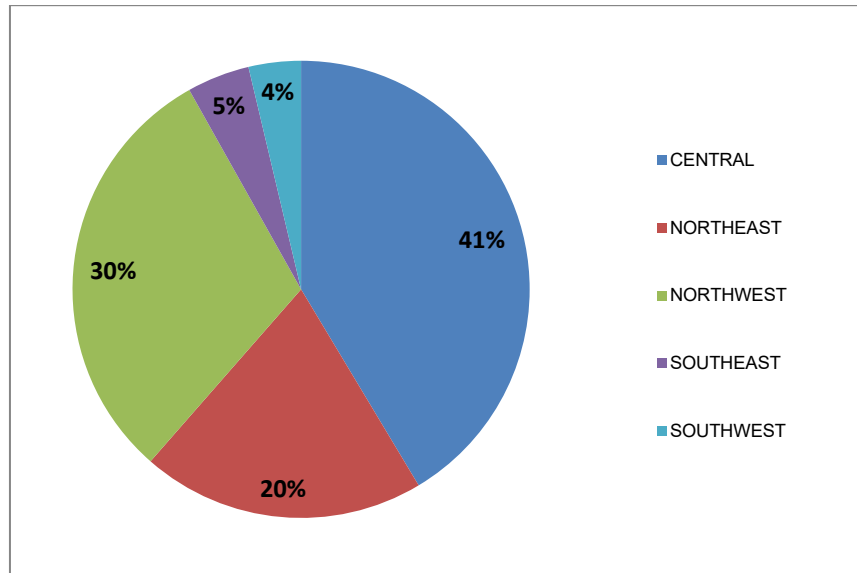
Social Workers by County Per 10,000 Population



