## Collecting respiratory specimens for measles testing:

NP swab is preferred. Throat swab is acceptable. Swabs can be synthetic tip such as nylon, polyester, or dacron with plastic shafts to collect NP swab. Do not use cotton swabs or wooden handles.

Place swab in 3 ml liquid viral transport media (VTM). Collection kits used for influenza or respiratory biofire panel testing are appropriate. Refrigerate specimens and ship cold with cold packs. Label specimen with name, DOB, and collection date/time. SPHL must receive specimen within 72 hours of collection date/time.

Ship specimens to SPHL as Category B Include the completed HL-06 form.

Name and DOB on HL-06 form must match specimen label.
