The Board conducted an emergency hearing in the matter of **Jonathan Ragan, PD07823 and Westside Family Pharmacy, AR20556, Case #2025-047**. Board staff recommended the following:

- Immediate cease and desist on all sterile or non-sterile compounding, beyond reconstitution of commercial products.
- Recall on all non-sterile products that were compounded and dispensed with out-of-date ingredients, lack documentation and/or have incorrect records that could be in patient use.
- Take immediate action to make corrections and report all controlled substances dispensed to the PDMP.
- Patients are to be notified they will no longer be engaging in compounding pending further Board Orders. Notification to patients must be made in a timely manner and he will need to facilitate any transfers requested by patients.

BOARD ACTION:

Dr. Jolly made the motion in the matter of **Jonathan Ragan, PD07823 and Westside Family Pharmacy, AR20556, Case #2025-047**, that the Board accepts staff recommendations and steps for both the pharmacist and the pharmacy. Dr. Richmond seconded the motion. The vote for the motion was unanimous.

The Board conducted an emergency hearing in the matter of **Sandra Pollard, PT19180, Case #2025-038**.

BOARD ACTION:

Dr. Boone made the motion to suspend the pharmacy technician permit of **Sandra Pollard, PT19180, Case #2025-038**, pending a full hearing. Dr. Richmond seconded the motion. The vote for the motion was unanimous.