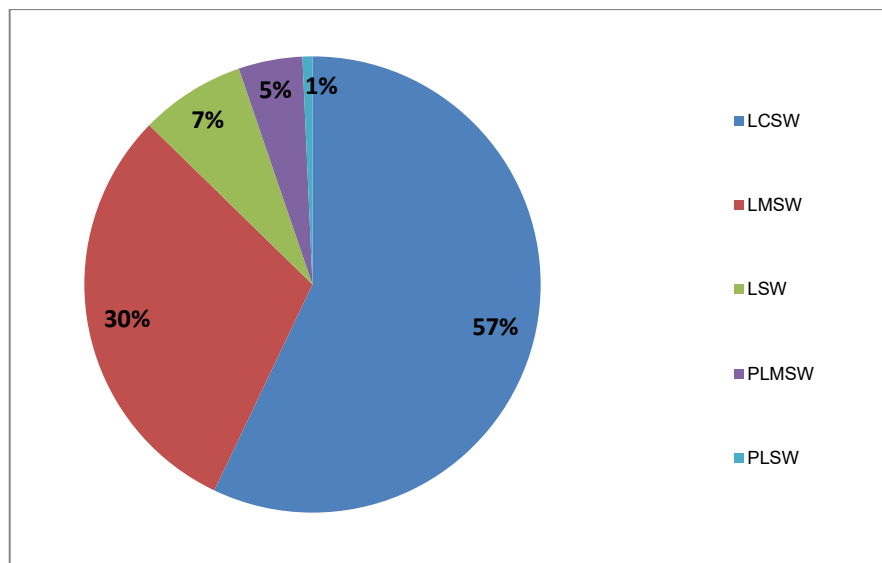

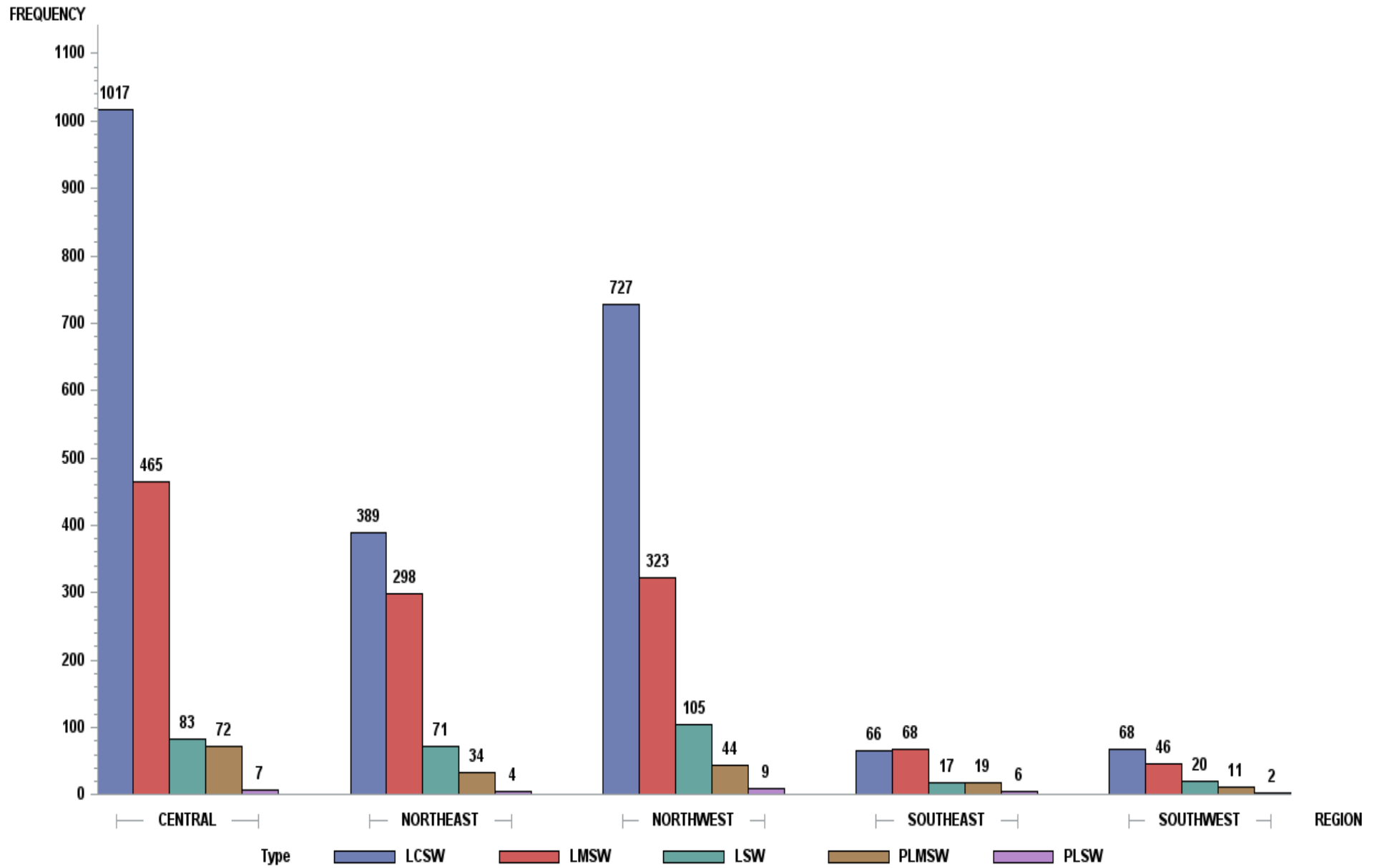
Distribution of Social Workers by Region

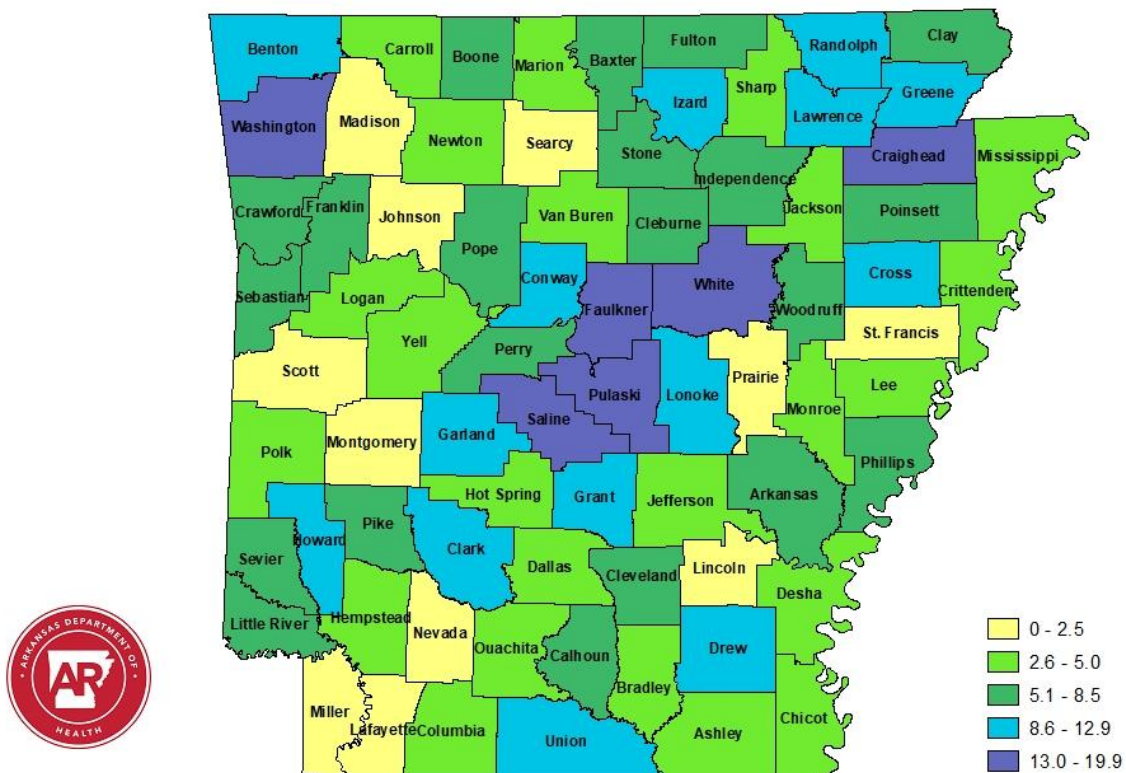

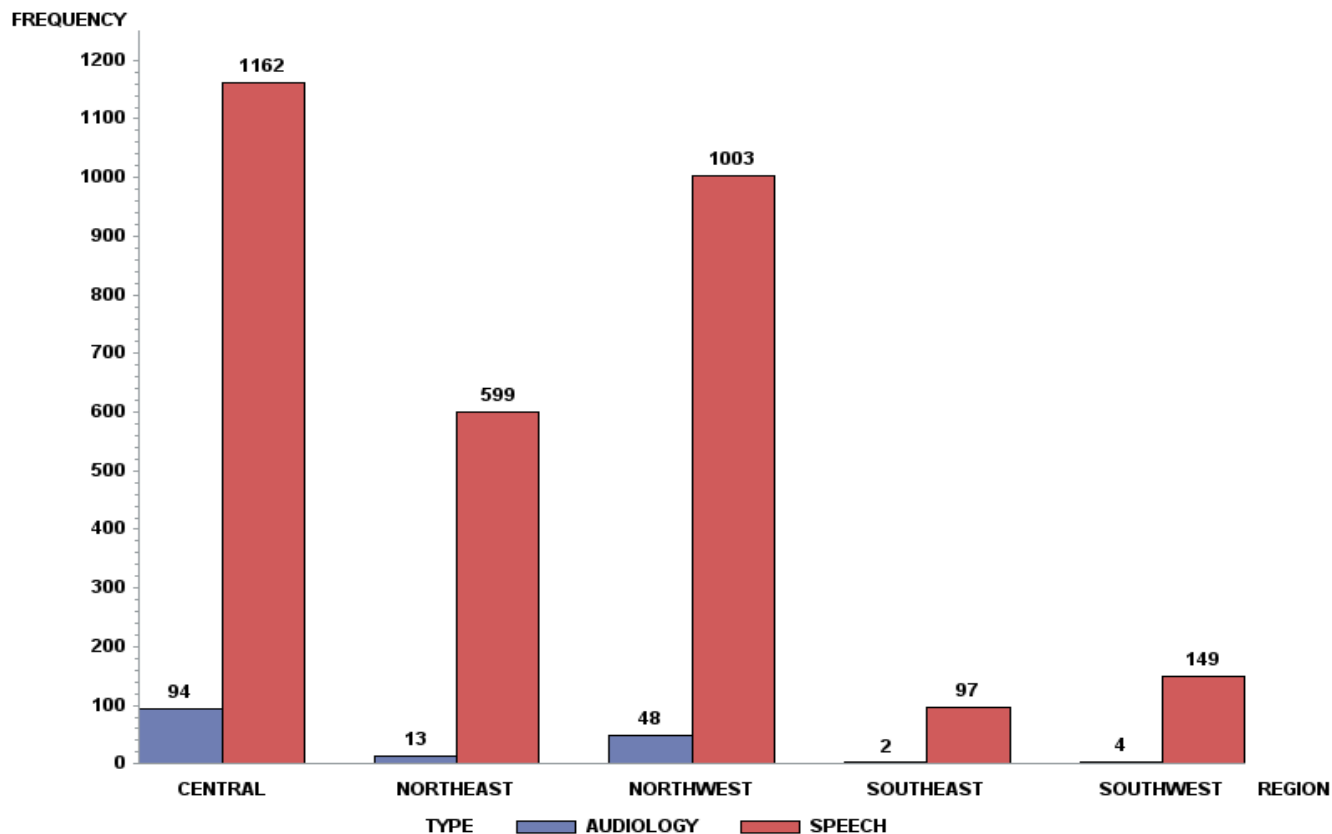
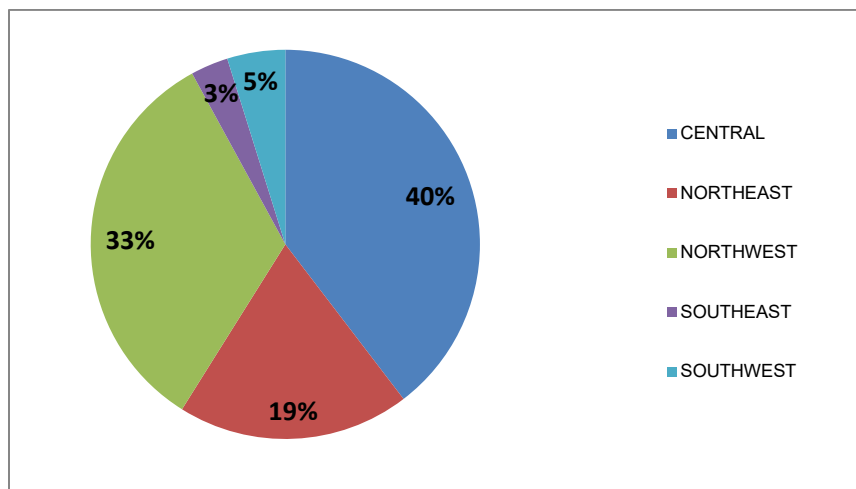

Veterinarians by County Per 10,000 Population

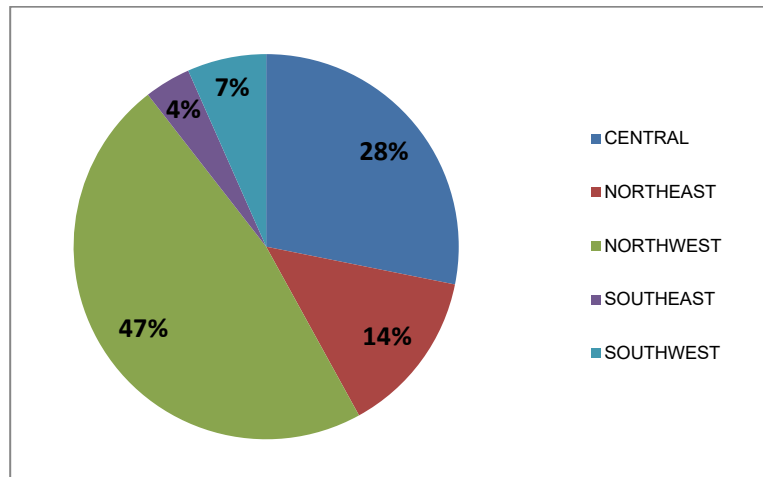

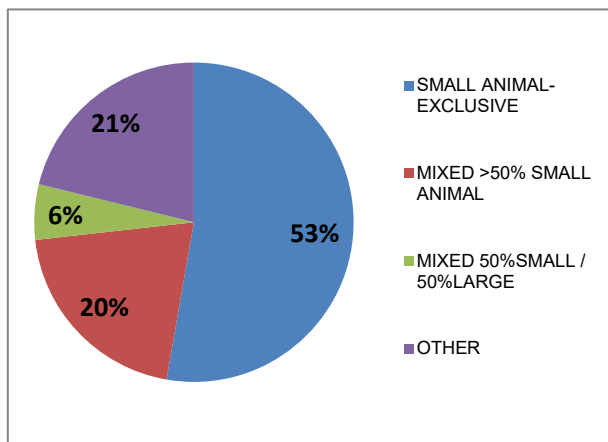

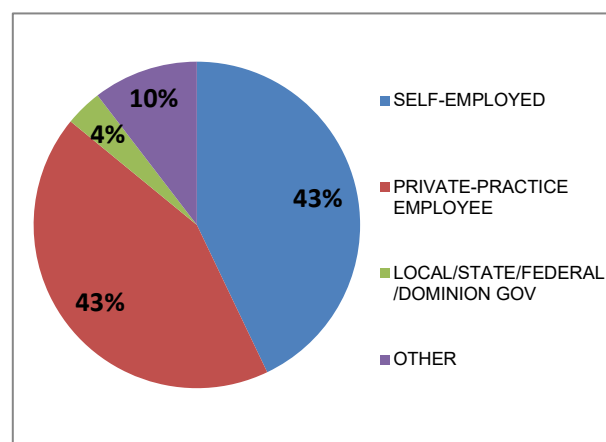
